- 2)- impiegare, del 292 O.C., il solo personale, che andrebbe a rinforzare il personale dell'O.M. Territoriale
- 3)- usufruire del materiale dell'O.M. Territoriale già messo in opera.

In poche parole si verrebbe a fondere i due Ospedali sia per il personale che per il funzionamento.

Ciò non è attuabile per i seguenti motivi:

- a)- Il 292 O.C. perderebbe completamente la sua autonomia e si rischierebbe di perderlo una volta che il personale fosse passato in servizio all'O.M. Territoriale.
- b)- Si verrebbe ad avere un frammischiamento di annalati e personale a ragionamento civile e militare, dannoso al buono andamento amministrativo e alla disciplina, per i confronti antipatici che ne potrebbero nascere sia fra il personale dei due Ospedali che fra i degen- ti, data la diversità di trattamento economico e di razi- onamento.

Pertanto credo che la cosa migliore sarebbe quella d'impiantare il 292 O.C. in locali completamente separati.-

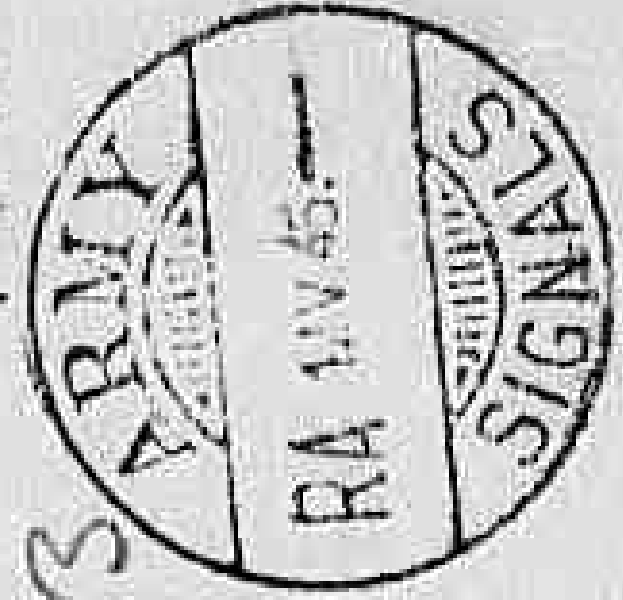

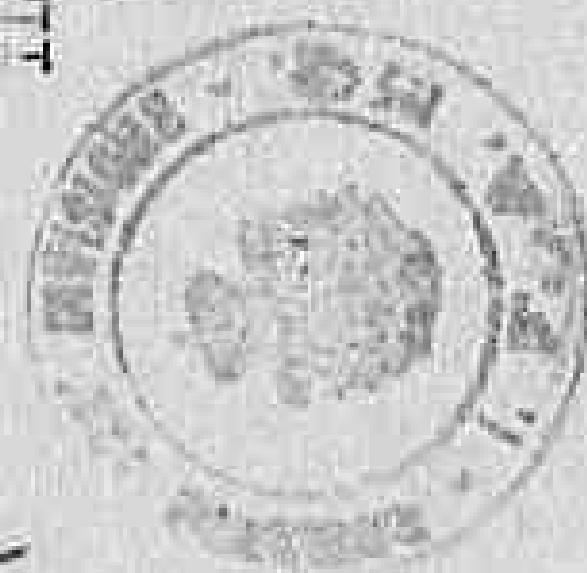

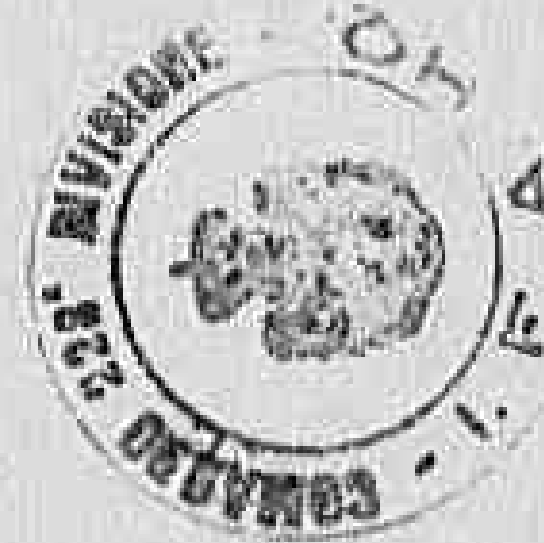

This is to introduce Miss Paula Milesi. She is the Senior Italian Red Cross Nurse in charge of organising and recruiting 100 Sisters for service with the 200-bedded Italian Field Hospitals with the Combat Force.

She is visiting Rimini, Faenza and Ravenna in order to collect Red Cross Nurses who are known to be in this area. These nurses will be returning to Rome where they will be equipped and posted to the hospitals as they move forward.

Miss Milesi also asked me if she could be permitted to visit a British medical unit with equipment similar to that issued to the Italian units. (The G 1098 equipment of these units is the same as issued to a 200-bedded British General Hospital).

I think it is a good idea and suggest 54 General Hospital which is my old unit and I believe in the Rimini area.

Could you ask DMS Rear 8th Army for his permission. If agreed, the enclosed package contains a copy of this letter and a personal note to Miss Douglas, Matron of 54 General Hospital and an old friend of mine.

I am anxious to get this organised as soon as possible and will be grateful for any assistance which Miss Milesi may require on her mission. Miss Milesi is in possession of a proper permit for herself, the Italian medical officer, batman and driver.

1. Enclosed are two copies of W.E. NA/574/1 and SEL 186/1.

The W.E. and S.E.L. have been approved by AFHQ for equipping the ten non-divisional Fd Hospitals (200 beds each), which are now forming to support the Italian Combat Force. Two of these units will shortly be called forward to 8th Army Area.

This W.E. is also applicable to 291 and 292 Fd Hospitals. No information has been received at MMIA that the S.E.L. applies to these two units.

2. AFHQ have been requested to approve of the addition of ten Red Cross nurses to WE/574/1 in respect of 16 Italian Fd Hospitals including 291 and 292. Approval has so far only been received in respect of the ten units with the Italian Combat Force. It is considered that the addition of ten CRI nurses is all that is necessary to the existing W.E. in order to expand 291 and 292 to 200 beds each.

3. The main items of equipment required for expansion are beds and bedding. 291 and 292 Fd Hospitals can obtain these from Ministry of War. There is no extra tentage available from Italian resources.

Two copies of indents for the necessary items should be obtained from the Units concerned and forwarded to HQ M.M.I.A.
