

4. Authority can only be given for the issue of petrol in Unit quantities of 4 gallons.
5. On receipt of duly signed authority from OC Troops, transit drivers will be able to obtain petrol from the Nafta Installations (CI) at the NAPLES end of the Autostrada. Map reference 252497.


