The snap checks carried out by the MG's of this section, show beyond doubt that these block posts are extremely effective. It is impossible for a person to enter or leave the area without a permit to travel by train or civilian vehicle. The one loophole is that of the transport carrying civilian passengers. It has long been a grievance among the Alpini who man these posts that they can do nothing about this method of evading the necessity of having a pass.

However, in recent weeks the snap checks on the main road from VICENZA to TRIESTE have been made more frequently and these show that the number of unauthorized civilians in the transport is not large.

An incident which occurred at VILLAS block-post on 14 Feb 17, although not of a security nature is interesting as it reflects upon the integrity of the soldiers who man these posts. An Army 15 cwt truck was standing unattended near the block-post, its driver having been obliged to go to VILLA VICENTINA for assistance, one of these on duty pilfered some kit, consisting of two blankets and a gas cap, which had been left inside. Complaints from the driver on returning, resulted in the thief being discovered. He has since been transported to RAUJA to await Court Martial while the kit in question has been returned to the owner.

The Lt. in command of VILLAS block-post has apologized for the incident and in fact a Captain of the Alpini visited the office of this section's detachment at CURTAINIA in order to offer his personal apology. The very fact that an incident of this type has occurred have aroused so much concern is a testimony to the overall honesty and integrity of the soldiers who have the somewhat boring task of

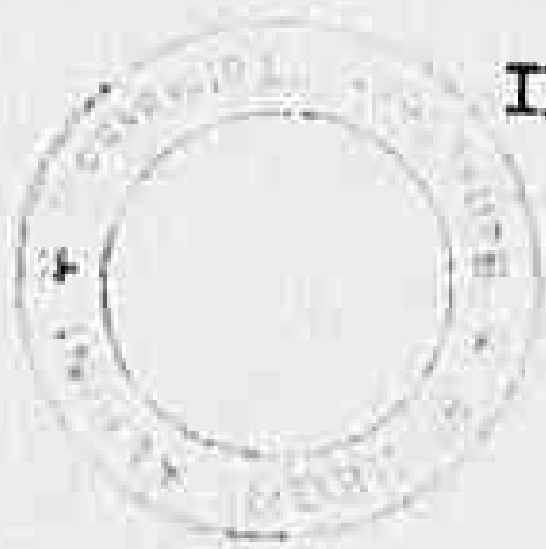

Most important news.-

- At about 2350 hrs on the night of 9 Feb. shots of automatic guns were fired toward the Pojanis Road Post (Prepetto) from the Dolegna square.
- On the 10 Feb. 47 at 1930 hrs a detached patrol of the Detached Group of Prepetto was fired with a burst of machine-gun coming from the East side of the Judrio river.
- Some minutes later, other two bursts followed the first from the same Rdg.
- An inspection was made on 11 Feb and at about 100 meters East of the bridge an empty magazine of Breda submachine-gun, about 20 cartridge cases, and six unexploded cartridges were found.
- A civilian informer reported to have heard, little before the shots, unidentified persons, walking along the path near the river in "A" Zone, singing Slav songs.
- In accordance with the accidents occurred on 10 and 12 Feb. an anonymous minatory letter was received by the V.G. Police at Dolegna. The telephone line between Podresca and Prepetto is cut nearly every night.
- Nightly ambushes have been done with no result. The pro-slay activity and propaganda has increased in these days particularly in the Judrio Valley. A faithful person who had a meeting with a UAIS (Trieste) exponent, confirmed the arrival on the border line of clandestine elements of the Yugoslav frontier guard in order to close the passages, control the persons and provoke accidents in the Judrio and Natisone Valley.
- On 18 Feb. 47 an Allied vehicle has collided in the Road Post neighbourhood (Gr. Dist. VILLANOVA) with a civilian who has been taken later to the Udine Civil

Nella notte del 9 verso le ore 23,50 sono state indirizzate contro la località ove risiede il Posto Blocco di Pojanis (Prepetto) dalla piazzetta di Dolegna alcuni colpi di arma automatica.

Un informatore civile riferiva di aver udito poco prima della sparatoria cantare inni slavi da alcuni individui, non identificati, che passavano dal sentiero che costeggia il fiume nella zona "A". In relazione agli incidenti dei giorni 10 e 12, alla Polizia della V.G. in Dolegna è pervenuta una lettera anonima minatoria. La linea telefonica che collega Podresca con Prepetto quasi ogni notte viene tagliata. Sono stati fatti degli appostamenti notturni ma finora senza alcun risultato. L'attività e propaganda filo-slava in questi ultimi giorni si è accentuata specialmente nella valle del Iudrio. Viene confermato da persona degna di fede che ha avuto un colloquio con un esponente dell'UAIS di Trieste, l'arrivo sulla linea del nuovo confine di elementi clandestini della guardia di frontiera jugoslava per chiudere i passi, controllare le persone e per provocare incidenti nella Valle del Iudrio e nelle Valli del Natisone.

VILLA VICENTINA.

This railway Check Post is subject to routine visits by HQ's of this Section.

The method of checking persons travelling by train is as follows. Each train is halted at the station and all persons are required to detrain in order that their permits may be checked by those on duty. While the examination of passes is taking place the train is searched by two Alpini. These men are armed, as are the other four men on duty. This method of checking has been found both simple and efficient.

Barracks.

Although the billet is quite good, it has the great disadvantage of being situated at least a mile from the station. As no transport is available to this detachment the men are obliged to walk "cross country" to the station.

Twelve men live in the barracks including the "sergente-maggiore" who is in immediate command. The latter sleeps in the orderly room while the rest occupy two fairly large rooms. The billet is in excellent condition.

Food.

This is satisfactory both in quality and quantity. Cooking facilities are very good, as there is a large kitchen together with

- B. The following general comments are forwarded for information:

BUDA.

Accommodation at Block Post. The hut at the Block Post for the use of the men on duty contains a stove and a telephone. A larger hut and two smaller huts have been built intended for the sleeping quarters of the detachment in the near future.

Barracks. The accommodation for the men is far from satisfactory. There is a Corporal in immediate charge of the detachment which consists of ten men. He sleeps in a very small room with four other men while the rest sleep in the attic of a farmhouse opposite. This attic is also used as a granary and in addition the roof leaks very badly.

Food. This, although satisfactory in quality, is not available in sufficient quantity. Cooking arrangements are not very good as the kitchen is used by both the detachment and civilians. As usual wood is very short, and the rations are one kilo per man per day.

Equipment. There is sufficient number of arms which consist of rifles, TSM's, and one revolver. These are in good condition. Each man has two blankets, sheets and a cotton sweater.

Sanitation. This is very bad since they do not possess a latrine of their own, and are obliged to use the latrine belonging to the civilians living in the next house.

Personal Cleanliness. This is good, each man being obliged to wash and shave each morning. The rooms in spite of their bad aspects are very clean and tidy, and are swept out every morning.

Transport. There is no transport available for this detachment, there being only one truck, and this is at the disposal of the Lt. i/c at TAPOGLIANO.

Recreation. There is no radio or gramophone at the barracks. The Lt. i/c suggested that one or two bicycles would be of great help since these would provide recreation and also transport to the Block Post, a mile distant.

Morale. Morale is high and a good standard of discipline is maintained.

1. It has been known by this HQ and the Tolmezzo HQ that conditions at CHICHI are bad. Alternative or additional tent accommodation was not available. However arrangements were made with the Italian Engineers to erect two wooden huts. These have now, this week, been completed and will accommodate all the men. There is a good warming stove in each hut, and a cooking stove and boiler in the cook house, and a water tank.
2. It was considered better to concentrate on the new accommodation rather than divide limited resources of the engineers between tent, and improving the old.
3. There is no wood fuel shortage. There are lies about it, adequate, and it is suspected that this is the usual soldiers' guess. The disadvantage of your electric lighting is shared by the whole of North Italy.
4. CHICHI is however a pretty dismal place, under any conditions, but it is no ed that these have been improved by the new huts.

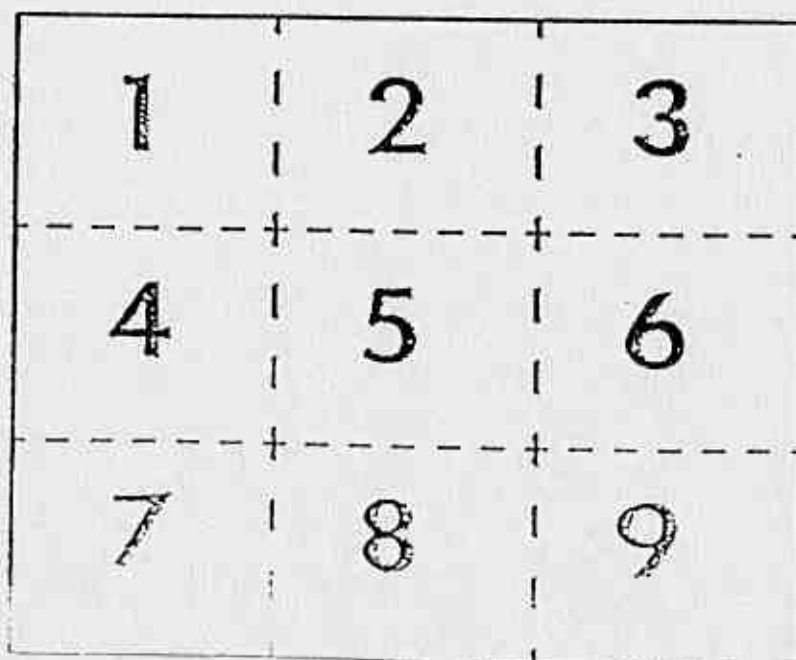
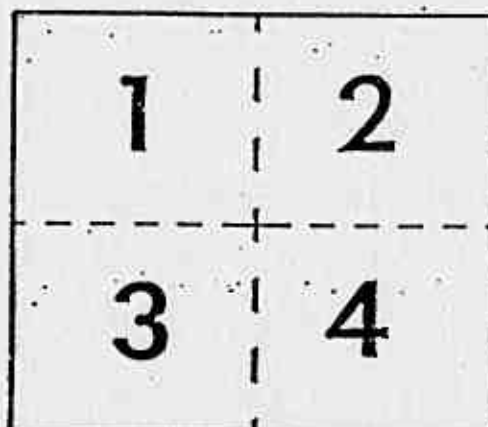
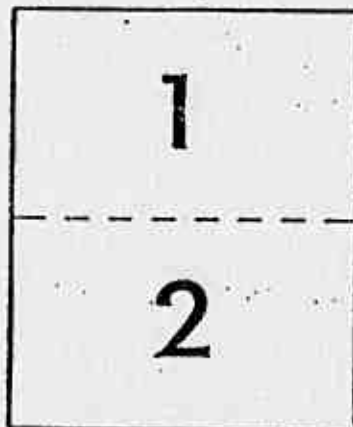

This detachment has two block posts under its command. For convenience in filing these are known as CHILAPRI I and CHILAPRI II. One of these block posts is on a road to COPALAN and is kept fairly busy, while the other, being on a third class road, has very little traffic passing through it.

Accommodation at Block Posts. The huts at the two block posts are newly built and quite large enough to accommodate those on duty. In each hut is a telephone and stove. However the shortage of wood renders the latter almost useless. The duty roster consists of one man for day duty and two for night. The only lighting at the block posts is that provided by electric power and in recent weeks, owing to the national shortage, this has been unreliable and weak.

The difficulties due to lack of current during the early evening have already been stressed in relation to other block posts.

Baracks. The billet is far from satisfactory both as regards conditions and available space. Since this detachment comes under the command of the officer at TAPACHILAN it is under the immediate command of a Brigadiere. Owing to the lack of space the Brigadiere sleeps in the orderly room while the rest, numbering, seventeen, sleep in a large dormitory. The entire barracks is in a deplorable state of disrepair. There are very few windows and doors left intact and in most cases stoking is the only substitute. In addition, due to the shortage of wood, there is little or no heating. There are also no recreational facilities in the barracks.

Food. Rations are good and quite substantial. ⁴⁵⁹² t cooking facilities are remarkable if only for their absence. The small stove has to suffice for the entire cooking of the detachment and again the shortage of wood increases the difficulties. There are very few cooking utensils and the only eating utensils are mess-tins. Water for washing and cooking has to be carried from a well nearly half a mile distant.

Equipment. This detachment is armed with rifles and some but lacks pistols. These arms are clean and in good condition. They are stacked in racks bearing the name and number of the owners. As far as is possible the personal kit of the men is well kept and in good condition.

Sanitation. Considering the state of the billet the latrine is good. It is conveniently situated inside the building.

Personal Cleanliness. This appears to be quite satisfactory. The men are required to fold their bedding and lay out their kits in an orderly fashion. The barracks and its area are kept extremely clean and tidy. Each man must wash and shave each morning regardless of whether he is on duty or not.

Transport. This detachment has no transport of any sort.

Morale. Discipline among these men is very good and the block posts are run in an efficient manner. Their morale appears to be high in spite of the depressing conditions under which they live.
