1. The questions reported in letter referred to above has been thoroughly studied by this S.M. -
- adaptively, the present shortages of man power in units cause various inconveniences which affect the normal carrying out of the training activity.

In order to eliminate said inconveniences, the best solution would be undoubtedly that of adopting "peace establishments" instead of the "war establishments" in force.

But in the present situation during which the organization of the army is of a temporary nature, it seems premature to adopt such "peace establishments". These could be adopted later on when the peace treaty is signed. It will be possible then to have a final organization which fits, in accordance with the clauses of the treaty and the habits, the structure of the army and its strength.

2. In view of this, we deem advisable to adopt, interim, a temporary solution which permit to cope with the difficulties deriving from the numerical deficiencies and that is, within the framework of the units.

Accordingly, this S.M. has issued instructions in circular 5034/CRA/2 dated 17th inst. (copy attached) to the Military Territorial Command.

The solution adopted:
- reduces slightly the strength of HQs, specialized and services units in order not to affect the regular function of the units.

As such all the Inf. battalions since their location has been chosen not only on the account of accommodation requirements but also because of public order requirements.

The question reported in letter referred to above has been thoroughly studied by this G-2.

As a result, the present shortage of men power in units causes various inconveniences which affect the normal carrying out of the military activity.

In order to eliminate said inconveniences, the best solution would be undoubtedly that of adopting "fixed establishments" instead of the "war establishments" in force.

But in the present situation during which the organization of the army is of a temporary nature, it seems preferable to adopt said "fixed establishments". These could be adopted later on when the peace society is signed. It will be possible then to have a final differentiation which takes, in accordance with the wishes of the army and the budget, the structure of the army into consideration.

In view of this, we deem advisable to adopt, for immediate differentiation solution which permits to cope with the different culture deriving from the numerical deficiencies and that is: to adopt the structure of the units.

Major General M. M. M. has issued instructions in circular 203/204 dated 19th Nov. (copy attached) to the Military Headquarters.

The solution adopted:

It should be noted that the structure of HQs, specialized and services units in order not to affect the regular function of the units.

It is also noted that the units, battalions since their location has been chosen for this on the account of accommodation requirements but also because of public order requirements.

SUBJECT : Reduction of the Strength of units

1. We know that with the system in force regarding the training of recruits and the formation of instructors and trainers, Approx 10% of the strength enlisted is constantly in the field and the various military schools. This affects considerably the efficiency of the units which have a strength inferior to that shown on the WLB. Various inconveniences arise, among which :-

- minor interest of commanders in the field of training.
- lack of a single procedure in the internal organization of units; since every commander adopts different solution to solve the problem of numerical deficiency.

With a view to eliminating said inconveniences, while awaiting for a new organization which permit further improvements in the present system of training of recruits (which proved very fruitful) and in the meantime complete units to WLB strength, we seem advisable to reduce the strength of units adopting principally almost unitary.

2. Although considering that the situation is different in the various Military Territorial Commands, the necessity of adopting a unique solution, as far as possible, appears evident. To this end, we show, in the enclosed table, the procedure to be followed to effect said reduction. The fact that :-

- HQ units cannot have a strength too far below the WLB (75 - 80%) otherwise their activity is affected,
- it is advisable to maintain efficient all inf bns since their location has been fixed not only because of local requirements but also for public order

SUBJECT: Reduction of the strength of units

1. To know that with the haste in terms regarding the training of personnel and the formation of instructors and teachers, special loss of the strength exhibited in conformity in the class and the various military schools. This affects considerably the efficiency of the units which have a special tendency to that extent on the side. Various inconveniences arise, among which is:-

- Shortage of personnel in the field of training.
- Lack of a simple procedure in the internal organization of units; since every commander adopts a different solution to solve the problem of operational efficiency.

With a view to eliminating such inconveniences, while awaiting for a new organization which permits further improvements in the present system of training of recruits (which proved very fruitful) and in the meantime complete units to be strengthened, we seem advisable to reduce the strength of units adopting principles almost as follows:-

2. Although considering that the situation is different in the various Military Territorial Commands, the necessity of adopting a unique solution, as far as possible, appears evident. To this end, we shall, in the enclosed table, the procedure to be followed to effect such reduction. The fact that:-

- No units cannot have a strength too far below the WE (75 - 80%) otherwise their activity is affected.
- It is advisable to maintain efficient all inf. and since their location has been fixed not only because of such requirements but also for public order requirements have been considered therein.

3. Military Territorial Commands are requested to compile a report by the 15th Dec 46 on the situation regarding the reduction in number and to give any difficulty met. Regarding maintenance and custody of weapons, instructions contained in letter 1/2043/Gen. date 1st Jan 46 are hereby confirmed. Some procedures should be adopted for the maintenance and custody of the equipment on issue.

1. COO AGIA while on a recent tour in GHAN, received certain comments on the new WE of the 3rd Pioneer Battalion in the 1st Infantry Battalion. It is considered that these comments were well founded.

2. The present WE of the 3rd Pioneer Battalion is 37 all ranks; the equivalent BRITISH WE is 37 all ranks. It is not adequate effective to fight six mortars in action.

It is strongly recommended therefore that we have an immediate amendment raising the WE of the 3rd Pioneer Battalion to the level of its BRITISH equivalent. In this connection it is suggested that personnel can readily be found either:-

- (a) From the establishment of the 1st Pioneer Battalion in the same company, which has each for a long an company with thirty four in the 1st Pioneer Battalion. It appears doubtful also whether forty men can be fact be carried in the transport provided for the 1st Pioneer Battalion; or
- (b) From the Assault Pioneer Battalion which is twenty eight strong compared with twenty two in the 1st Pioneer Battalion.

3. Transport for the 3rd Pioneer Battalion also requires adjustment. Seven light trucks are shown in the 1st Pioneer WE. This should read:

"Seven carriers fitted for 3rd Pioneer

trucks being suitable for the tactical role of the platoon.

4. It was always the intention of this WE that carriers should be provided for the transport of 3rd Pioneer Battalion. It is regretted that their omission has only now been observed.

- (a) from the establishment of the 3rd Marine Division (an platoon) in the same company, which can each form a team as compared with thirty four in the 3rd Marine Division. It appears doubtful also whether forty men can in fact be carried in the transport provided for the 3rd Marine Division; or
- (b) from the Assault Pioneer Platoon which is twenty eight strong compared with twenty two in the British Army.

3. Transport for the 3rd Marine Division also requires adjustment. Seven light trucks are shown in the MIA MIA. This should read:

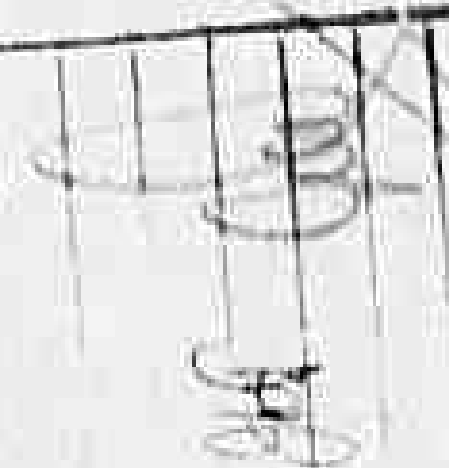

With a view to obtaining the 6 men required, it has been suggested, as an experiment, to draw:

- 3 men from the Recon Platoon (one per squad)

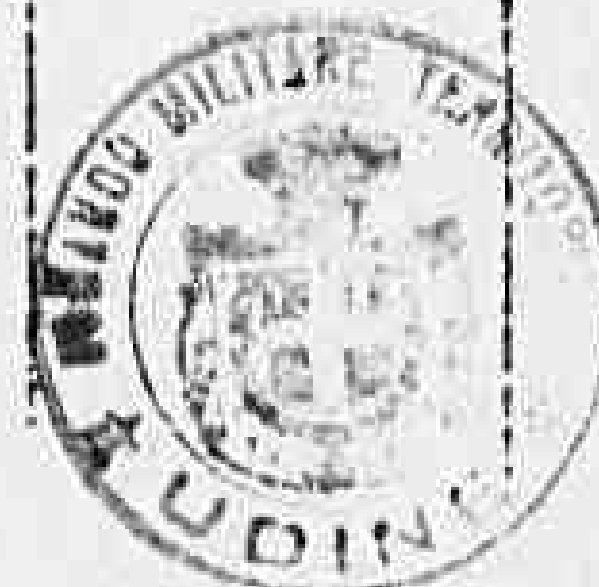

Units organised on a Peace Establishment maintained a Mobilisation Store which held all the weapons and equipment clothing etc required for use by the unit when expanded from a Peace to a War Establishment. An important responsibility for a unit commander in peace time was to ensure that such equipment was maintained in a serviceable condition and was listed and stored in such a way as to allow of speedy issue and distribution on mobilisation.

7. It is appreciated that Great Britain, having no land frontiers, did not require to have any troops in peace time at instant readiness to protect the frontier.

Should your Ministry consider the adoption of the Peace Establishment principle it is pointed out that it would be perfectly feasible to maintain some portions of the Army permanently on War Establishment while other portions were organised on a Peace Establishment.

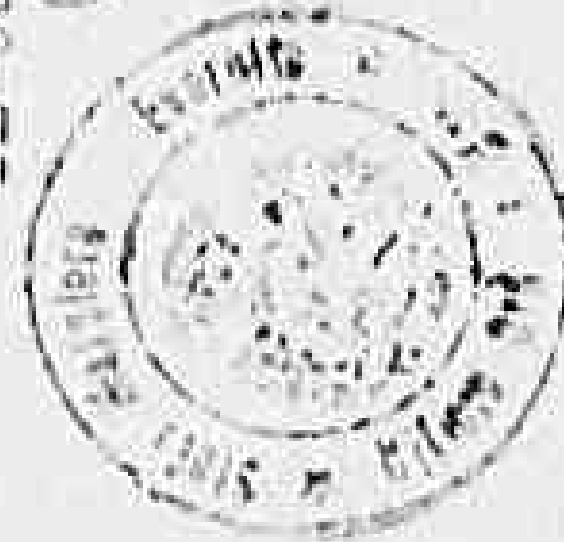

Ref your 2301/1 of 27 Apr 46.

The first period of life of the CAR under our Command has clearly shown that the actual W.E. is unfit to face the real necessities, owing also to the fact that it has been divided into MODENA and SACILE.-

On the basis of those necessities the CAR Hq. has compiled a proposal of a new W.E. as attached herewith.

No doubt that there has been a rather wide judgment in stating the need for a larger W.E., but there appears to be justified by the preoccupation of having at disposal a number of men on par with the exigencies of a new organization, which struggles its way out to a vital and definitive settlement, through its hard first trials. We agree with the above objection, but taking into consideration that the CARs should be organized the most liberally they can, for their sure and smooth running, this Hq. is forwarding on their integral reading the proposals compiled by the MODENA CAR (Appx No. 1 and No. 2).

The Ministry of War, which has to examine this matter on the ground of analogous proposals going to be laid down by the other Territorial H.Q., will take the most suitable decision about it.

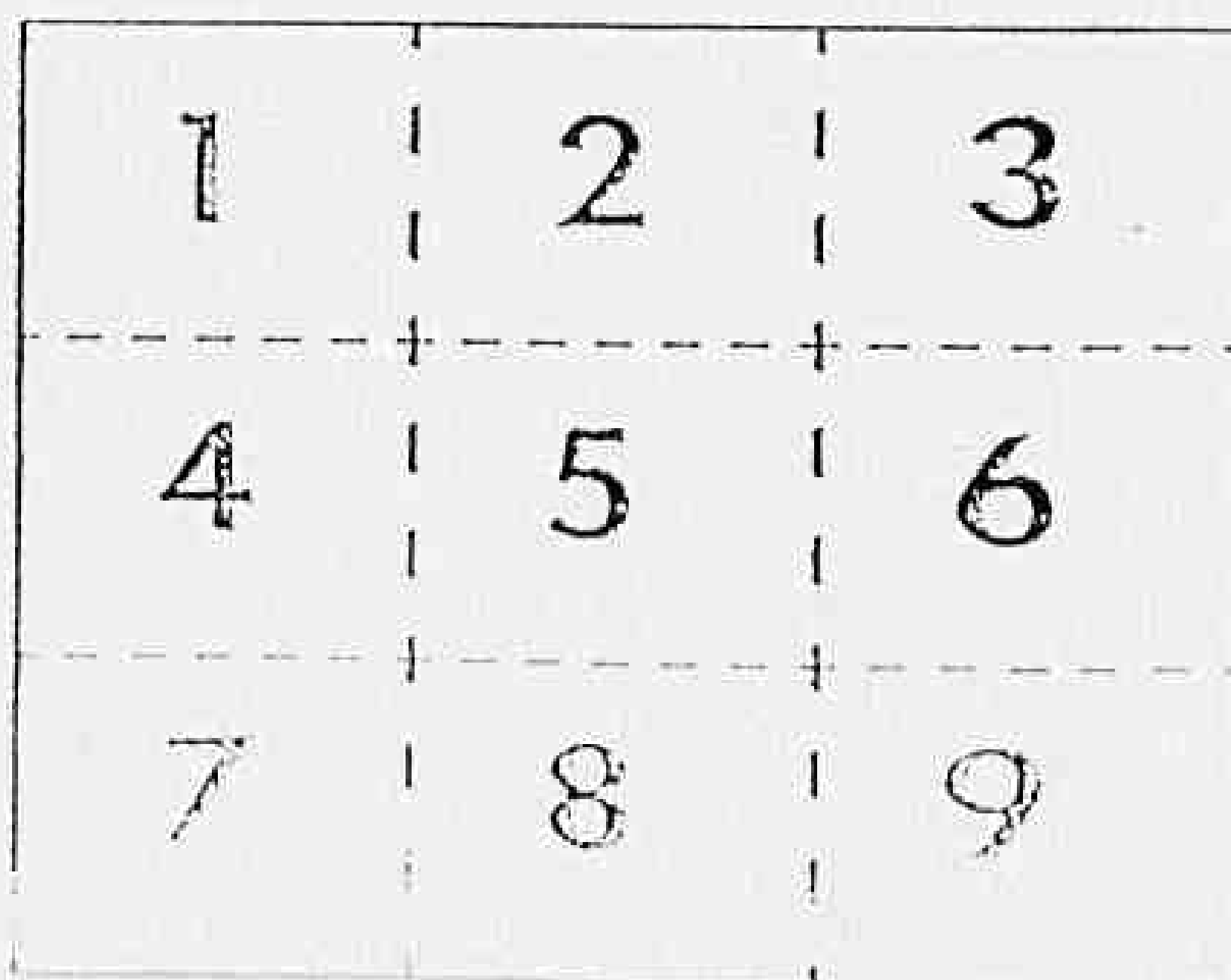
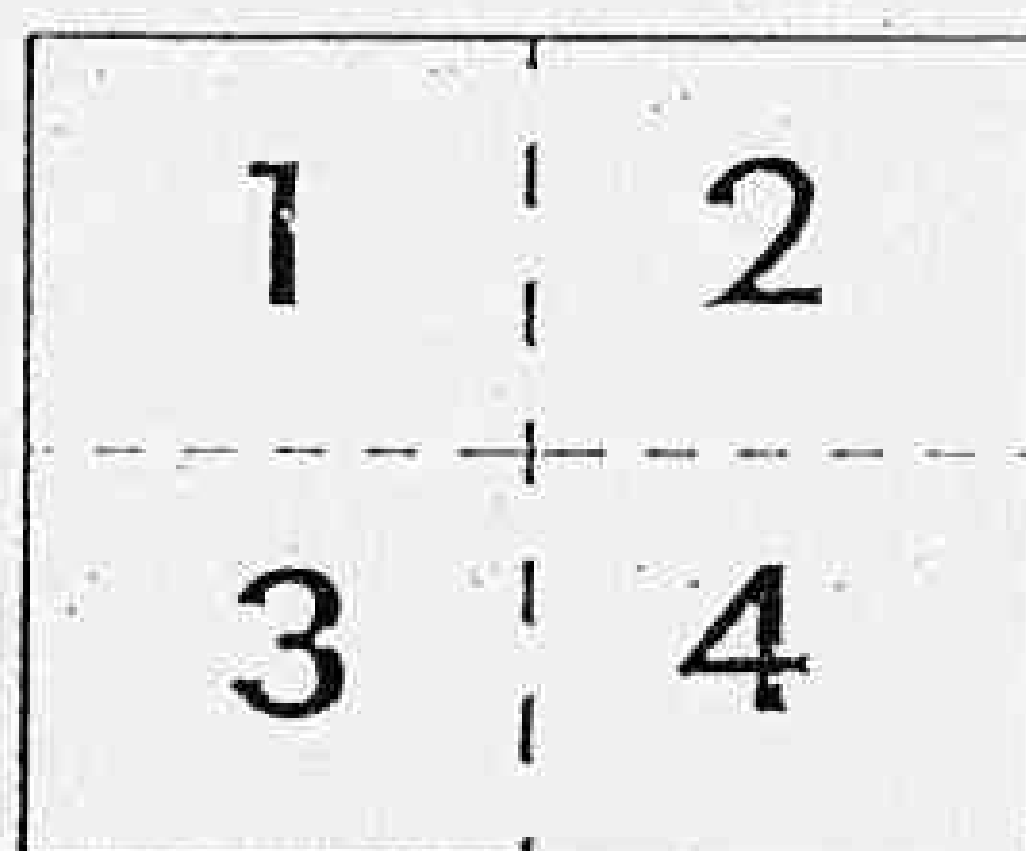
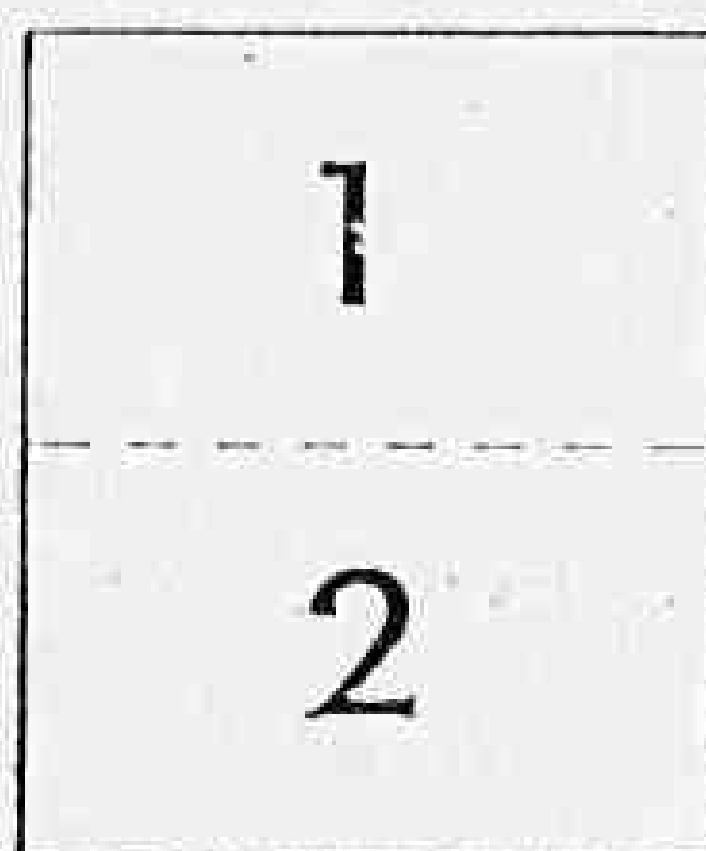

BLUs are therefore requested to keep special watch over the use and distribution of these WEs within the Terr HQs. If the system which is now working at the Ministry of War does not work in the Terr HQs it will break down, and this, it is felt, would be a serious blow to the final emergence of some form of standardized and considered model ITALIAN Army, which is the aim of this HQ.

4. Finally, this HQ is trying to instil into the minds of the War Ministry the idea that because a War Establishment is approved it does not necessarily follow that it can be automatically implemented. Terr HQs should not therefore implement the WEs until formal formation or conversion orders are received from the Ministry of War. BLUs are requested to watch this point. If Terr HQs do not keep to formation and conversion orders both the Ministry of War and this HQ will find it impossible to maintain an accurate Order of Battle.

5. The Ministry of War are at the moment preparing a memorandum to Terr HQs on the uses and functions of the WEC and on the issue etc of the new WEs. The above remarks are intended, therefore, only as an indication of this HQ's policy and feelings in the matter.
