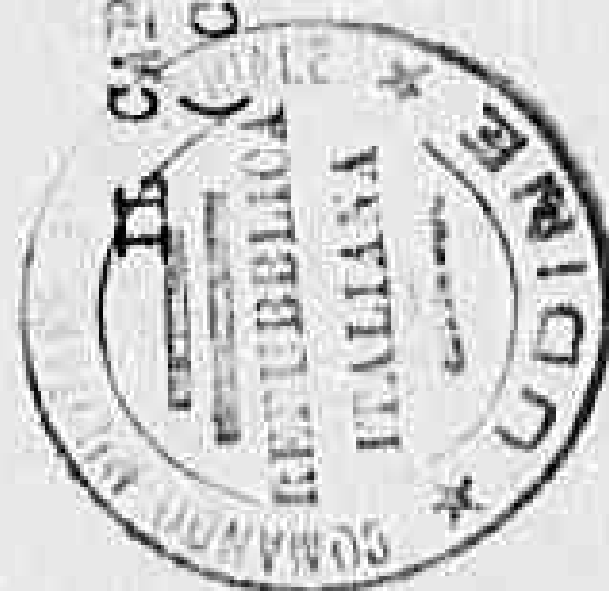

1. Information from all sources indicates that both wings of the local Partisan movement are busily preparing for the celebrations on the 2nd June, in connection with the presentation by the Italian Chief of State of a gold medal to the city of Udine for its part in the struggle for liberation.

The OSOPFO, acting on reports that the ANPI have ordered a GARIBOLDINI mobilization for the occasion, is seeking reinforcements from outside the Province, and detachments from GORIZIA and TRIESTE are expected. In all, it is estimated that 7-10,000 supporters from each faction will gather in Udine on the 2 June 1947.

2. The leaders of each Group have declared that they have no intention of creating incidents, and that they will do all in their power to see that order and discipline prevail.

3. It is appreciated, however, that risk of small incidents is probable, and of serious disturbances possible, given the fact that for the first time large organized opposing groups are to celebrate a provincial occasion on the same day in the same place.

4. The following suggestions for diminishing the risk of incidents are submitted for your consideration:

- a) All British Troops in Udine to be Confined to Barracks on 2 June 1947. UDINE to be OUT OF BOUNDS to all visiting military.
- b) Italian Troops to be allowed to attend the ceremony only in organized parties under their regimental N.C.O.'s and Officers. All other Italian Troops to be confined to Barracks
- c) W.D. traffic using the Treviso-Udine - Trieste road to be directed onto the by-pass by CIP, and not allowed to pass through the town.

- g) Strong Civil Police patrols to be in evidence.

5. This Section will cover the days celebrations, using NCO's civilian clothes as observers. Progress reports will be phoned to at hourly intervals, or more frequently if the occasion warrants

6. It is not recommended that the city should be cordoned off to prevent outside parties entering. This measure might leave us open to public accusation of undemocratic practices, ie, withholding the right of free assembly without justification, and the peaceful nature of past demonstrations does not seem to justify such a step.
