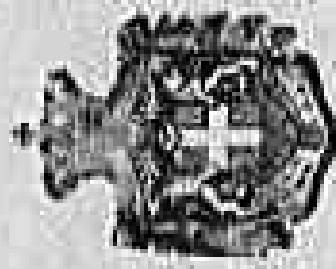

ARRESTO DA PARTE DI PATTUGLIA JUGOSLAVA DI ENRICO GIANNINI

Soldato Gruppo Combattimento Legnano (8 Army) avvenuto a Trieste il 14 maggio 1945 mentre trovavasi in refolare licenza militare e in divisa.-

ENRICO GIANNINI, nato a Trieste il 13 novembre 1924, figlio dell'avvocato Luigi, studente universitario, partito da Trieste, appena occupata da tedeschi, l'11 settembre 1943: da tale epoca partecipò come patriotta nella zona di Cassino alla lotta contro i tedeschi e fascisti.

Il padre avvocato Luigi, noto alla cittadinanza oltre che per la sua probità, per l'intransigente linea politica di fiero antifascista, **partì** da Trieste il 15 settembre 1943, seguito a brevissimo intervallo dalla moglie e dalle figlie, ricercate dai tedeschi e dai squadristi, e si recò nelle zone di Caspoggio e del Sangro a capeggiare bande di partigiani.

Dopo la liberazione di Roma, Enrico Giannini fece parte prima delle 21^a divisione italiana mobilitata e poi del Gruppo di Combattimento "Legnano" (8 Army), e, come soldato, combatté costantemente fino all'ultima vittoriosa offensiva che, attraverso Bologna, condusse alla liberazione dell'Italia Settentrionale.

Nello stesso periodo di tempo il padre, ottenuto di essere richiamato alle armi e, col grado di Tenente Colonnello fu ispettore delle truppe italiane dipendenti della V Armata americana e partecipò all'ultima vittoriosa offensiva, finché, richiesto dal comando della A.M.G. per l'Emilia, si recò a Ferrara ad assumere la carica di Prefetto di quella Provincia.

Al soldato Enrico Giannini, fu per il suo valoroso comportamento concessa una licenza premio per Trieste sua città natale, dove giunse il giorno 10 maggio. La sera del 14 maggio verso le ore 19, mentre passeggiava con la signorina Miranda LO Prenti sua ex compagna di scuola lungo la via Roma verso la via Bellini, fu fermato da una pattuglia jugoslava, la quale gli contestò di essere sprovvisto di documento personale e fu condotto e rinchiuso in una stanza del liceo Dante in viale Margheriet dove trovavasi già un detenuto e dove nei giorni successivi ne convennero numerosi altri.

L'indomani = 15 maggio = il professor Luciano Serti, presso il quale Enrico Giannini aveva trovato temporanea ospitalità, essendo ancora la famiglia Giannini lontana da Trieste, consegnò nelle mani di un ufficiale di guardia del liceo Dante, la licenza, da cui si desunse l'identità dell'arrestato Giannini e legittimità della sua presenza a Trieste.

Nel ricever tale documento, l'ufficiale stesso assicurò che il Giannini sarebbe stato rilasciato.

Del racconto fatto dai signori Vinicio Lagotollo, geometra, abitante in Trieste via S. Giusto n.1 e Sergio Basiliotti sottosegretario agente di custodia abitante in Trieste in Via de Giacinti n. 24 e da numerosi altri condetenuti, risulta che il Giannini non fu mai interrogato, nonostante le sue vive insistenze e le sue proteste di essere soldato della 8 Armata inglese, fino alle ore 22 del 22 maggio.

Dopo questo interrogatorio fu rinviato nelle solite stanze dove trovavano altri, tra cui i due suddetti destinati ad essere rimessi in libertà. Benonche poco tempo dopo il Giannini fu fatto uscire ed introdotto in altra stanza vicina, dove, tra gli altri, trovavansi dott. Antonio d'Este, abitante in Trieste via Commerciale n. 23; Ermenegildo Michielli agente carcerario; due autisti dell'ispettorato di polizia; due agenti di questura (uno di essi certo Carlisi); un militare portuario. Da rilevarsi che ad alcuni di costoro era contestata la qualita di fascisti e di militi e che portavano sul viso e nel corpo i segni di sanguinose percosse.

Mentre i detenuti della prima stanza furono effettivamente messi in libertà il giorno 23 maggio, quelli della seconda stanza furono durante la notte trasferiti altrove.

Da allora non si sono piu avute notizie e tracce benché minimo sul conto del Giannini.

Il padre dello scomparso, avvocato Luigi Giannini, soccorso a Trieste partecipò alle ricerche già iniziati da amici. Presentato ed accompagnato dal Sig. Gino Merovic abitante in Trieste Galleria Protti 4, poté parlare con il Commissario del liceo "Dante" e con il comandante dello stesso tenente Prigio, i quali gli offrivano in visione una specie di ruolino dei movimenti. In un primo momento, il commissario signor Lonzar Aloja dichiarò che il Giannini era stato "mandato avanti". Richiesto di maggiori spiegazioni, si allontanò dalla stanza dove avveniva il colloquio come per andare ad eseprire qualche indagine. Torno dopo circa 20 minuti, asserendo che il Giannini sarebbe entrato nel liceo Dante il 13 maggio e che ne sarebbe uscito perché liberato il 24 maggio.

A sostegno del suo aserto, mostrava un registro del quale risultava l'ingresso del Giannini il 13 maggio e mostrava altresì un foglio sul quale erano scritti diversi nomi tra cui quello del Giannini che secondo una annotazione apparentemente fatta in un secondo tempo, comune a diversi altri, sarebbe stato rimesso in libertà il giorno 24 maggio. Alla obiezione che la data dell'arresto era errata, il commissario si limitò a rispondere che così risultava; all'altra obiezione che se il Giannini fosse stato rimesso effettivamente in libertà, si sarebbe immediatamente recato dal Professor Serti, e poi al comando militare inglese, del quale dipende, il commissario rispose che per lui risultava fatto uscire e che non poteva rispondere di ciò che gli fosse toccato fuori della porta del liceo "Dante". Soggiunse anzi che a Trieste c'è il mare, ci sono i trams e, quindi, numerosi e gravi pericoli.

Il tenente Prigio diede a sua volta assicurazione, che secondo lui, il Giannini non si poteva far rilievo di sorta, che aveva visto la licenza militare del giovane e che pertanto anche lui pur senza asserne in grado di precisarne la data aveva disposto per la scarcerazione.

Da quanto sopra si deve concludere che la versione desunta sia a voce sia dalle carte del liceo "Dante" non è attendibile.

È invece purtroppo grandemente probabile che Enrico Giannini abbia seguito la sorte del triste drappello uscito la notte tra il 22 e il 23 maggio dal liceo "Dante" e convogliato verso destinazione ignota. Poiché anche le scritturazioni sui ruolli, date la comprensibile confusione di questi primi momenti, si sono rivelate manchevoli e fallaci, o potrebbe essere stata persa dopo la notte del 23 ogni traccia del Giannini, sembrerebbe opportuno che le indagini tenesse presenti i nomi di Antonio d'Este, Ermenegildo Michielli, Carlisi, per stabilire in quale tempo

e in quale luogo il destino del Giannini si è diviso da quello degli
uccisi e dei compagni.

Sembrirebbe inoltre necessario che il Commissario del Liceo "Dante" e il
tenente Frincio fossero diligentemente e scrupolosamente richiesti di
tutte le notizie sul caso e in particolare sulle persone fisiche e sulle
funzioni di colui o coloro ai quali è stata effettuata la consegna, la
notte del 23 maggio, oltre che del Giannini, anche dagli altri sopra
nominativi.

Poiché della testimonianza dei detenuti è risultato:

a) che al Giannini, il quale veniva dai guardiani gratificato in tono
di disprezzo di epiteti come questi: "Badogliano, Porco d'Inglese" fu
improvvisamente imposto, nella notte sul 23 maggio il cambiamento di
cello.

b) che, durante la sua detenzione al liceo "Dante" (dal 14 al 22 maggio)
il tenente Frincio ed altri dissero al Giannini che anche egli avrebbe
potuto essere rilasciato in libertà se sul suo conto non ci fosse stato
un punto interrogativo.

Sembra molto importante chiedere decisamente ai ripetuti Ufficiali jugo
slavi in che cosa consistesse tale punto interrogativo e quale è stata
la ragione che li ha determinati a cambiare la cella del Giannini e ad
avviarlo a un destino del quale si sono poi rifiutati di dare la minima
notizia.

Si deve aggiungere che tutti i compagni di carcerazione hanno attestato
e sono pronti a ripetere a chi vorrà interrogarli che il Giannini durante
gli otto giorni della sua permanenza al Liceo "Dante" ha tenuto contegno
dignitoso sì, ma disciplinato e corretto, tale da non giustificare nessun
provvedimento disciplinare da parte degli incaricati della custodia.
