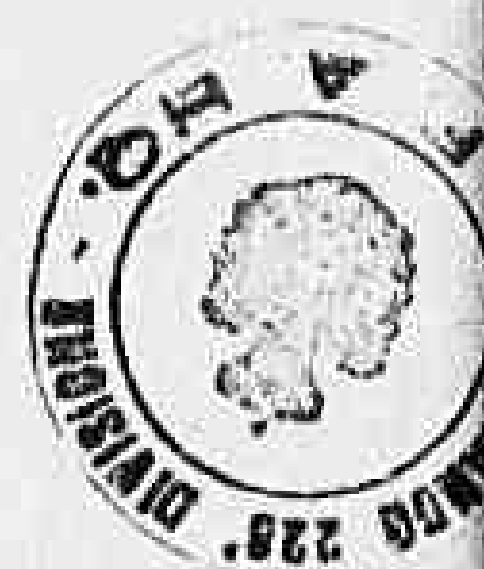

1. Your interpretation of this Headquarters letter Q/8 8 Mar 45 is not agreed. The policy approved by the Supreme Allied Commander was to afford protection to War Ministry property against improper requisitioning by Allied officers.
2. Under the circumstances then existing cases were occurring of Allied Commanders and A.M.C. officers taking possession of Italian Army Barracks and stores in the same way as they requisitioned civilian buildings. Except in cases of operational necessity it was ruled that War Ministry property would be privileged and the printed notices were issued with the intention of assisting the Ministry to safeguard property of this nature.
3. While it is realised that a number of War Ministry Barracks are still occupied by Allied forces the number of such buildings is not likely to increase and when ever circumstances permit they will be de-requisitioned and thereafter protected. The same action cannot however be taken in the case of buildings which have been requisitioned by the War Ministry from their owners. It is considered that any dispute which may arise over the possession of such buildings must now be a matter of decision as between the Italian Government and the owner of the property.
4. If any building, not the property of the War Ministry, but which they desire to occupy has been requisitioned by the

If any building, not the property of the War Ministry, but which they desire to occupy has been requisitioned by the Allies the matter may, if of sufficient importance, be referred to this Headquarters who will ascertain whether or not the building can be released for the Italian Army.

This is the result of the local inspection I made of the Museo Archeologico in Cividale del Friuli today 4 June '45:

- 1) The keys of the Museum are held by Avv. (Lawyer) Giuseppe Marioni. It is closed for the public.
- 2) The Museum contains all sorts of precious relics of the past twenty centuries and contains also a small number of weapons of the ~~Medieval~~ Middle Ages. I have noticed nothing of particular value for the 1st Italian Inf. Regt.
- 3) In 1940, many cases of most valuable things had been carried to Passariano (Codroipo) Villa Manin by order of "Sovrintendenza di Trieste" and in Oct. 1943 were carried back to Cividale and boxed and buried in various houses.
- 4) The Avv. Marioni and the "Sovrintendenza of Trieste" have lists of ~~every~~ all the places in Cividale where the valuable cases are hidden.
- 5) Nothing has ever been misplaced, says Avv. Marioni, nothing is lost or spoilt.
- 6) Allied Forces have not occupied or even touched the Museum.
