1. It has been reported that there are in this theatre, a considerable number of men whose civilian trade is that of Bricklayer, who have so far not been offered a Class "D" Release as a Bricklayer or nominated for reversion to UK under the BRICKLOAN scheme.
2. It is desired to obtain details of all such men in this theatre, so that the matter may be taken up with the War Office.
3. Nominal rolls of men who claim to have been Bricklayers in civil life, who have so far not been offered Class "D" Release, or who have not been nominated for reversion to UK under BRICKLOAN Scheme, will be fwd to this HQ as soon as possible, and not later than 1200 hrs 27 Jun 46, and will show the following details:-

(a)	Army Number
(b)	Rank
(c)	Name
(d)	Regiment or Corps
(e)	Unit
(f)	Name of names of Brickmaking firms by whom employed.
(g)	Duration of employment
4. After nominal rolls have been despatched, no further action will be taken until instructions are received from this HQ.
5. It must be clearly understood by all concerned that forwarding of names to this HQ in no way implies promise of a Class "D" Release at any time in the future.

1. Authority has been given under War Office/O i/c Records Cable/Letter dated 31 Oct. 1945 for the release of the above named under Class 'B' Release for employment as MINER 2874434 AND TRAWLE COLLS GILFARW GOCH.
2. Please ascertain that subject to 'military necessity' clause (vide Regulations for Release from the Army 1945, para 320-321):-

- (a) The above named is willing to be released under Class 'B' and eligible. (+)
- (b) If willing and eligible, arrangements should be made for him to be medically examined and report furnished on AF W3149.
- (c) If medically fit, a certificate as follows should be obtained from him:-

- 3. Please report to this HQ by the quickest possible means available the result, i.e., whether 'operationally vital', 'unwilling', 'medically unfit' or 'available'.
- 4. If the soldier is willing, eligible, medically fit and available, a copy of the report (called for in para 3 above) must be sent to the Transit Camp to which the soldier is despatched for onward routing to UK.
- 5. Should the above named be unwilling for such release, he will sign a certificate of 'unwillingness' in accordance with AMHQ Release Instructions 1945, para 32, and such certificate will be forwarded to GHQ 2nd Echelon without delay.

PART II. APPLICABLE ONLY IF SOLDIER WILLING, ELIGIBLE, MEDICALLY FIT AND AVAILABLE.

- 1. If willing, eligible, medically fit and available :-
The above named should be despatched immediately for onward routing to UK in order to revert to HOME ESTABLISHMENT and the following action taken by you:-

- (d) Employer will not be shown in the case of 'Bulk' Release.
- (e) Provide the OR with AF W5153 (Document of Authority) for completion as far as possible. The form will be endorsed at the head in RED (BLOCK LETTERS) "CLASS 'B' RELEASE".

- (a) The above named is willing to be released under Class 'B' and eligible. (+)
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 (c) If medically fit, a certificate as follows should be obtained from him:-

 Employer will not be shown in the case of 'Bulk' Release.
 (d) Provide the OR with AF W5133 (Document of Authority) for completion as far as possible. The form will be endorsed at the head in RED (BLOCK LETTERS) "CLASS 'B' RELEASE".
 (e) Report on AF W3011A or 3012A that date on which the OR is struck off strength of the unit.
 (f) Despatch AF W 3149 and 'Certificate of Willingness' to GHQ 2nd Echelon CMF.

2. The procedure for the voyage, disembarkation and disposal in UK will be as laid down in ACI 74/44 except that the provisions of para 4(o) of the ACI will be waived for this purpose.

3. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ANY SOLDIER PROCEEDING TO UK FOR RELEASE UNDER CLASS 'B' RELEASE BE INCLUDED IN, OR ATTACHED TO, TRAFS PROCEEDING HOME ON CLASS 'A' RELEASES. ALL DOCUMENTATION WILL BE EFFECTED AS FOR PERSONNEL RETURNING TO UK ON DUTY. ATTENTION IS DRAWN TO BAGGAGE LABELS WHICH WILL BE PLAIN WHITE.
