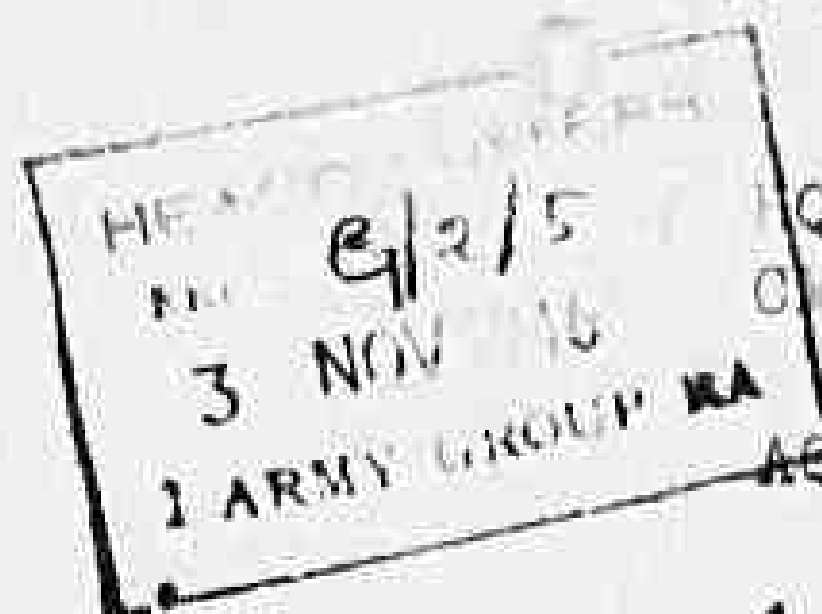

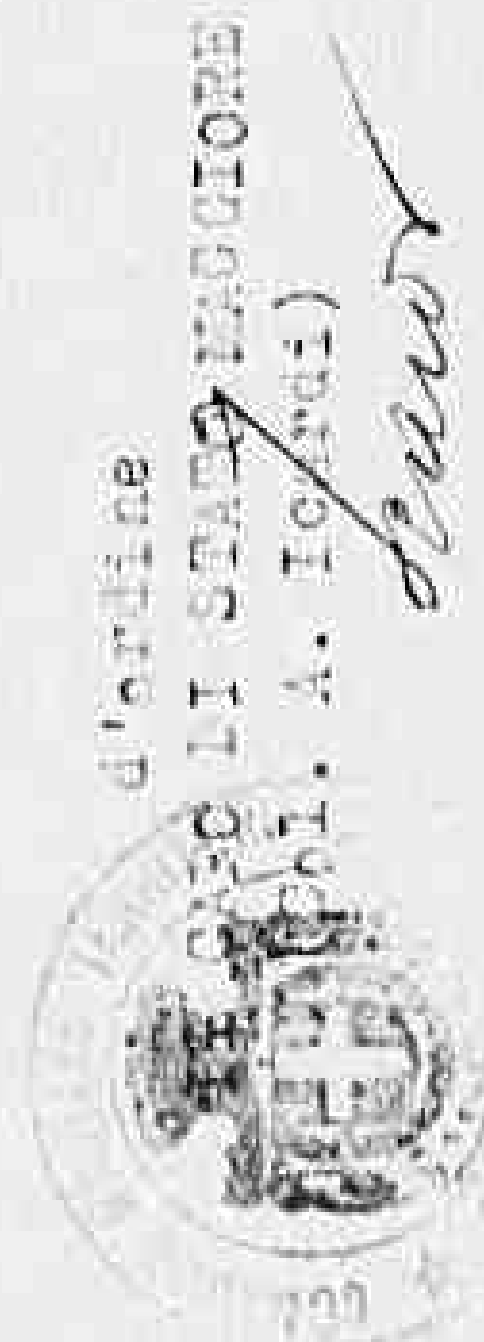

Local Military Allied Authorities require 40 servicemen, of whom 10 drivers and 10 searchlights to be employed for night-time lighting at railway-stations (.) By care of A/M Authorities a short train-course to be carried out soonest has been planned in Gaine area (.) Owing to well-known situation this Comditer has neither available nor fit personnel (.) Report on the A/M request is forwarded to Stamaggiore as to meet it eventually by taking men from another Comditer (.) A resolution on this matter is urgently needed (.) General Omar at Interim Adolfo Gelli (.)
