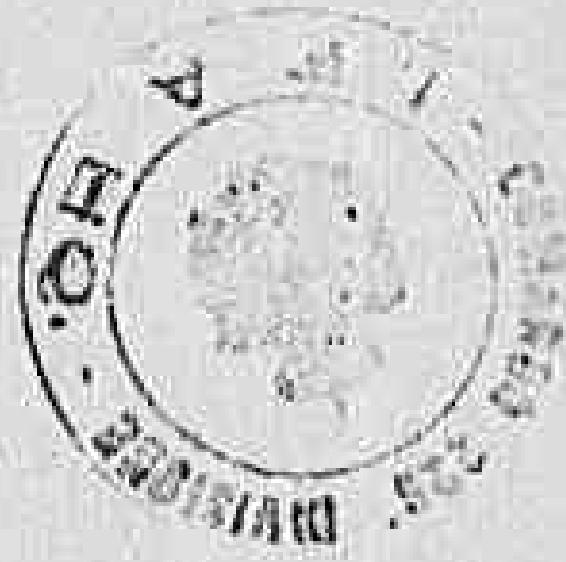

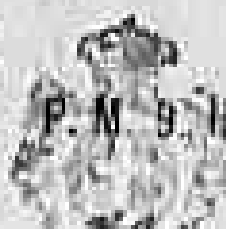
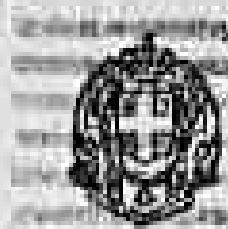

I wish to report adversely on the above-named officer at present serving on attachment to this Coy with a detachment of 514 (Italian) Line Section.

It became necessary to move this det. on morning of 13 Apr 45 and accordingly, at approx 0700 hrs, I/Sgt WATKINS of 25 Line Sec was sent to their camp near BATTINA to warn the det to close up on 1 Coy HQ as soon as possible.

The det, less one 3-ton G3 lorry, reported to this HQ under SM COZZI GIACONO at 1000 hrs. One 25 Line Sec accompanied the party and reported that I/Sgt WATKINS had found S/Ten GANDROSSI absent from camp and his bed bearing evidence of not having been slept in. It was further stated that no rank in the camp could explain the officer's absence.

A guide from 23 Line Sec was attending to conduct the party to HQ 23 Line Sec but as the other lorry 3-ton had not arrived, having been kept back to move the cookhouse, the remainder of the det was ordered to move on to 23 Line Sec. The SM, meanwhile, was despatched rearward on a motor-cycle to locate the missing lorry.

At approx 1430 hrs the missing lorry arrived and S/Ten GANDROSSI reported. On being questioned as to his absence at 0700 hrs he stated that he had left camp at 0600 hrs to visit his section HQ regarding repairs to one of his vehicles. I regarded this as suspicious inasmuch as he did not appear to have left camp in any of his section tpt and that no such explanation had been vouchsafed by his NCO's.

In general I have found this officer slovenly and incapable of maintaining discipline in his detachment.

The standard of workmanship and discipline in his **710** detachment is the lowest I have encountered in my working experience of some ten Italian Line Sections and I request ~~that~~ <sup>each</sup> to take this opportunity of submitting the opinion that such troops are useless to this unit in the present operation

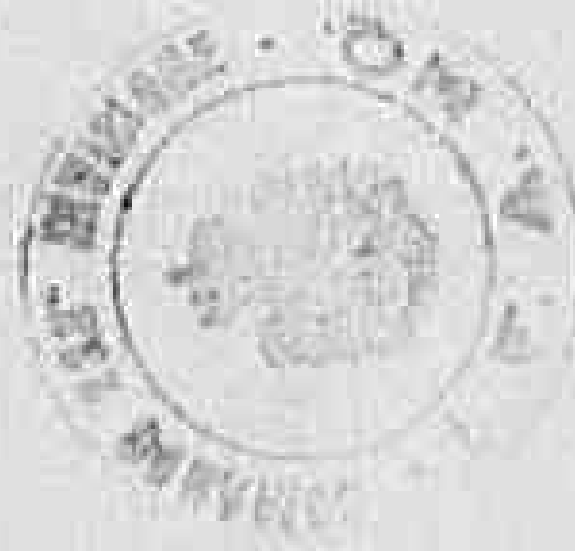

1. The following is the procedure for the selection and vetting in Rome of prospective candidates as Italian Intelligence Liaison Officers of Nucleo I att GSI(OL) Eighth Army. Similar machinery will be set up in FLORENCE.

- a. British offer rep.) Military capacity and knowledge.  
Italian offer rep.) Bearing, character and general appearance; knowledge of English.
- b. 300 PSS: Security and background check.
- c. SIM: Security and background check.  
Preliminary regularisation (e.g. recall to service) with Comando Supremo. Provision of permits for buying equipment (e.g. camp beds) from Unione Militare.

2. After officers have been passed through these stages they are sent to Lt Col di Villanova, OC Nucleo I att GSI(OL) HQ Eighth Army.

Lt Col di Villanova and Maj Colquhoun will make a final judgement on suitability, and arrange their distribution to Corps according to this and to priorities of requests. Lt Col di Villanova will then put them on the strength of Nucleo I, and arrange their pay and allowances.

3. All Italian Intelligence Liaison Officers will be selected on the above lines. Formations are encouraged to find suitable candidates, but they must be put up to GSI(OL) at this HQ before acceptance. Indiscriminate enlistment will only lead to confusion.

4. If Italian officers or volunteers, selected under different arrangements, have for some time given satisfactory service to units and formations, full details will be sent to GSI(OL) at this HQ, and the officer or volunteer concerned will be sent to this HQ as soon as possible for interview by Lt Col di Villanova.

5. It is to be noted that these officers are for Intelligence duties as in Main HQ Eighth Army letters M 502 I of 10 July 44 and M 1202/4 G of 5 August 44, and should be distinguished from interpreters, who do not come within the competence of GSI(OL).
