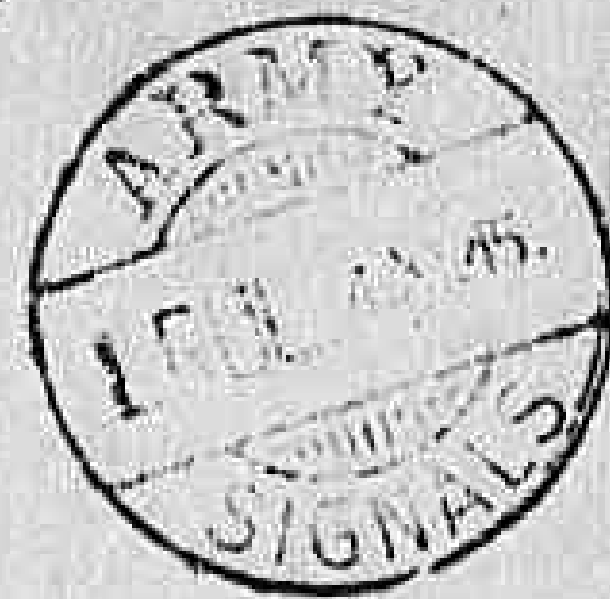

5. GHQ Signal C 28344 of 15 Oct 45 lays down that ITALIAN and other wives are to fall under Familien Scheme 'B'. This is under consideration and may entail certain modification in their privileges, i.e. it may not be possible to provide them with free requisitioned accommodation, nor with rations for wives and children. It is felt that the quota of five hundred families recommended to the War Office, and for whom full privileges vide GHQ letter 2242/44 of 3 Oct 45 are likely to be afforded, should be reserved for these Officers and ORs whose families have been separated from them by virtue of their being resident in ENGLAND or elsewhere. 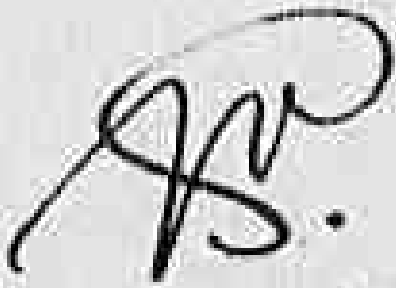

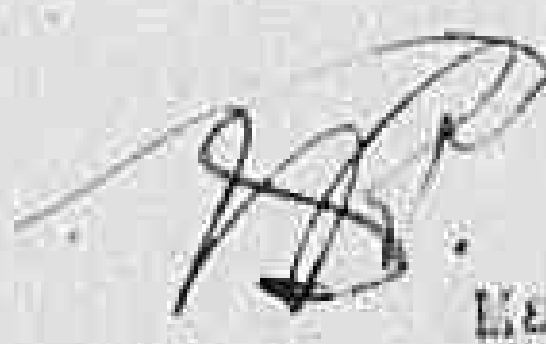

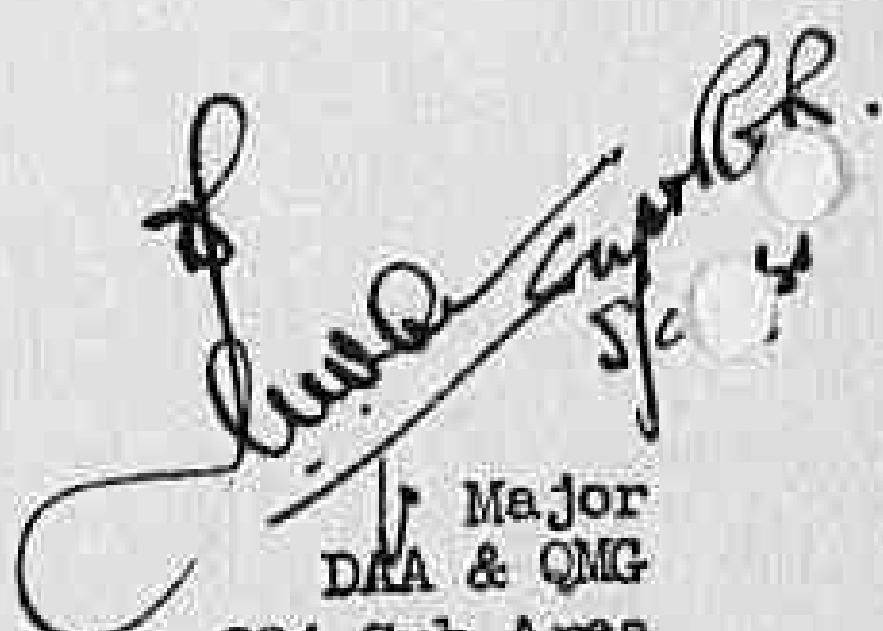

Thank you for your DO/1 written from TRIESTE and which contained a considerable amount of information gathered by you in a short period. We have now received your new address which will be circulated to all concerned.

Your warning of the shortage of winter accommodation in the UDINE Area is timely although it would appear fairly general also in surrounding areas. Accommodation for 5 I.S. Bde for UDINE is still causing us some worry - the present position is as follows:-

Before leaving PADUA Bourne sent a signal to DISTWO (C4 of 10 Sep) copy of which is attached, asking for accommodation for 516 Gd Bn in their area and preferably near PADUA where Rear 5 Terr. HQ could keep an eye on training. Later we agreed with AFHQ and 13 Corps that the I.S. Bde HQ should be stationed at the same place selected by DISTWO for 516 Gd Bn. Unfortunately DISTWO have not yet replied giving location so we are at a standstill. "Q" are sending a hastener today.

The disbandment programme is generally going well and if all concerned follow the instructions in our A.1222 of 8 Aug all will be well.

The return of the 5,000 YUGS from FRANCE to your Area is causing great discussion here. No doubt by the time you receive this letter many signals will have passed and you will be fully in the picture.

Col. FIDSEY is writing you about your driver but as far as I know you will be able to keep MONICO's driver.

By all means settle down and then send your reports and correspondence. If you are short of any "basic" documents etc please ask for them.

I forwarded you these notes to give you something to work on; I hope we can have a meeting in Milan to discuss any difficulties.

2. The future of the Italian army and MILIA's relations towards it naturally depends on the Peace Treaty and the talks now being carried out in London. The Peace Treaty must either say that we control the Italian Army or that we advise.

An efficient army is essential if Italy is to take her place in Europe, maintain her frontiers and keep law and order. AMPS have recommended that we control in order to achieve this end.

3. You should by now have received a copy of Gen. Browning's address to the War Ministry officials on Sep 14th. This gives a complete picture of our suggestions as to future policy. It is now up to the Italians to consider all these various points and make their recommendations.

4. You will see that it is proposed to have a P.I.O. and an I.T.O. in each Territorial Hq. This means that there will probably be a P.I.O. with each Terr. Hq to ensure that correct procedure and training is being carried out.
