1. As it is known, a "School for the cooperation between the various Arms" has been set up at Civitavecchia (Hq. at Gargano Palace - rooms - billets - Mess & Services in the "Duca degli Abruzzi" Barracks .-

Purpose: To develop adjournment and qualification training courses for General Officers, Colonels and Senior Officers - particularly for practicing the cooperation between the various Arms and supporting Arms, and drawing out profit from the experiences of the recent war and contributing to the creation of the new tactical practice.-

2. The organization of the school will be realized per ranks in consideration to the effective necessities of the Army and to the instructors available, as it follows :

1st time (partially on course)

a) Adjournment courses for Bn and Group's Leaders: reserved for majors and Lt.Colonels. All senior captains, who has frequented tactical, weapons and means courses in the proper Arms Schools will participate too;

b) Adjournment courses for Regts Leaders: all Colonels and Lt.Cols (senior), who have already frequented the Group Bn Leaders Courses will also partake.

c) Adjournment courses for General Officers.-

Senior Officers of Services Branch will also participate to these courses, and they will attend to the various lessons and exertations.

2nd time

Qualification courses for senior Officers practicing them in command - in relation to their promotion turn.-

3. The courses for Lt.Colonels, Majors and Captains will last 8 weeks, and it will be gradually augmented in relation to the necessities to be foreseen; officers, who will take part to it, will be gradually selected by the Territorial Hqs. on numerical designation. of this General Staff.

./.

4. The subject of this courses gives a high importance to the cooperation between the various Arms and Supporting Arms in the tactical field; the student officers will actively attend to the various discussions for the purpose of contributing with their experience to the elaboration of the war practice.-
The development of the matter is including:

a) On theoretical side:

- orientation on the tactical procedures of the British practice
- substantial instructions in the employment of various arms and services.
- Notion on the employment of new arms or new operational means.

b) On practical side:

- examination of concrete case in the field, completed by the use of the plastic.

It is presumed that as soon as the courses will start all students should already be well acquainted with:

- Knowledge of weapons and means at present in distribution
- " " actual W.E.

Therefore for the purpose of filling up eventual gaps and putting the students Officers at the same level, at the beginning of each course

- a visit will be made to Military Schools (Infantry, Artillery, Pioneers, Communications, Armoured Cars).
- The School will issue a brief pamphlet containing the summary W.E. of Infantry, Artillery, Genie and Services Units.

5. As above said it appears the great importance that the School is assuming in the picture for the New Army reconstruction and for the Bns, Groups, Regts Leaders.-

It follows that selected Officers will be gradually sent to the courses, who they are in possession of physical and intellectual requisites, adequate to the finalities of this S.M. and to the necessity of preparing Senior Officers, fully capable and instructed re the actual experiences and the actual tactical procedures ie. weapons and means allocated to different Army Units.-

6. All General Senior and Captains going to be promoted have to be informed re the contents of this letter.-

Acting on instructions from H.Q., M.M.I.A., I have been visiting 5 C.A.R. at Modena and have included my report in 6 B.L.U. Monthly Progress Report.

On 15th Oct., which was the first visit, training stores, P.T., Sports equipment, armouries and various stores were found to be adequate. Each coy has its own classroom and dining hall and accommodation is satisfactory. Local training areas, both inside the barracks and on the Piazza d'Armi, are sufficient for elementary training and two coys go by train daily to Sassuolo for advanced training and firing. The only real shortage is armourers tools and equipment and spare parts, cleaning kits and bayonets. Since then they have bought some tools locally.

On 8 Nov. '46, I watched training at Sassuolo, firstly Bren firing at 300 yds. Standard was average for recruits and the only comment was that the firing point instructors were not helping so much as they could. Secondly, a field firing Pl in attack which was most realistically planned and well carried out. The piece of country chosen was ideal for a small Pl attack and by judicious placing of two LMG representing the defence and various figure targets for both defence and attackers, a very good effect of realism was obtained.

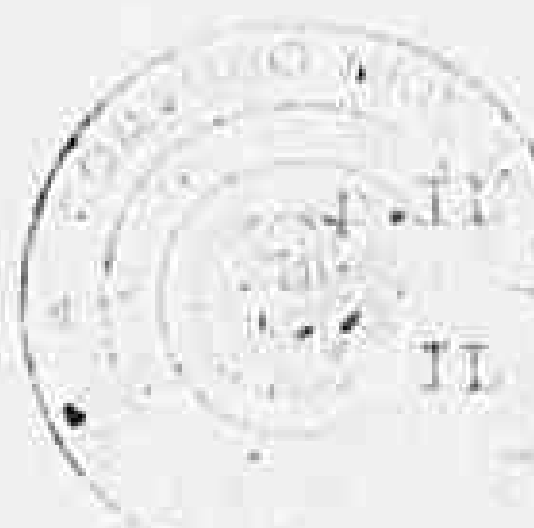

TO : ADJUTANT GENERAL

1. The problem of organizing a training programme for formations and units which receive a new intake of young soldiers from OMT every four months is, as you have already realized, a very difficult one.
2. The solution of the problem that you have arrived at, and set forth in your Directive 11116/1/4 L&A of 1 May 46, involving as it does a four monthly training cycle, ensures that soldiers receive continuous and progressive training from the time they join their COB until they are discharged at the end of their years service.
3. From the point of view of the individual training of the soldiers themselves this system is excellent, but from the wider point of view, that is to say from the point of view of the training of the unit as a whole, the system has certain disadvantages namely:
 - a) That the directive is based on training the individual of the rank and file, and that training of the unit as a homogeneous whole can rarely be attempted.
 - b) That training is unlikely under the system laid down to rise higher than the Coy and equivalent level.
As a direct consequence of this:
 - c) The training of Officers and Staffs will be seriously neglected since these can practice in the field what they have learned in theory only by taking part in exercises of Platoon, Squad, and Platoon.
 - d) No opportunity will be provided for practicing cooperation between the various Arms.
4. In my opinion it is necessary to think of training under two categories:
 - a) Training of Officers and leaders, and practicing them in command and admin. in the field, and in the cooperation

Add of 4. 1946, involving as it does a four monthly training cycle, ensures that soldiers receive continuous and progressive training from the time they join their unit until they are discharged at the end of their years service.
3. From the point of view of the individual training of the soldiers themselves this system is excellent, but from the wider point of view, that is to say from the point of view of the training of the Army as a whole, the system has certain disadvantages namely:
 - a) That the directive is based on training the individual of the rank and file, and that training of the unit as a homogeneous whole can rarely be attempted.
 - b) That training is unlikely under the system laid down to rise higher than the Coy and equivalent level.
As a direct consequence of this:
 - c) The training of Officers and Staffs will be seriously neglected since these can practice in the field that they have learned in theory only by taking part in exercises of Bn, Regts, and Divs.
 - d) No opportunity will be provided for practicing cooperation between the various Arms.
5. In my opinion it is necessary to think of training under two categories:
 - a) Training of Officers and leaders, and practicing them in command and admin. in the field, and in the cooperation with other Arms.
 - b) Training of soldiers and exercising them in the field.
6. As regards para 5. sub para (a):
 - a) The problem is the training of the Officer and the NCO. On these leaders, senior or junior, rests the responsibility of command in battle, and it is on them that the nation must rely as leaders and instructors in the event of war or the expansion of the Army.

- b) It would appear therefore that the first and most important task your Ministry has before it, is to ensure that material of the highest quality is recruited to fill the ranks of the officer and permanent WCO class.
- Secondly it must ensure for both officers and WCOs adequate and realistic training and make provision for this in the curriculum of training for the year 1947 which you will presumably issue shortly.
- c) During 1947 I suggest therefore that more attention be devoted to the training of the Regular Officer and WCO and that this should conclude with exercises not lower than Bn level, and, if the training of senior Commanders is envisaged with exercises not lower than Regimental level.
- As regards para 5. and para (b):
- a) The recruit is now ensured a round initial training at the OAR. It is obviously desirable that this training should be revised and continued when he joins his unit, and that he should be exercised in field training in order to harden him and accustom him to rigours of life in the field.
- b) The recruit must however be made available at some period of his training to some part in exercises, the primary purpose of which is to exercise the Regular Officer and WCO. It is felt that field training of the rank and file, though of necessity subordinated to the exercising of the Regular Officer and WCO, can be made to achieve the object of hardening the recruit and accustoming him to living under active service conditions in the field and even though he may only recently have joined his unit, he will still benefit and learn irrespective of whether he is taking part in section, platoon, or Regimental exercises.
6. Approximately 12/14th of the Italian Army will, under present arrangements, be conscripted soldiers serving a short service engagement and I do not therefore overstate the importance of their training, nor am I unkind that your present curriculum has been soundly devised to ensure that this training is both progressive and practical.
7. a) The difficulties that have to be overcome before field training of Bn, Regt, and Supporting Arms can be undertaken is fully realized. Some of these, although well known to you, are recapitulated below:
- b) (i) Specialist training, as carried out at present, must continue and the flow of specialists cannot be interrupted.
- (ii) Consideration must be given to the problem of ensuring that the selection and initial training of WCOs from Conscript Classes does not suffer.

10. It would appear that the best period for collective training of units is at a time when personnel are at the most advanced stage of training. That is to say at a period immediately prior to the discharge of a class. Under the system of call up every 4 months such a period will occur three times a year, but only one of these periods is likely to be suitable for collective training due to the condition of the country and the prevailing weather (see para 9. (b) above).

11. Should this suggestion be in agreement with your views it might be necessary to adjust the dates of call up and discharge periods to ensure that the discharge of a class takes place after the period selected for collective training. As an example, if the most suitable period for collective training was considered to be in July and August the discharge periods would need to be in September, January and May.

12. I would suggest that the training can be carried out progressively during the rest of the year by some or all of the following means:

- a) Practical courses at schools.
- b) Periodical exercises without troops held by Bns and Regts and corresponding units.
- c) A senior Officer study exercise which might subsequently be carried out in the field by one of the Divisions. In this connection the British Army has carried out many study exercises in the winter months at all levels of command and this system is strongly recommended to you.
