Subject: Troop transport on behalf of the Allies. -

On 16th June 45, the Societa' Anonima Tronvie Interprovinciali Piemontesi following an order from the American Army (signed by Capt. Bender) carried out the transportation of 1720 soldiers of an American Regiment, from Iomiazco to Turin. -

The expenses sustained by said Society amounted to Gh.800 Lira, as shown in the attached account; the reimbursement of the expenses, (as shown in foot of the enclosure of transports carried out) should be made by the nearest American Army Cashier. The Society approached the Finance Office of the V Army at Gardone but up to to-day has received no reply.

The firm also approached the Turin Military Territorial Command who asked several Allied Offices for information but received no reply and could not obtain the payment which was due.

On the 9/7/46 the above Command approached the HEADQUARTER PONTESULAI BASE SECTION U.S.ARMV - Livorno, with letter 5190/3g., in order to have confirmation that the transport was carried out following an order from the American Authorities and an indication of the office concerned for the payment.

With letters 5446/3g. and 5921/3g. respectively of the 31/7/46 and 25/8/46 the above HQ was approached again but up to now no reply has been received.--

We beg you to directly approach the HQ P.B.S. of Livorno on the matter and inform us if and by whom must the payment be made. -

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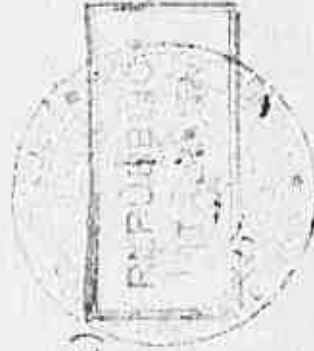

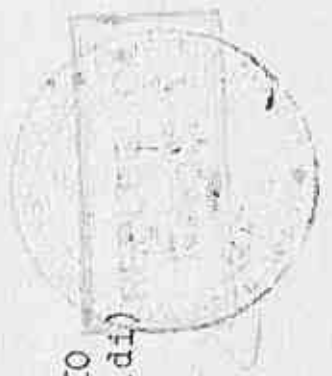
