Your signals 0044 and 0702 reference Italian POW returning to Trieste are acknowledged.

Before commenting on your proposals regarding priority signals it would perhaps be better to explain the procedure in force here for repatriation of Italian P.O.W.

Primarily it must be pointed out that this Division never gets any prior notification of the impending arrival of these men. Moreover the Juco-Illy Authorities, not noted for their cooperation with this H.Q. have a habit of so arranging movement that these unfortunate men usually arrive during the night. No. 17 Displaced Persons Centre - Trieste which handles this movement is a Transit Centre only and few facilities exist for exhaustive re-clothing, etc. In consequence the men are medically examined, mainly for infectious diseases and after bathing and feeding are sent on by the first available train to Udine where arrangements are such that they are attended and succoured by Displaced Persons Staff and Italian Red Cross at No. 18 Displaced Persons Centre there (O.C. Major Ormesher - telephone Udine 1526).

There is one exception to this procedure. For P.O.W. for Trieste, Pola and Gorizia are not sent to Udine, which would be a waste of time, but are sent direct to their homes after being helped in clothing by the local Italian Red Cross. These men are always advised to report to the Ufficio Sostegno Militari (Zone "A" area for "Distretto Militare") here so no doubt the Comando Territoriale Udine would receive particulars ultimately.

The movement of Italian P.O.W. from Trieste to Udine is always preceded by a telephone call to Displaced Persons

Your signals 0044 and 0702 reference Italian POW returning to Trieste are acknowledged.

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The movement of Italian P.O.W. from Trieste to Udine is always preceded by a telephone call to Displaced Persons Centre Udine thus if 5 B.L.U. could make arrangements with No. 18 Centre Udine they could be aware of impending arrival of P.O.W. considerably earlier than would be the case if they were to await arrival of a signal via A.M.G. Trieste - M.M.I.A. Rome - .

However to make sure this Office will phone B.L.U. with which unit relations have always been cordial.

If after this explanation you consider priority signal essential this office will gladly oblige. For your interest a broadcast is always made by this Division from Radio Trieste by which means it is hoped families of P.O.W. can get more news for their reception than this office does from the Jugo-Slavs!

As a matter of interest about 25,000 ex Italian P.O.W. have been repatriated via Trieste Displaced Persons Centre and the good work still goes on. Any suggestions you may have regarding this work will gladly be considered by this office.
