Complaints have been received from A.M.G. that Units in the Bolzano Area have been requisitioning chopped fuel wood from civilian contractors thereby creating a shortage on the civilian market and consequent hardship to the civilian population, for whilst there is no shortage of wood the facilities for chopping it are very limited.

2. The system adopted by British Units is to requisition an Area of Forest and for the Units to make their own arrangements for cutting up the wood. Please therefore instruct all Italian Units to adopt the same system so that civilian supplies of chopped wood for the coming winter will not be jeopardised.

The Ministry of War, by signal dated 23 Oct 46, made known that the Ministry for Industry and Trade (Ministero Industria e Commercio) will allot only limited quantity of brown coal for the winter heating of 5 Coniliter offices, and therefore the bodies under our Command will have to use brown coal and wood for the above mentioned purposes, except Hospitals, to which Coal Office -MILAN- will allot coal, on request.

Consequently 5 Coniliter, who previously had applied to the War Ministry to take interest in this matter, has requested from the above Coal Office the allotment of as much coal as it will be wanted for the month of Nov 1946 (Copy of signal 5275/1 and letter 5277/1 dated 25 Oct 46 attached herewith).
