DOS CORPS INSTRUCTION NO. 104

Subject : Other Ranks held in excess of War Establishment.

1. Personnel will in no circumstances be held in a W.E. in lieu of any trade other than that in which they are at present mustered.
2. If they are considered suitable for holding in lieu of some other allied trade, application will be made to GHQ 2nd Echelon for their mustering or re-mustering.

The following is the only exception to this rule :-

STOREMEN FILLING CLERKS VACANCIES

Owing to the acute shortage of Clerks, Storemen may be held against a Clerk's vacancy in the W.E.

Where this occurs, no promotion against NCO vacancy may be made until personnel are found suitable and have been re-mustered.

Drivers or Clerks will NOT be mustered or re-mustered into any other trade.

3. D.Ds.O.S. and A.Ds.O.S. will keep continually under review the situation in their respective formations and take the following action :-

- (a) Post surplus personnel to existing vacancies within their formation so far as is possible.
- (b) Submit a list of surplus personnel who cannot be absorbed to GHQ (ADOS Organisation) with weekly Deficiency Return, stating reasons, if any exist, for retention of surplus personnel.

4. Attention is drawn to DOS Corps instruction No. 59 of 18th February 1944.

in lieu of any trade other than that in which they are at present mustered.

2. If they are considered suitable for holding in lieu of some other allied trade, application will be made to GHQ 2nd Echelon for their mustering or re-mustering.

The following is the only exception to this rule :-

STOREMEN filling CLERKS' vacancies

(a) Post surplus personnel to existing vacancies within their formation so far as is possible.

(b) Submit a list of surplus personnel who cannot be absorbed to GHQ (ADOS Organisation) with weekly Deficiency Return, stating reasons, if any exist, for retention of surplus personnel.
