Italian News Agency states that the British Admiralty is recruiting 15,000 workers in Italy for port and road construction in the Far East.

Agreement for this to be done had been concluded between the British and Italian Governments, it was stated.

It is confirmed in London, adds Reuter, that such an agreement has been reached and that recruiting in Italy began at the beginning of June.

The Italian News Agency declared that workers between 21 and 45 and doctors and technicians up to 50 will be accepted.

1. The Italian Ministry of War has made arrangements for the demobilisation of large numbers of officers. Such demobilisations to be voluntary and subject to exigencies of service and to Allied agreement.
2. The Italian Ministry of War proposal is to replace the demobilised offrs gradually by regular offrs as and when they become available.
3. HQ 228 Div, the adm div HQ for all units (excl Combat Groups) under command Eighth Army, proposes to liaise with all unit comds to ensure a sufficient number of offrs remain with each unit so that unit efficiency does not suffer.
4. Before any action can be taken in this matter the approval of HQ Eighth Army is required and I would be glad to have your views on the scheme, together with any suggestions so that I can give a decision to HQ 228 Div.

The ministry of War, in circular n.3719/250/2 dated 23 May, has made arrangements for the release of a large contingent of officers, on their demand, subject to the exigencies of the service and Allied agreement.

The WE deficiencies that may ensue with this release would be gradually replaced, upon request, by the Ministry of War, with officers holding permanent commissions.

To ensure the satisfactory functioning of units after the release of the oldest officers this HQ will reach an agreement with Unit COs to settle with them the minimum number of officers for each unit.

But before taking any action I would like an opinion from Allied authorities.

If the Allied authorities have no objections, the WE of officers in units would be, after the release, reduced until replacements arrive. If not, replacements would have to be found/prior to the release. and brought up.

1. Recommendations for the size and composition of the Interim and Peacetime Italian Army are now under review in LONDON and WASHINGTON.
2. The regulations in force for call-up and demobilisation of certain classes were dictated by the number of Italian soldiers required by the Allies; the call-ups were conducted in CENTRAL and S. ITALY through force of circumstances.
3. It is not understood why men of 1927 class have been demobilised in CREMONA I.C.G. as those eligible are 1914 (first four months) and above.
4. As soon as the regulations are clarified I will inform all Italian firms concerned.

1. Under the terms of Main HQ Eighth Army letter M 1202 H dated 25 May 45 demobilised Italian Military are allowed into the Army Area East of the Security Control Line; provided they are in possession of passes issued by MIA and are not in full uniform.
2. It is now understood that black battle dress will be issued to such demobilised soldiers.
3. In view of existing conditions in Army Area including the presence of Yugoslavs and other armed partisans, it is considered that an influx of persons wearing black uniforms, is most undesirable, bearing in mind the associations of the colour black and the fact that partisans have recently been fighting the Brigade Here.
4. It is requested that this be represented to MIA.

1. The attached letter 6923/16 dated 7 May from HQ 2 Bn 405 Pnr Regt to 14 Army Veh Disposal unit reveals that the conditions of demobilising certain classes of soldiers have been radically misunderstood.
2. The basis of all discharge, unless units are to lose half their strength and efficiency has always been that replacements must be available locally before those entitled to demobilisation are sent away.
3. The present situation seems to be that the strength of 14 Army Veh Disposal Unit has dropped to 2 offrs 5 ORs.
4. Will you therefore please investigate the facts and ensure that the current regulations for demobilisation are clearly understood by all HQs and units under your command.

CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH ITALIANS  
WILL BE EXEMPTED FROM THE MILITARY SERVICE1. General

a. As a result of the additional commitments undertaken by the Italian Authorities to provide Italian Units for employment as such with the Allied Forces, it is essential that the required Italian personnel be made available for service in these units now being organized to the maximum extent, which is possible without involving depletion of Allied manpower.

b. All Italians in Allied employment, either directly or by contractors, who are subject to call will continue in their employment only on the conditions set forth below.

2. Initial Procedure - Application will be made for authority to retain in employment personnel subject to call in the following manner:

a. Application forms (Appendix "A") will be completed by the employing unit in respect of all personnel affected. Men falling within the following categories will be listed on separate forms:

Category I - Skilled Labor employed in Military installations.

Category II - All other labor.

Forms will be submitted in quadruplicate to the local British or United States Labor representative.

b. The local British or United States Labor representative will complete the certificate appearing on the application form stating whether or not replacements can be provided from civilian sources. He will then forward three (3) copies of the application form as follows:

Category I - To appropriate Head of Service or Chief of Special Staff Section at AFHQ, who will in turn forward 2 copies to the appropriate exempting authority with his recommendation.

Category II - To the appropriate exempting authority (see paragraphs 3 and 5).

3. Exempting Authorities

a. The following are declared to be Exempting Authorities for the purposes of this instruction:

- (15) Chief Commissioner, The Allied Commission.

b. Independent organizations operating over widespread areas will refer applications for exemption to the nearest appropriate exempting authority.

4. Procedure By Exempting Authority

a. The exempting authority will take into consideration the certificate of the British or United States Labor representative but will not authorize exemption in any case unless satisfied that the retention in employment of the individual concerned is so essential that such individual will be of greater value to the Allied war effort by remaining in his present capacity than he would be if called into the Italian Military Service.

b. Where exemption is granted the Exempting Authority will complete a Certificate of Exemption (Appendix "B") and will forward it together with one copy of the application form to the appropriate Italian Authority as set out below:

c. The Certificate of Exemption will be sealed and countersigned on behalf of the Italian Authorities and returned to the Exempting Authority for onward transmission to the employing unit who will hand it to the person exempted.

d. Should the Italian Authorities take exception to an exemption authorized by an Allied Exempting Authority, they will return the Certificate of Exemption, with their comments but without Seal or Countersign, to the Exempting Authority, through IMIA, for review. Final determination in each case will rest with the Exempting Authority, but full consideration will be given to the views of the Italian Authorities and IMIA.

5. Channels of Application - All applications forwarded by the local British or United States Labor Representative to an Exempting Authority will be submitted through the normal channels of command.

6. Duration of Exemption - Exemptions granted under the provisions hereof will be valid only for a period of six months with effect from date of exemption. Applications for further exemption will be submitted in the same manner except that the form will be marked (RENEWAL) and previous authority quoted.

7. Notification

a. Employing Units will notify the Exempting Authority of any person to whom exemption has been granted who is subsequently released from employment; and will instruct the released employee to report to the nearest Reali Carabinieri Headquarters for direction to the nearest Italian Military District.

b. Exempting Authorities will supply full particulars of all personnel whose exemption is cancelled or expires to the appropriate Italian Authority as set out in paragraph 4 b above.

8. Civilian Firms - Applications for exemption will be made by the authority concerned in similar form and on similar grounds as set forth above in respect of personnel employed by civilian firms doing work of operational importance for the Allied Forces.

9. Refusal of Exemption - Where an application for permission to retain personnel in employment is refused, the employing unit may continue to employ such personnel until called up by the Italian authorities.

10. Applicability

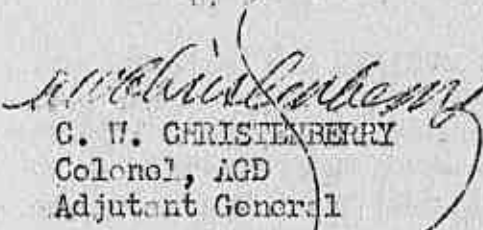
a. This instruction is applicable to Italian Civilian personnel employed by both British and United States Forces and by civilian firms doing work of operational importance for the Allied Forces.

b. Nothing in this instruction shall in any way affect Italian prisoners of war (including cooperators) employed by the Allied Forces.

c. Nothing in this instruction shall be construed as providing exemption for deserters from the Italian Armed Forces. In all cases deserters will be turned over to the nearest Italian Military Authority for return to their units for disciplinary action.
