DOCUMENTATION - OFFICERS
RECORD INSTRUCTIONS NO 1

12 November 1945

The following instructions are circulated for guidance of units in reporting casualties concerning officers' appointments, promotions and grants of war substantive ranks (hereafter referred to as MS casualties).

All such casualties will in future be reported on A.F. W3010A and NO OTHER TYPE OF CASUALTY will be reported on A.F. W3010A which reports MS casualties. Postings, claims for additional pay, etc, will be reported separately.

It is, however, particularly to be understood that on no account must there be any delay in reporting an officers movement, i.e., the actual despatch on posting from one unit to another, though there may be delay in obtaining authorities for appointments, etc.

1. APPOINTMENTS.

- (a) (i) All appointments and relinquishments of appointment which are normally published in the MS Lists issued as an appendix to GPOs, must, in any circumstances whatsoever, be reported to the HQ which controls such appointments, and A.F. W3010A should not be submitted until authority has been given. Additional pay derived from these appointments, command pay (in the case of Lt Col's commands) 2nd in command pay (in the case of Majors entitled thereto) and adjutants' pay, should NOT be claimed until the appropriate authority has been published in the MS Lists issued as an appendix to GPOs.

- (ii) The majority of appointments in this theatre is controlled by one of the following authorities:-
Staff appointments, command appointments (in rank of Lt Col) Dep Mil Sec
and above) 2nd in command (in rank of Major) } GHQ, CMT, or
MS, HQ, BTL.

- (ii) If, for any reason, the date is considered to be incorrect, action will be taken as outlined in sub-para (a) (iii) above.

- (iii) If for any reason, letters of authority, when received, are considered to be insufficiently A.F. W3010A will NOT be rendered; but the unit or units concerned must request the issuing authority (through service channels) to issue an amendment. Copies of all correspondence of this nature will be sent to HQ and London, CWP, (for information Officer i/c Officers' Records)

- (b) (i) When an authority for an appointment or relinquishment of an appointment specifies that date of which the appointment or relinquishment is to become effective, this date must be adhered to by all concerned, and A.F. W3010A rendered accordingly.

- (ii) If, for any reason, the date is considered to be incorrect, action will be taken as outlined in sub-para (a) (iii) above.

- (c) (i) When an appointment or relinquishment of an appointment is approved "wef date of assumption" or "wef date S.O.S." care must be taken by all concerned that the date when are not reported by different units. Despatching units will report relinquishments wef date S.O.S., and a copy of A.F. W3010A will be taken personally by the officer concerned to hand to his new unit on arrival; the new unit must ensure that date of assumption reported is not earlier than that of the:-

- (a) date of relinquishment in former unit, or
(b) date of relinquishment by the outgoing officer who is being replaced.

- 2 -

(ii) The despatching unit need make no reference on A.F. W3010A to the new appointment to be assured. The receiving unit need make no reference on A.F. W3010A to the former appointment held. IT IS EMPHASISED THAT A.F. W3010A ARE REQUIRED FROM ALL UNITS CONCERNED.

(d) Upgrading of command, staff, extra-regimental and intelligence appointments are to be reported as such, and NOT as regimental promotions.

2. PROMOTIONS.

(a) Officers can only be promoted to fill vacancies in the authorised War Establishment of the unit on whose posted strength they are held. Promotions are NOT admissible for officers who are held on X Lists (other than X (1) List).

(b) Where higher formation authority is required for a promotion, the instructions given in para 1 above regarding appointments will be applied and observed.

(c) Promotions to paid acting rank or regnants of temporary rank, are in every case dependent on the rank being held on that occasion for a minimum of 22 clear days. The period of 21 days or less, unpaid acting rank only is admissible.

(d) Where a promotion has been made vice an officer who has proceeded on LIAP, and during his absence, the temporary incumbent is absorbed in a vacancy in war establishments in the rank which he is holding by virtue of his LIAP promotion, no further publication in GROs is necessary, merely because the promotion, has become a permanent one. No further A.F. W3010A will be rendered, but GHQ 2nd Echelon will be advised of the situation by letter.

3. GRANTS ON TEMPORARY AND WAR SUBSTANTIVE RANK.

(a) When paid acting rank is held continuously for the period necessary to qualify the holder for the grant of temporary (and war substantive) rank, the period is calculated in calendar months, except as stated in sub-para (e) below.

(b) When paid rank is held during two or more broken periods, such periods are cumulative. Grant of temporary (and war substantive) rank is made wef 92nd in these cases (or wef 183rd day in the cases of colonels and brigadiers).

(c) Periods of paid acting rank retained under the provisions of GRO 706 of 1944, para 5 (e) are reckonable towards grant of temporary (and war substantive) rank.

(d) Periods of unpaid acting rank are NOT reckonable towards grant of temporary rank.

(e) Grant of temporary rank is made to CANALON officers after paid acting rank has been held for 181 days, wef 182nd day.

(f) Where 2/Lieuts are not recommended for promotion to the war substantive rank of Lieut after six months' commissioned service, units MUST ensure that CHQ 2nd Echelon is so notified.

No further A.F. W30101 will be rendered, but GHQ 2nd Echelon will be advised of the situation by letter.

3. GRANTS ON TEMPORARY AND WAR SUBSTANTIVE RANK.

- (a) When paid acting rank is held continuously for the period necessary to qualify the holder for the grant of temporary (and war substantive) rank, the period is calculated in calendar months, except as stated in sub-para (c) below.
- (b) When paid rank is held during two or more broken periods, such periods are cumulative. Grant of temporary (and war substantive) rank is made wef 92nd in those cases (or wef 183rd day in the cases of colonels and brigadiers).
- (c) Periods of paid acting rank retained under the provisions of GRO 706 of 1944, para 5 (c) are reckonable towards grant of temporary (and war substantive) rank.
- (d) Periods of unpaid acting rank are NOT reckonable towards grant of temporary rank.
- (e) Grant of temporary rank is made to CANADIAN officers after paid acting rank has been held for 181 days, wef 182nd day.
- (f) Where 2/Lieuts are not recommended for promotion to the war substantive rank of Lieut after six months' commissioned service, units MUST ensure that GHQ 2nd Echelon is so notified.
- (g) Where promotion of 2/Lieuts to the war substantive rank of Lieut is claimed by virtue of other rank service, full details of such service, and the dates between which different ranks were held, must be stated.

4. LIAP.

Separate instructions are being issued in GROs, concerning the procedure to be adopted when an officer who holds a command, staff, etc, appointment proceeds on LIAP. Meantime, the foregoing rules will apply. When separate instructions are issued, they will be read in conjunction with this instruction, and where they conflict, GROs will be compelled with.

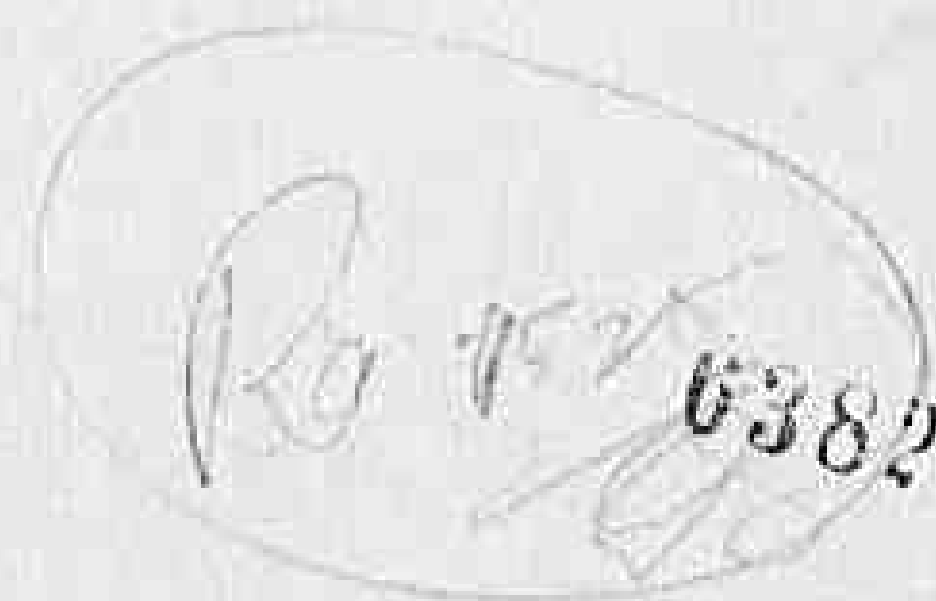

1. GRO 1336 is being superseded by a new GRO now in publication.
2. The provisions of this new GRO are similar to those of GRO 1336 except as in para 3 below.
3. If, after full consideration, Commanding officers find it necessary in the interests of military efficiency, to promote individuals who do not come within the terms of para 4 of GRO 1336/45, they may promote up to and including the rank of sergeant without reference to GHQ 2nd Echelon. Normally promotion should not be given to individuals with less than 2 months to serve with their unit. Acting ranks thus granted will be subject to reversion in the event of suitable War Substantive NCOs becoming available on X(IV) list and being posted in by GHQ 2nd Echelon.

SUBJECT:- Transfer of Subaltern
Officers to RASC

List 'B'

1. The War Office has agreed that Subaltern Officers of Royal Armoured Corps, Royal Artillery, Infantry, Pioneer Corps and General List who are within one month of their release, may be considered for transfer to, or service with, the Royal Army Service Corps if they elect to defer their normal release for six months or later, under the terms of GRC 451/45. Free at Capbadgas will be retained by officers whose applications are successful.
 2. Such officers if eligible for PYTHON would similarly be required to waive their PYTHON rights for 6 months or over.
 3. Officers having knowledge of Supplies, Petrol, or Rations, would find any such knowledge advantageous, although this is not essential.
 4. The attention of all such officers is invited to the fact that they will be entitled to Corps Pay in accordance with Para 362 of the Royal Warrant for Pay should they transfer to the RASC, or Para 332 of the Royal Warrant for Pay in the case of Officers not transferring, but being posted for duty within the WE of an RASC unit.
 5. Initial nominal Rolls will be signalled to reach G-1(Br) Section this Headquarters not later than 2 Feb 46 and thereafter names will be submitted by Signal as each individual officer volunteers.

Sir,

At UDINE on the 19 April 46 about 1010 hrs I was on duty in VIA AMILO MARCO VOLPE accompanied by L/C. WALTHOUSE C.M. POLICE, where I saw WD CHEVROLET STAFF CAR n°5905874 stationary unattended in front of the ARIVITA CAMP.

I kept the vehicle under observation for about (20) twenty minutes, after which time the above mentioned soldier appeared and stated to me he was the driver of the vehicle.

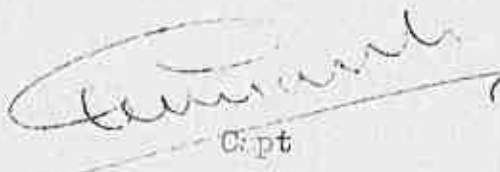
