The head of family clause does not apply in 13 Corps Area where special CLB rates are in force (see GRO 88/46). There is no reason why he should not be given the maximum basic wage of his grade, and that, together with CLB will give him 11700 Lire per month if category 3 and 10400 if category 4.

It is regretted that it is not possible to pay an employee in Udine, Trieste Province rates of pay.

1. We have already talked to you of NERIO NARDO, Via Chiusura 81, BRESCIA, who has requested to be employed as foreman.
2. NARDO, 54 years old has many years technical experience and is a good organizer. For 40 years he has dealt with vehicles. He has worked in FRANCE with DELAFE, RENAULT, CITROEN etc. as Motor Tester. He has run a garage in AIX-les-BAIN, with a repair Wksp for 17 years. He bought vans in bad condition which he repaired and sold. He left FRANCE when the war was declared and was employed at the GENIO MILITARE, MILANO as tester of engines which were delivered by the various firms.
3. These particulars and the conversations we have had with him have persuaded us of his real value.
4. We have an extreme need of skilled ~~and~~, authoritative and directive personnel (his age is a favourable element for the exercise of authority), in order that our possibilities should be augmented and improved. ✓
5. With effect from Monday 16 Jul 45, NARDO will be employed on trial at Wksp Section, as foreman.

 - (b) Having heard that a son of his, sailor and P.O.W. of the Germans was on the island of ELBA, he asked the OC of the G.K. Mot to request him as tradesman for the Wksp. The OC answered that he would try to fulfill his wish, but NARDO was to become a member of the FASCIST Republican Party.
 - (c) He became a temporary member of this Party and was authorised to go and work where his son was a P.O.W.
 - (d) His son had already been sent to Germany and he requested four times that he should be released but was told that such a request would be only met if he would persuade his son to enlist in the Black Brigade.
 - (e) He would not agree to this and his son is still in Germany.
 - (f) In order to save a number of young men from the Army he made them be employed at the G.K. Mot. Actually it is more correct to say that he employed them as he was charged with such duties, alleging nonexistent requirements.

- (g) He got out of prison 12 of his dependents who had been taken prisoner, stating that they were absolutely necessary for his work.
- (h) He always stated that the many sabotages were shortcomings of unskilled personnel.
- (i) All this and his direct participation in the obstruction of repairs, reduced the output to only 15 engines a day. He was therefore dismissed and with him approx 20 workmen (whom he had employed in order to save them from the Army) as they were found useless. After his dismissal the output went up to 40 engines a day.
- (j) If apparently his attitude towards the Germans was respectful, this was due to the fact that he feared to make the situation of his son worse, such situation had already been imperiled by his refusal to make him enlist in the Black Brigade.
- (k) He did not convert his temporary membership to the Republican Fascist Party in a standing membership.

12. Would you please get AMG to make enquiries on the subject (through its own channels and the Committee of National Liberation and to give its views on the question whether NARDO can be employed at M3 Wisp or not.

13. NARDO has a document released by the Committee of National Liberation of BRISQIA stating that he is in temporary release. He states that the newspapers have issued a communique according to which whoever was in temporary release is to be considered definitely cleared.

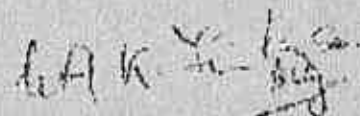

5. Group VII. Unskilled lab may be emp on the authority of Head of Service or his authorised delegates. Payment will be made out of imprest account and charged to the normal vote. (By IMA Comd Down Mags and Welfare Centro non vote LIR imprest account holders).

The following are not a charge against the public and may not therefore be paid out of Unit Imprest Accounts.

- (a) Barbers and Gardeners.
- (b) Employees of MAFI/EPI or employees in Hotels, Clubs or hostels controlled by MAFI/EPI.
- (c) Mess cooks, waiters and Ord rlies emp in excess of 12 unless special authority has been granted, in accordance with para 3 (b) hereof.
