GENERAL STAFF INSTRUCTION NO 14

(Cancelling General Staff Instruction No. 13)

Summary

1. G(St), Hq 2 District is divided into two parts:-
 - (a) G(St), - Issues, War Establishments, Orders of Battle and Location Statements.
 - (b) G(StS) - J(St) Controlled Stores including vehicles.
2. In correspondence the distinction between the two sub-divisions will be carefully observed so.
3. This instruction deals with the functions of G(StS) only, and with the procedure for obtaining and disposing of J(St) controlled Stores and 'A' and 'B' Vehicles.

OBJECT

4. The object of Staff control of equipment and vehicles is to ensure that available stocks are used to the best advantage and in conformity with operational policy.

DEFINITION

5. Controlled Stores for the purpose of this instruction include all vehicles (incl trailers) and the items of equipment listed at Appendix 'A'. These are the only stores controlled by G(StS). The release of components and spare parts of the above is NOT controlled by G(StS).

ENTITLEMENT

6. The scales of entitlement are those shown in the various Staff Equipment Tables. When there is a difference of entitlement between the "A" or "B" scales, and the Staff Equipment Table the latter is the operative document.

7. Staff Equipment Tables are issued through service channels - see GAO 75e/10. Any queries regarding entitlement will be referred to the Ordnance Branch of the area or Sub Area in which the unit is located.

DEMANDS

8. The following principles will apply in the submission of demands:-
 - (a) Demands will be made weekly to arrive at Hq 2 District on the following days unless otherwise ordered:-

3. This instruction deals with the functions of G(SD2) only, and with the procedures for obtaining and disposing of G(SD2) controlled stores and 'A' and 'B' Vehicles.

OBJECT

4. The object of Staff control of equipment and vehicles is to ensure that available stocks are used to the best advantage and in conformity with operational policy.

DEFINITION

5. Controlled stores for the purpose of this instruction include all vehicles (incl trailers) and the items of equipment listed at Appendix 'A'. These are the only stores controlled by G(SD2). The release of components and spare parts of the above is NOT controlled by G(SD2).

ENTITLEMENT

6. The rules of entitlement are those shown in the various Staff Equipment tables. When there is a difference of entitlement between the HQ or G 1050 scales, and the Staff Equipment Table the latter is the operative document.

7. Staff Equipment tables are issued through service channels - see GAG 754/34. Any queries regarding entitlement will be referred to the Ordnance Branch of the HQ or Sub HQ in which the unit is located.

DETAILS

8. The following principles will apply in the submission of demands:-

(a) Demands will be made weekly to arrive at HQ 2 District on the following days unless otherwise ordered:-

For vehicles .. Saturdays
For controlled stores - Thursdays

(u) Demands will be made on the published proformas.

(c) Demands will be made ONCE ONLY, and periodical demands WILL NOT include items previously demanded. Demands will be cancelled automatically after 3 months, and items may then be redemanded, the fact that they have been previously demanded being clearly stated.

- (a) Transient Units and Units - C(SD2) HQ 2 District will normally deal direct with:-

Corps
Divisions
Independent Bases

In other areas Areas and Sub Areas will investigate the requirements of transient units, and may if necessary, recommend that they be dealt with direct by C(SD2) HQ 2 District. This procedure will NOT be adopted unless:-

- (i) The replacement of deficient items is a matter of operational urgency
and/or (ii) The matter is unusually complicated
and (iii) Suitable communications exist to the unit from HQ 2 District.

Preference is above will be used. One copy only is required by C(SD2). One copy will be sent to Ord HQ 2 District. Transient Units and Units will submit a complete list of their requirements on arrival in 2 District, and will thereafter submit additions or amendments to reach HQ 2 District on the days specified in para 8(a).

- (b) Static Units and Units.

A list of plans and units authorized to deal direct with C(SD2) HQ 2 District regarding controlled stores will be published periodically. Demands will be prepared in a similar manner to that described in para 4(b), above. A copy of all demands will be sent to Ord HQ 2 District. Units whose vehicles are C(SD2) Maintenance responsibility will send a copy of vehicle demands to the S and T Branch of the Area or Sub Area concerned.

- (c) All demands for vehicles to be held on the Staff and Services Pool Area (including Chaplains vehicles) will be made to C(SD1) this HQ.

VEHICLE DEMANDS THROUGH SERVICE CHANNELS

12. (a) Vehicle demands by the undermentioned units which do not form a part of Area dealing direct with HQ 2 District under para 11 will be submitted through service channels under arrangements to be made by the head of each service:-

- (i) RE Units other than in Units - By C
(ii) RA-30 Units - By DIST

- (b) Demands will be prepared in a similar manner to that described in para 10(b) above. Priority will be decided by the head of each service at HQ 2 District. Only one copy is required by

Procedures as above will be used. One copy only is required by G(SD2). One copy will be sent to Ord Hq 2 District. Prominent items (a) units will submit a complete list of their requirements on arrival in 2 District, and will thereafter submit additions or amendments to reach Hq 2 District on the days specified in para 5(2).

(b) Static Units and Units.

A list of static and units authorized to deal direct with G(SD2) Hq 2 District regarding controlled stores will be published periodically. Demands will be prepared in a similar manner to that described in para 10(b) above. A copy of all demands will be sent to Ord Hq 2 District. Units whose vehicles are G(SD2) Maintenance responsibility will send a copy of vehicle demands to the S and T Branch of the area or Sub Area concerned.

(c) All demands for vans to be held on the Staff and Services Pool (the (including Chaplaine vehicles) will be made to G(SD1) this Hq.

VEHICLE DEMANDS THROUGH SERVICE CHANNELS

12. (a) Vehicle demands by the undermentioned units which do not form a part of vans dealing direct with Hq 2 District under para 11 will be submitted through service channels under arrangements to be made by the units on each service:-

(b) Demands will be prepared in a similar manner to that described in para 10(b) above. Priority will be decided by the head of each service at Hq 2 District. Only one copy is required by G(SD2) Hq 2 District. One copy will be forwarded to Ord Hq 2 District.

(c) Demands for units mentioned in sub para (a) for controlled stores other than vehicles will be submitted through the G and Branch of the area or Sub Area in which the units are located.

 14. All Certificates will NOT accompany demands on C(SD2), except in the case of units authorized to deal direct with HQ 2 District. For dealing direct with C(SD2) will certify that BLK certificates equivalent to their demands be held by them.

PRIORITIES

15. The following priorities will be used throughout 2 District in dealing with controlled stores and vehicles.

Priority I.

Meaning that the items concerned are required for operational purposes at the earliest possible time. A demand of this priority will be supported by an authority and will quote a date by which the items are required.

Priority II.

Meaning that the items demanded are essential for the proper functioning of the unit, and that in the interest of efficiency release should be made as soon as practicable.

Priority III.

Meaning that the items demanded although a necessary part of the unit's equipment, that no serious repercussions will result if release is delayed, to allow higher priority issues being made.

REQUISITIONED VEHICLES

16. (a) Power to authorize the requisitioning of vehicles for all British Army units within 2 District is vested in G(SD2) HQ 2 District.

(b) No attempt will be made to requisition vehicles until the necessary authority has been obtained. Requisitioning will be carried out by the Ord Branch of the area or Sub area concerned.

(c) Requisitioned cars will be held against the VE allowance of cars. Load-carrying vehicles will not be requisitioned.

(d) Requisitioned cars will not be removed from the country of origin without the approval of JHQ.

(e) Army/Sub Areas will not requisition vehicles on behalf of RM establishments. Any RM establishment which makes a request for a requisitioned vehicle, whether as a new issue or against a RA certificate, will be advised to apply through normal channels to the JHQ, the Office of C-in-C and JHQ.

TRAINING

17. Transfers of vehicles and weapons between units will not be made except on the prior authority of G(SD2) HQ 2 District.

VEHICLES ON REPAIRS

18. Application for the issue of new vehicles on replacement will be made 10, 11, 12 and 13 months before the vehicles are being replaced.

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the interest of efficiency release should be made as soon as practicable.

Priority III.

Meaning that the items demanded although a necessary part of the unit's equipment, that no serious repercussions will result if release is delayed, to allow higher priority issues being made.

REQUISITIONED VEHICLES

16. (a) Power to authorize the requisitioning of vehicles for all British Army units within District is vested in G(AD2) HQ 2 District.
- (b) No attempt will be made to requisition vehicles until the necessary authority has been obtained. Requisitioning will be carried out by the Ord Branch of the area or Sub Area concerned.
- (c) Requisitioned cars will be held against the ME allowance of cars. Load-carrying vehicles will not be requisitioned.
- (d) Requisitioned cars will NOT be removed from the country of origin without the approval of AFHQ.
- (e) Area/Sub Area will NOT requisition vehicles on behalf of RM establishments. Any RM Establishment which makes a request for a requisitioned vehicle, whether as a V issue or against a V issue certificate, will be advised to apply through Naval Command to the EMTV, the Office of C-in-C Med Area.

TRUCKS

17. Ownership of vehicles and vehicles between units will NOT be made except on the prior authority of G(AD2), HQ 2 District.

VEHICLES ON REPLY

18. Application for the issue of vehicles on reply will be made through the appropriate channels as explained in paras 10, 11, 12 and 13 above, the fact that the issue is requested on the terms being clearly stated.

SUPPLY STOCKS AND MATCHES

19. (a) The holding of controlled stores and vehicles surplus to ME, now that hostilities have ceased, will be approved only in very exceptional cases. Each case must have the personal recommendation of the Provost/Area Commander concerned.

- (b) Applications will be forwarded through staff channels and be prepared in accordance with the controlled stores being kept up to date from vehicles.
- (c) On Commencing Units and Establishments are responsible that no surplus stores or vehicles are held by them without authority. Application for disposal instructions for surplus stores or vehicles will be made to the Ord Branch of the Area or Sub Area in which units are located. Before ordering the return to parks of controlled stores or vehicles the Ord Branch of Area/Sub Area will refer the matter to G(SD2) Hq 2 District.

CONTROLLED STORES OTHER THAN VEHICLES FOR TRAINING PURPOSES

20. Demands for controlled stores other than vehicles required for training purposes will be submitted through the appropriate channels as described in paras 10 and 11 above, and that they are required for training being clearly stated. Monthly releases for this purpose will be confined to approved training establishments.

UNITS RE-EQUIPPING IN 2 DISTRICT

21. Units ordered to re-equip under supervision of 2 District will communicate with the Ord Branch of Area or Sub Area in which they are located. They will then be dealt with in accordance with para 11(a) above.

FORMATION, DISBANDMENT AND CONVERSION OF UNITS

22. (a) Orders for formation, disbandment and conversion of Units are issued by 'A' Branch Hq 2 District.
- (b) Formations and units receiving such orders will consult the appropriate Ordnance Officers as follows regarding the adjustment of vehicles and equipment:-

- From mentioned in para 11(a) - Hq 2 District (unless it is found more convenient to deal with DOS of the Area/Sub Area)
- All other formations and units - DOS of the Area/Sub Area.

Resultant demands for vehicles or controlled stores will then be made through the usual channels as amplified by paras 10, 11, 12 and 13 above.

- (c) When a unit changes its location any consequent demands for vehicles or controlled stores, will be accompanied by a statement

20. Demands for controlled stores other than vehicles required for training purposes will be submitted through the appropriate channels. It is noted that they are required for stores mentioned in para 10 and 11 above, and that they are required for training being carried out. All releases for this purpose will be confined to approved training establishments.

UNITS RE-EQUIPPING IN 2 DISTRICT

21. Units ordered to re-equip will be supervised by HQ 2 District. All communications with the Ops Branch of the Area by Sub Area in which they are located. They will then be in accordance with para 11(a) above.

FORMATION, DISMANTMENT AND CONVERSION OF UNITS

22. (a) Orders for formation, dismantlement and conversion of Units are issued by the Branch HQ 2 District.

(b) Formations and units receiving such orders will consult the appropriate Ordnance Officers as follows regarding the adjustment of vehicles and equipment:-

Units mentioned in para 11(a) - HQ 2 District (unless it is found more convenient to deal with ADOS of the Area/Sub Area)

All other formations and units - ADOS of the Area/Sub Area.

Resultant demands for vehicles or controlled stores will then be made through the usual channels as amplified by paras 10, 11, 12 and 13 above.

(c) When a unit changes its location any consequent demands for vehicles or controlled stores, will be accompanied by a statement showing vehicles or controlled stores returned surplus.

(d) Attention is directed to HQ 13/15 regarding the return of stores and units being transferred.

(e) Units ordered to disband will, immediately upon receiving disbandment instruction, forward to ADOS the Form/Area, or in cases of urgency, direct to G(SB), HQ 2 District copy to ADOS Form/Area, a vehicle state showing details to be discussed of given type, make, quantity, classification and approval date available.

REPAIR OF VEHICLES - EQUIPMENT TO GO - PHS

23. (a) The repair of components from vehicles and other equipment prior to return to parks is strictly forbidden.
- (b) Attention is directed to GPO 23/44 which requires units to arrange the inspection of vehicles by an RME immediately prior to return to parks. A copy of the inspection report will be handed to the OC Park.

RELEASES

24. (a) Vehicle releases will be cancelled 14 days from the date of release unless the unit concerned is notified by the HQ Vehicle Group that the vehicles are not ready for collecting. Units which have to send a long distance to collect vehicles from parks, are advised to communicate with the HQ Vehicle Group before despatching their drivers.
- (b) Controllers stores other than vehicles will normally be despatched direct to units from the Central Depot concerned as soon as possible after release. Units will not collect unless instructed to do so.

MISSING AND FOUND VEHICLES

25. Attention is directed to GPO 10 of 1945.
- (a) No "lost" vehicles will be replaced until the action prescribed in para 10(3) of the above mentioned GPO has been completed.

- (b) With reference to para 9(a) of the above mentioned GPO, the HQ Branch of the area or sub-area concerned will apply to District G(22) for official instructions for any "found" vehicles.

CAPTURED ENEMY VEHICLES

26. (a) NO captured enemy vehicles will be held by firms or units in 2 District without authority from either :-

ADHQ
HQ BTA
HQ XIII Corps
HQ 1, 2 or 3 Districts
HQ LFC

- (b) All captured enemy vehicles in use will carry a retention certificate as per GPO 23/44 or DUC 44/15. This certificate will be posted inside the 412 of the vehicle and will be available for production to the Military Police when required. The WD No. allotted will be clearly stencilled on the vehicle.

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- (b) Controller stores stores in the vehicle will normally be despatched direct to unit on the first Depot concern. as soon as possible after release. Unit will not collect unless instructed to.

MISSING AND FOUND VEHICLES

25. Attention is directed to GAO 16 of 1242.

- (a) No "lost" vehicles will be replaced until the action prescribed in para 10(4) a. the above mentioned GAO has been completed.

- (b) With reference to para 2(c) of the above mentioned GAO, the 'loss' of the Area or Sub-Area concerned will apply to 2 Districts G(M2) for all the instructions for any "lost" vehicles.

CAPTURED ENEMY VEHICLES

26. (a) No captured enemy vehicles will be held by firms or units in 2 District without authority from either :-

HQ BTA
HQ XIII Corps
HQ 1, 2 or 3 Districts
HQ IFG

- (b) All captured enemy vehicles in use will carry a retention certificate as per GAC84/10 or D.344/10. This certificate will be pasted inside the 412 of the vehicle and will be available for production to the Military Police when required. The WD No. allotted will be clearly stencilled on the vehicle.

- (c) Captured enemy vehicles will normally be held against an allowance for a similar type of British vehicle. In very exceptional cases, a specific purpose authority may be granted to hold captured enemy vehicles surplus to WD. Recommendations for retention or release of captured enemy vehicles in excess of WD must state full reasons as to why a surplus holding is necessary. Such an authority will only be granted for strictly limited periods.

- (d) Captured enemy vehicles will NOT be taken away from the theatre. In the event of a unit being ordered to move outside the theatre with its vehicles, it will request disposal instructions for any captured vehicles in its possession from the Ord Branch of the Fm, Area/Sub-Area concerned. /8...

MIA ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS NO 28

1. OBJECT.

The object of this instruction is to define the method of:
