5. a. Army Code Sign System.

(1) Code signs will be changed once a week instead of daily. Code signs will change at 0001Z hrs on Sundays, the code sign for Sunday being used for the whole of the ensuing week.

(2) Code sign extracts may be issued for a period of one calendar month, so that the extract will consist of four or five call signs depending on the number of Sundays in the month.

(4) On instructions from higher headquarters.

b. During a period in which daily (or appropriate) changes of keys are in force for a particular formation, all rear links and lateral links working from that formation will also adopt daily (or appropriate) changes of keys. This may lead to routing difficulties over the rear or lateral link circuits, due to duplication of code-signs between the daily and weekly changing systems. Particular care must be taken, therefore, in the handling of such traffic and in operational circumstances "pilot" service messages may be necessary.

1. In view of the fact that many cipher personnel are returning to civil life, it is imperative that they should be warned again of the secret nature of the work upon which they have been employed. This can best be done by drawing their personal attention to the provisions contained in sub para. 2(c) of Section 3 of Military Cipher Instructions, 1944 Part 1, with special emphasis of the last sentence thereof.

2. It cannot be stressed too strongly that any information which has been acquired in the course of their work on cipher duties must never be discussed with or communicated to any person who is NOT authorized to receive such knowledge in order to perform his duties.
