(c) Italian District Deps deal with the appropriate Allied HQ on 'G' and 'Q' matters. On 'I' matters they deal with the appropriate Territorial HQ.

LIAISON

FUNCTIONS OF TERRITORIAL HQ, DISTRICTS & REGTS.

1. Territorial HQ.

- (a) Represent authority of War Ministry and General Staff throughout area of responsibility.
- (b) A French authority and discipline beyond the scope of Lower Army HQ (local HQ under Allied operational control).
- (c) Responsibility for safe custody and accounting of all Italian military stores.
- (d) Regs of services not to the staff are responsible for any of services in the area.
- (e) Org and op of Districts, Regts, batts and other mil units.
- (f) Supervision and org of call-up and demob.
- (g) Admin and discipline of Italian 10 GPs.

2. Districts constitute the mil documentation and admin centres through which the civilian citizens or leave the Army. Essential functions are :-

- (a) Maintenance of conscription and callings-up of classes.
- (b) Issue and recall of reserves.
- (c) Assistance to families of men killed, wounded or taken prisoner.
- (d) Payments of allowances to dependents of active mil (Hqs).
- (e) Records of junior reserve officers.
- (f) Settlement of claims and compensation for MRE and GPs.

3. Regts (Record Centres) are the base and record centres of Italian regts. Their functions are :-

- (a) Soldier's record while he is in the Army.
- (b) Clothing and issuing the soldier when he is first called up: when verse or demob.
- (c) Forwarding personnel into units when required, local units for Allies.
- (d) Records of all arms and eqpt issued to units.
- (e) Making stocks of clothing, unit and personal eqpt etc.
- (f) Regtl admin and records.

NOTE:

Functions of 3(b) and (c) are being performed by the Allies under present circumstances. The clothing referred to in serial 3(c) is known as XVI clothing.

1. Confidentiality

- (a) Represent authority of War Ministry and General Staff throughout area of responsibility.
- (b) A branch matters and discipline beyond the scope of lower level (and the under Allied operational staff).
- (c) Responsibility for safe custody and accounting of all Italian military stores.
- (d) Regs of services att to the staff are responsible for any of services in the area.
- (e) Org and op of Districts, Regiments, Bataillons, Regiments and other military units.
- (f) Supervision and any of call-up and demobilization.
- (g) Adv and discipline of Italian in the area.

2. Districts constitute the all documentation and administrative functions through which the citizens enter or leave the army. Administrative functions are:-

- (a) Machinery of conscription and collection of classes.
- (b) Death and recall of reserves.
- (c) Assistance to families of men killed, wounded or taken prisoner.
- (d) Payments of allowances to dependents of officers and men.
- (e) Records of junior reserve officers.
- (f) Settlement of claims and compensation for loss and damage.

3. Regiments (Regimental Companies) are the basic and second centers of Italian regts. Their functions are:-

- (a) Soldier's record while he is in the army.
- (b) Clothing and issuing the soldier when he is first called up: viz: issue on demobilization.
- (c) Furnishing personnel into units when required, incl units for allies.
- (d) Records of all men and equipment issued to units.
- (e) Holding stocks of clothing, mail and personal effects etc.
- (f) Regtal adv and records.

Notes: Functions at 3(b) and (c) are being performed by the Italian under present circumstances. The clothing referred to in serial 3(e) is known as VII clothing.
