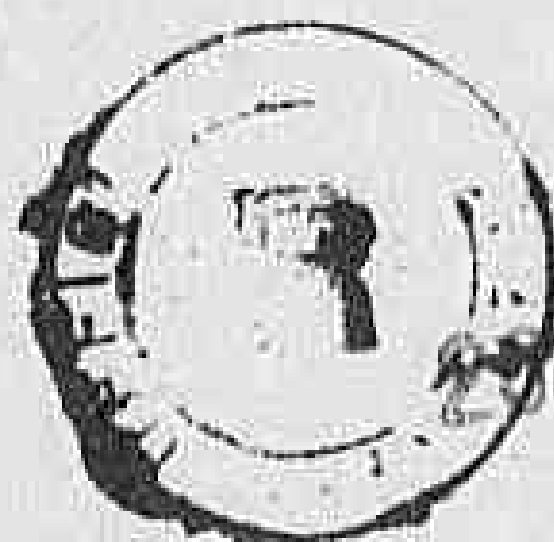

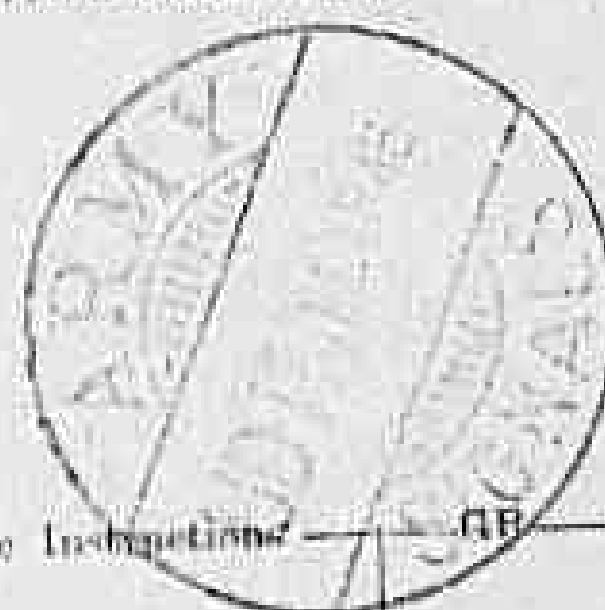

1. It is suggested that if Para 1 of your above-quoted letter is put into operation in its entirety, it will cut across the normal AMG and Civilian Customs.
2. I understand from AMG UDINE Province that the principle on which they work is that they (AMG UDINE Prov) are authorised to issue passes into V.G. to any civilian residing in the Province of UDINE, without reference to V.G.P.F. Any civilian residing in a Province outside AMG Control and who wishes to enter V.G., must obtain a pass from V.G.P.F. through his own Questura.
3. So as to maintain uniformity I would recommend that the present system of issuing passes to Military personnel who reside in UDINE Province be retained. The object of the original scheme whereby this HQ was authorised to sign passes on behalf of AMG was merely to save time and paper work. Military passes authorised by this HQ are always endorsed in the first instance by the Chief of Staff or a head of a Directorate at 5 Territorial Command.

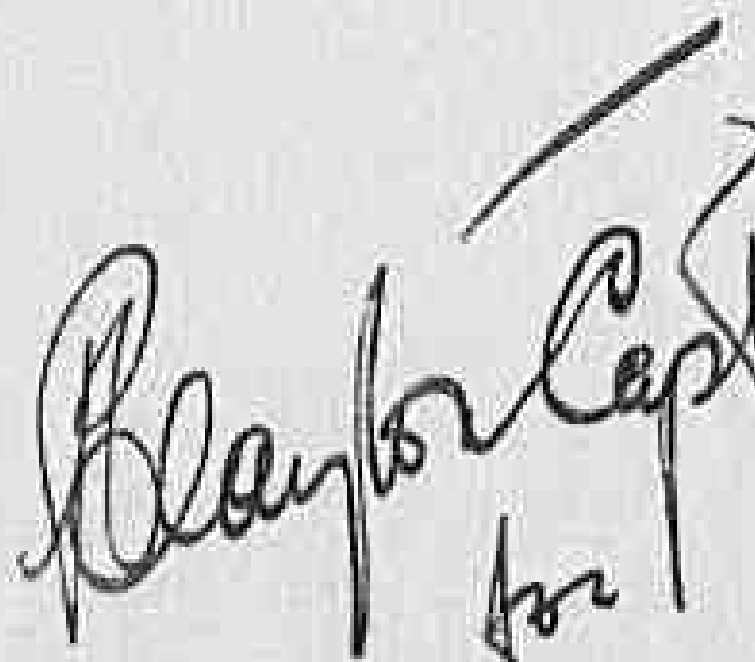
