1. I have visited the Naples office of the Societa Tirrenia di Navigazione and find that they have a very full report on the incident. This was made by the Captain of the ship on arrival in Sicily.
2. I enclose a copy of a letter I have written to the Direzione Marina Mercantile. This was written at the request of the Societa Tirrenia who are reluctant to allow me to borrow their only copy of the report.
3. However this report whilst of value to me, is that of the ship's captain reporting to his owners and does not take much account of the military personnel on board or of the Prisoners of War. Any information you may be able to obtain concerning that aspect of the incident will be much appreciated.

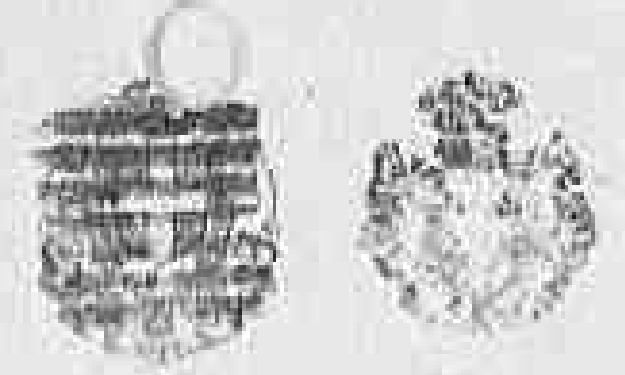

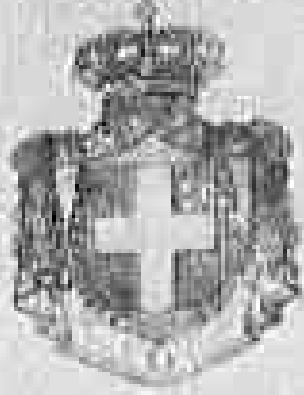

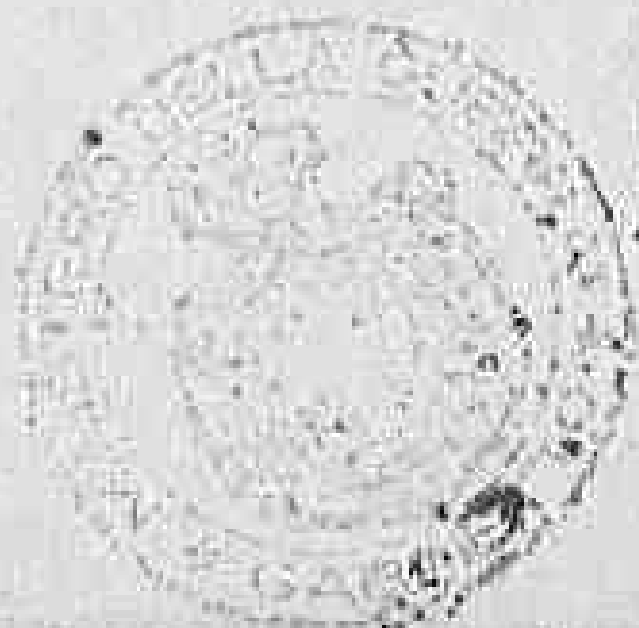

As no attempt was made to release the P/W they forced open the hatch of the hold and gained the deck. The Italian Officers and crew had already left the ship taking all serviceable lifeboats. The P/W who was the source of my information was picked up 6 hours later by an Italian cruiser and landed at Frankfurt. The prison ship is believed to have been of about 3000 tons. It is stated that 100 P/W were drowned.

(1) Reports state that the SS "Ariosto" was sunk at 01.45 *1/15 Feb.* off Cape Africa. The Italian destroyer "Pomorie" rescued 135 P/W which were landed at Tripoli and the torpedo boat "Pollux" saved 20 P/W which were disembarked at Palermo.

(2) The "Ariosto" was a motor-ship owned by Società di Navigazione.

(c) The SS. "Rosolino Pilo" sailed from Benghazi on about 1st August 1942 bound for Naples. As a result of a disastrous overcrowding one P/W died of

suffocation - his body was landed at Tripoli. Reports state that Ps/W had to be forced into the hold at the point of the bayonet.

1. Will you please deal with the enclosed letter from Dr. Smodlaka (Pov/Br. 37/46 of 3 January) and inform him that any further applications for the arrest of persons whose names are included in the lists issued by the United Nations War Crimes Commission should be addressed to you.

2. The manner in which requests from Dr. Smodlaka will be dealt with in future will be:

a. If the person referred to is in the War Crimes List:- Allied Commission will request the DAPM (SIB) c/o JAG Naples to effect his arrest and inform Dr. Smodlaka of the action taken. Action thereafter will be the responsibility of SIB and not of the Allied Commission.

b. If the person concerned is not in the List:- Dr. Smodlaka will be so informed and told that any application for his inclusion in the War Crimes list will be forwarded, with the necessary supporting particulars, to the War Crimes Commission through the usual diplomatic channels.

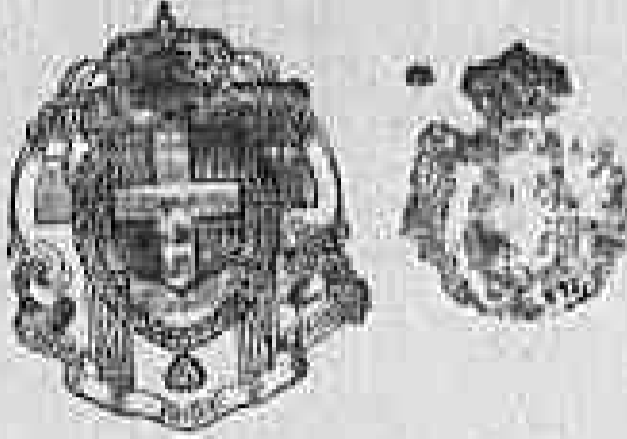

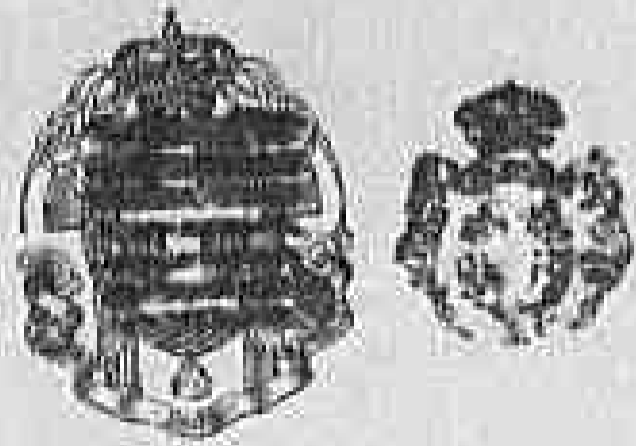

I detti ufficiali peraltro immaginavano che il trasporto della salma fosse già stato effettuato, perché non scesero nemmeno dall'automezzo. Vollerò invece l'indicazione del Cimitero che non era quello della Certosa (dove non erano locali disponibili) ma quello di Borgo Pace, e presero nota anche del numero del loculo. Così, previo consenso, della scorta tedesca, collo stesso automezzo, essi si recarono al Cimitero per deporre una corona.

Anche quella mattina lo stesso ricevevi gli Ufficiali venuti per le onoranze.

Di tutte le pratiche si interessò la Direzione dell'Ospedale Militare Principale di Bologna, la quale potrebbe aver conservato, non solo la cartella clinica, che fu regolarmente compilata, ma anche copia della denuncia di morte.

Per quanto riguarda gli avvenimenti verificatisi al Campo Prigionieri n. 19 i due Ufficiali medici in accompagnamento mi riferirono che, già alle ore 5 del mattino del 9 settembre, il Campo era stato circondato dalle truppe stesse ed i prigionieri. Appunto in conseguenza di tali avvenimenti rimase ferito il povero Capitano Johnson ed un altro Ufficiale, ma quest'ultimo assai lievemente, tanto che non fu nemmeno ricoverato in Ospedale.

In risposta a quanto mi si richiede col foglio n.2/ris. di prot. di codesta Direzione, posso comunicare che nelle ore antime rifilane del 9/9/43 una autoambulanza germanica trasportò alla Sezione S. Leonardo dell'Ospedale Militare di Bologna, da me diretta, tre Ufficiali Inglesi prigionieri, un ferito da pallottola al basso ventre, morente per grave emorragia, un'altro ferito ad un arto superiore, ed un Capitano Medico che li accompagnava.

L'ufficiale medico inglese chiese di soccorrere personalmente i due feriti, avendo udito che gli parlavo in inglese e che avevo frequentato l'Istituto Ospedaliero di Londra. Gli feriti perciò tutti i presidi chirurgici superstiti e l'aiuto dell'unico assistente rimasto in Ospedale, nella persona del dott. Martelli.

Ma l'ufficiale ferito gravemente, Capitano Johnson, decise dette prima che si intervenesse sulla ferita, per emorragia dell'Ilia: sicché l'ufficiale medico inglese provvide alla medicazione dell'altro Ufficiale ferito all'arto superiore, quindi si intrattenne a raccontare al Gen. Medico Dott. Exami, presente in Ospedale, che i due ufficiali inglesi prigionieri erano stati feriti nel tentativo di evadere dal Campo Prigionieri n. 19 di Bologna.

Nonostante la vigila sorveglianza della scorta germanica il generale Exami poté provvedere a ristorare i due Ufficiali inglesi superstiti ed intrattenersi cordialmente con loro finché furono bruscamente sollecitati a rilasciarli, quantunque l'Ufficiale ferito all'arto superiore, fosse ancora sotto l'azione della narcosi.

Non si conata se furono poi trasportati dall'autoambulanza germanica, né se fossero stati redatti dei documenti sanitari, perché i fatti si svolsero in circostanze tali che solo può giudicare chi le ha vissute. Al pochissimi rimasti nella sezione S. Leonardo incombeva oltre l'obbligo di soccorrere i feriti, quello di salvare i degenti e stare in abito civile, di salvarsi dalla deportazione.

I prigionieri data l'oscurità avendo l'impressione nell'avviarsi all'uscita del Campo di essere sottoposti ad una esecuzione in massa si sbandarono, contemporaneamente i fucilieri e i mitraglieri aprirono il fuoco.

Ciò che avvenne in seguito non ho potuto vedere dato che ero sbloccato nella palazzina dell'Infermeria, non potendo neanche occorrere per i soccorsi.

All'alba vidi uscire dal Campo una camionetta tedesca con dei feriti e con un Capitano Medico Inglese, pure prigioniero di cui non ricordo il nome, ricordo solo che era residente a Londra e che era chirurgo.

Quale mio coadiutore nominato da me direttore dell'Infermeria prigionieri era il Capitano medico Sanderson di Edimburgo che dopo l'ingresso dei tedeschi nel campo non rividi più, come non potei più rivedere gli altri prigionieri avendo i tedeschi vietato qualsiasi contatto con loro.

1. - All enquiries carried out by the competent department (Naples Military Territorial H.Q.) in order to supply your Mission with all possible information in respect of the personnel and P.O.W. camps referred to in the above mentioned letters, have been unfruitful. This is because the documents concerning the P.O.W. camps dealt with in the said letters were destroyed in Autumn 1943 by war action.
2. - We take this opportunity to beg you to also bear in mind (ref. letter 201549/11 of 29.1.46 relating to Derna P.O.W. camp) that this Ministry is not in a position to be able to give information in respect of the P.O.W. camps which were located in North Africa, in that the appointment of personnel to the above mentioned camps was ordered direct by the North African High Command which only notified to the Central Authorities the numerical variations in said personnel.

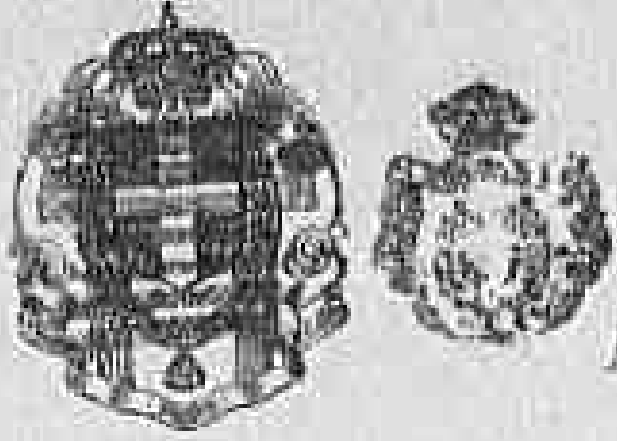

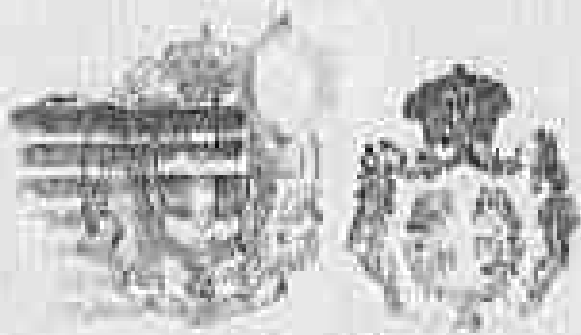

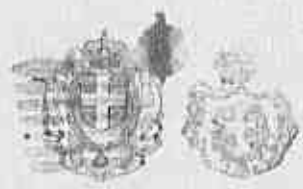
