Refer to AQ/59/447 of July 17th 1946.

Research carried out by this HQ so as to trace the place of the above German serviceman has not been successful.

As unanimously stated by the Municipality, the Parish and Carabinieri HQ of OUDROIPO, only 6 corpses have been exhumated all over the territory of that country-town and recognized as Germans from the regs of their uniforms. Out of them, only one had the identity disk with the following indications:-

"Erfassungsmark No. 75 0 W w. E. Abt 1/stb schu"

which are other than the data (that have been) reported.

But it is not excluded that Dethard may be one of the remaining soldiers unidentified for lack of identity disk.

Report on the travel to Rome and Piedimonte d'Alife
with the 15 H n. 511. Driver It. Pvt. Maturani.

I started from Bergamo the 13th, passed the night near Arezzo reached Rome the 14th where I stopped on leave. The truck went on on duty to Piedimonte. There had been some troubles with the petrol which did not arrive to the motor regularly and there was quite a lot of pinking up-hill.

The truck was supposed to be back the evening of the 18th and we should have started in the morning of the 19th. But the truck did not arrive and the morning of the 19th the driver rung me up from a place near to Frosinone saying that on the way down he had had some troubles with the battery and had to have it charged; but the morning of the 19th the truck had the battery flat again on account of the dynamo which wasn't working properly, he had it repaired by a civilian workshop and charged again the battery. The evening on the way back after I saw the car had stopped again. He couldn't find out where was the next recovery section. He had already spent some money. I told him that if it was just for something of no importance and that he could have the truck repaired in a short time, to go to a civilian workshop. He assured me that the matter would be of little importance and that he would have been able to be in Rome in the evening. He rung me up again the following evening the 20th, saying that he had broken down again, had been obliged to tow the truck back to Frosinone and had to spend for it a lot of money.

I told him to stop in the truck and wait for me. The driver had spent 2000 liras for the repairs and 200 for a new coil, I spent 100 liras for a tip to a worker who had helped me to repair the truck.

3. The first intimation that the BLU had of these letters was when either (a) an officer of HQ LEGNANO Gruppo came over to the BLU to enquire about one of them, and it was found that the BLU had never received it;

or (b) the letter was re-directed back to the BLU some days later by HQ 59 Area.

4. 1. Territorial HQ.

- (a) Represent authority of War Ministry and General Staff throughout area of responsibility.
- (b) A Branch matters and discipline beyond the scope of lower fun HQ (incl tys under allied operational comd).
- (c) Responsibility for safe custody and accounting of all Italian military stores.

3. Depots (Record Centres) are the homes and record centres of Italian regts. Their function incl :-

- (a) Soldier's record while he is in the army.
- (b) Clothing and arming the soldier when he is first called up: vice versa on demob.
- (c) Forming personnel into units when required, incl units for Allies.
- (d) Records of all arms and eqpt issued to units.
- (e) Holding stocks of clothing, unit and personal eqpt etc.
- (f) Regtl adm and records.

NOTES: Functions at 3(b) and (c) are being performed by the Allies under present circumstances. The clothing referred to in serial 3(o) is known as III clothing.

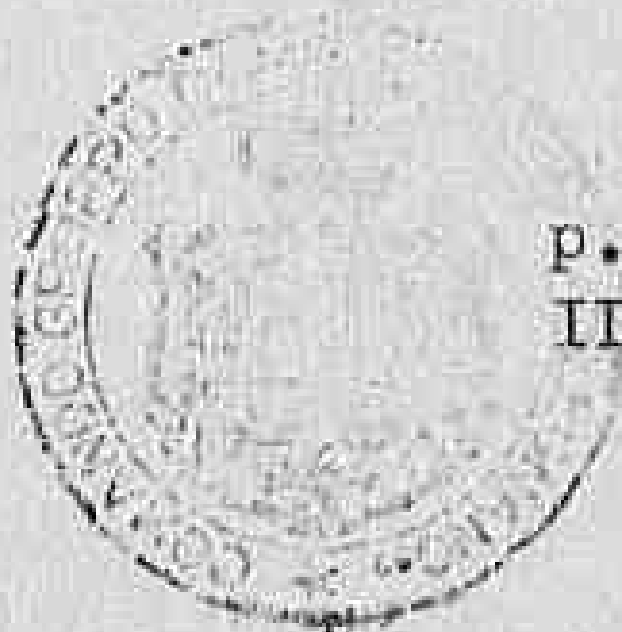

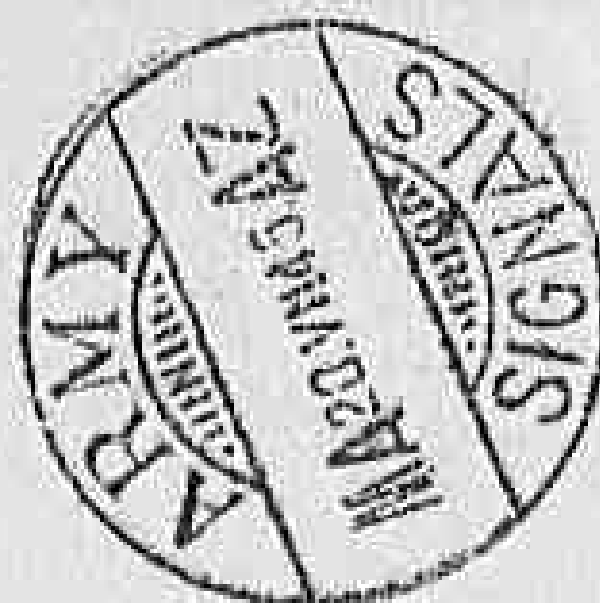

The undersigned Capt GRICO MARCELLO, Judge on the Court Martial Centre of "LIGNANO" Div reports as follows:

After 2 years of absence from home, due to the exigencies of military service with Allied units (called up on the 26th August 1943 I did not know the Germans nor the Fascists after 8th of September) I found my house and chattels destroyed due to an Air Raid. But what was most painful to know was that my own son (18 yrs old) GIAMPINO was a POW of the Allied troops in the POW cage W.P. 209 at ARNOLDIA (under the command of 12 Allied Military HQ: CASERTA).

From several reports as well as from my wife, I learnt that my family was subject to retaliations by the Republican Government after the 8th September 1943, since they considered me as a traitor. My family lived at LIGNANO, Via Mercadante. All their means of livelihood were taken away from them and my son, whose age group was 1926, was called up by the Republican Army. After suffering various hardships and in fear of further retaliations against the family and especially his brother ALBERTO (not yet 16 years old) who later on succeeded in escaping aided by Partisans, my son GIAMPINO joined the 10th MAS "BARBARICO" Bn. He did not take part in any mopping up operations of Partisans but was sent into the line, where he was later taken POW.
