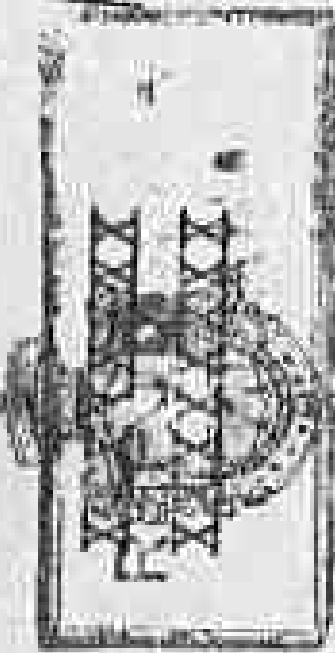

1. Up to 1 Jun 47 the investigation of War Crimes in ITALY and AUSTRIA, and the preparation of cases against persons alleged to have committed war crimes against British nationals, was the responsibility of the D.J.G. GHQ. Arrangements for the custody and trial of war criminals in ITALY and the execution of sentences was the responsibility of A-3 Section, GHQ, who also dealt with all matters of War Crimes policy, in consultation with the Judge Advocate, AFHQ.
2. A new unit designated "The War Crimes Group, South East Europe", was formed on 1 Jun 47, to handle all war crimes commitments in ITALY and AUSTRIA, including policy, investigations and trials. The responsibility of GHQ CME, apart from major questions of policy, is now limited to the provision of courts, confirmation of sentences and the provision of such assistance to the War Crimes Group in the movement of witnesses, the guarding of prisoners, the holding of trials and the execution of sentences, as may be required.
3. The OC War Crimes Group, South East Europe, is empowered to correspond direct with formations and units, including J.G. Dept War Office, and other commands, over matters concerning war criminals. He will not, however, issue any instructions involving executive action by a formation or unit; such instructions will be referred to A-3 GHQ, for issue through the usual staff channels.

For example, the OC War Crimes Group can correspond with a formation to ascertain whether a person is held in custody and can arrange for his investigators to visit a camp for interrogation purposes; but if he wishes to have a prisoner moved physically from one place to another, or to have an escort or guard provided, he must apply for instructions to be issued through staff channels.

The handover of persons to other nations and all major questions of policy will always be referred to GHQ before action is taken.

In relation to what is stated in a/m letter this Ministry has arranged for inquiries to be made to find out, from the war diaries of the Armed Forces G.H.Q. in Greece, what appeared regarding the killing in question for which CC. Lt Vittorio VITTOZZI has been arrested and imprisoned in Padua.

The document which mentions this fact is reproduced in attachment 7 to the war diary of 23 January 1943 of Armed Forces G.H.Q. in Greece (11th Army) of which photographic copy is attached (typewritten copy for I.M.A.S. L.F.S.S.).

It has not yet been possible to trace the "instructions in force" mentioned in a/m document.

General RICCI GOFFREDO son of Elmo and of Magnani Marcellina, born at Ferrara 21 May 1888.

On 25 July 1943 was Colonel (Cavalry) commanding the West Armoured Motor Group in Sicily.

Took part in this capacity in operations further to landing of the Allies.

On 8 September 1943 was on marriage leave at Gagnone (Arezzo). He was promoted General in August 1943.

Joined the Republican Army in December 1943 and assumed regional command of Umbria.

In March 1944 he was transferred to Germany and took over command of the Monterosa Division in training.

Released from this appointment in July 1944 was sent on special leave awaiting release.

Recalled to service in October 1944 he was posted to HQ Large Units Formation Centre at Vercelli.

In February 1945 was released from service and sent again on special leave awaiting release under the accusation of anti-fascist.

From March to May 1945 remained as a civilian at Milan.

On 15 May 1945 he reported voluntarily to Florence Military Territorial Command.

Interned in the camps at Scandicci-Aversa and Coltano. In October 1945 he was transferred to the Military Prison at Forte Boccea here in Rome, where he is at present bed-ridden.

Tried for collaboration he was absolved by the Court of Cassation on 10/12/46 as "the facts of which he was accused did not constitute crime".

Further to this action by the Italian judicial authorities his imprisonment was ordered which however did not take place as he is still at the disposal of the Allied Command.

The reasons are not known for which he is held in prison at the disposal of the Allies, as he cannot be guilty of any violation of the laws of war or other facts which interest the Anglo-American Command.

It is thought that he is held instead of a person of the same name or as for arbitrary attribution of non existing facts.

It is requested therefore that you kindly consider
