To Naples Military District H.Q.

It is my duty to inform you that I have been a prisoner of the British since 23rd inst.

Interned in the camp with me is pvt. (service corps) Liberti Gastano, who in September 1942, being on duty as a sentry at the gate of a Unit of sick British P.O.W.s in the Military Hospital of Caserta, gravely wounded an Indian, who attempted to throw himself down the stairs.

I think that my detention is due to a/m episode. At any rate I have not been yet interrogated and I do not know how longer my detention will last. I should like to point out that at that time I was not at Caserta, but up to 10 days ago I was at Naples as temporary Medical Director of the Army Corps.

I would inform you as above in order that High Authorities may be so informed.

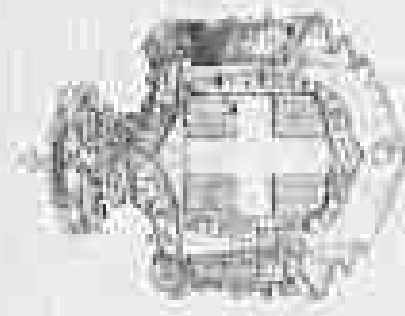

He formerly belonged to 51 permanent M.M.I. Battalion; from August 1942 to February 1943 was i/o concentration Camp of Capua, from where he appears to have been dismissed after having been punished with 30 days arrest, for having helped some English P.O.s.
No charges against the Officer concerned have ever been made in the past.

- Lt. gran. Rossi Riccardo - of Lorenzo and of Arsala Clotilde, born at La Spezia on 5/12/95 and there domiciled at Via XI Settembre 35.

2. Evidence held by this Office indicated that no War Crime had been committed and the case had been listed for investigation on a low priority.
3. I have been informed however, that the Italian Authorities hold evidence to prove a clear case of murder and therefore of a War Crime.
4. Since the Trial of those accused by the Italian Authorities is about to take place, it is understood that you do not wish to interfere at this stage.
5. No doubt however, you will request Land Forces Sub Commission, Allied Commission, to obtain details of the persons accused, of the charges and of the result of the Trial and to issue instructions that:-
 - (a) No sentence of death be put into execution without the authority of Allied Commission.
 - (b) Any of the accused acquitted must continue to be held in custody at the disposal of Allied Commission.

This office being informed that ^{she} had taken up residence at Como in Via Flume No. 3., sent a letter, No. 01228 of 18.5.45, to the Questura of that city ordering the arrest of the abovementioned.

The Como Questura, in letter 04657 R.I.P. of 9.8.45, addressed to the Questuras of Genoa and Milan and this office for info., informed that the father, Bartolini Emilio, together with the daughter

Edgarda had left Como some days previously for Genoa while the other daughter Rossana had, in turn, left for Milan to visit relatives.

The said Questura of Como, in telegram of 10.9.45 No. 04657 of R.I.P., addressed to the same Questuras of Genoa and Milan and this office for info., while ordering the revoking of the search for Bartoloni Emilio who had been arrested at Como, notified that the arrest warrant was still in force for the daughters, who, to date, have not yet been located.

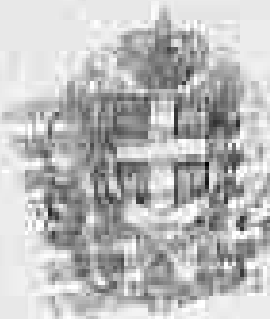
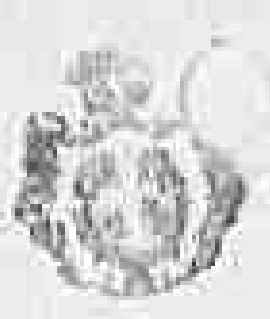

1. There are two main series of Lists at present in circulation in this theatre, GHQ Local Wanted Lists 1 to 21, and UNWCC War Criminals Lists numbered 1 to 16.
2. The GHQ Local Wanted Lists have now been edited and consolidated and will shortly be circulated with the instructions that upon receipt all copies of the separate Lists 1-20 may be destroyed.
3. The UNWCC Lists contain many hundreds of Italian names, and nearly all these Italians were or are members of the Italian Army.
4. To extract all these names from the thousands in the possession of this GHQ would be an enormous task quite beyond the capabilities of the present reduced staffs. It is therefore regretted that we are unable to furnish the information in the form in which you require it.
5. Should you be able to send a clerk to this GHQ however, every possible effort will be made to assist him in compiling the information you require.
