SUBJECT:- Report.

TO:- Capo Sezione Sede.

At 1030hrs of 29 Sept 47 Rag Bracchi owner of the building in Via Tarvisio No 4, requisitioned by the RAP for Offra Mens, came to my Office and invited me to go with him to that villa in order to impede that the persons occupying the villa, who were moving away, remove furniture. This because it was known that they had already removed furniture belonging to him, and to Mr Colla who occupied a part of the villa

We went to the Town Major and with him we went on the spot. We then saw that some POWs, commanded by a RAP capt were taking away from flats furniture and put them in the garden waiting for transport.

The Town Major interrogated the Offr who answered that he did not know the owner of the furniture as in the consignment statements in his possession, the furniture which resulted requisitioned were only 3 pieces. I showed them my requisition statement made by myself and countersigned by the owner, by our OC and by representative of Ufficio Tecnico Erariale. In that statement the owner stated and listed various furniture pieces existing in the houses, and which were partially of his property and partially belonging to Mr Colla.

The RAP Capt said then that such a statement was not valid for him because was not signed by the Officer of the Unit which occupied the villa.

In that moment a Senior RAP Offr came in and spoke first to the Town Major then to the Capt. After that the Town Major went away in his car and the a/m Offr entered the garden sent for an Interpreter and through him ordered in a hurtful and arrogant way to leave the place immediately

Mr Bracchi and myself as saw useless any word went on the street. From there Mr Bracchi in a last attempt to be heard, went again in the garden showing a paper in which were shown his merits with the British Authorities, trying to be heard by the Offr. After few steps the Offr ordered to him to go away and to come back alone in other moment, and precisely at 1600 hrs the same day

Reference your 3292/64, dated 23rd August, 1947.

I have studied the claims put forward by the Italian Comando Territoriale Militare and wish to point out that a claim by the Territorial Command for all property belonging to the Ministry of War in Allied Military Government territory appears to be an impossible one to satisfy.

It must be appreciated that the Allies are still in occupation and utilise a great deal of requisitioned property. There has also been considerable war damage in the Province; both of these factors have contributed to the accommodation of persons so displaced in any building available. The recent arrival of the Italian Army in the Province has increased the accommodation problem and it is understood that the Italian Army at present in Udine is in occupation of a number of buildings which do not belong to the Ministry of War.

However, I feel that where-ever possible we should endeavour to assist the Italian Territorial Command to the maximum of our ability. To this end I think you should ask the Sindaci of the communes in which the Territorial Command particularly require certain accommodation, in all - 18 buildings out of the 37 which they have listed, to give you this information:-

1. Whether present occupants were formerly residents of the Comune.
2. The reason for occupying their present accommodation.
3. On whose authority did the present occupants enter accommodation.
4. Whether any reasonable alternative accommodation is available.

It should be impressed on the Sindaci that where there has been a reduction in Allied troops recently alternative accommodation for persons who might be required to move from Italian Army property ought to be made available in the Communes.

I feel also that the time has come when displaced persons who were not residents in Udine prior to the War should be ordered to return to their former Communes.

SUBJECT:- Arrangements for Italian Troops in the VENETO Region.

TO :- H.E. the PREFECT of UDINE.

1. In the plan for arrangement of Italian Troops in the Veneto Region the Italian Military Commands could not use for their personnel the premises derequisitioned by the Allied Authorities, as stated by War Ministry with their letter 215550/II dated 27 Jun 47 to the Prefects of VENETO.

2. On the other side there are many premises belonging to the Military Authorities (barracks and other lodgings) which were occupied by civilians when evacuated, and which have not been yet given back to the Military Administration.

Such occupation, even if regularized then for the Administrative purposes, are not admissible normally, and have been tolerated in view of the particular general situation.

3. The influx of the new Units of Italian Army in this Region now causes a new situation as this Command must take under consideration the necessity of lodging many families of Officers and WOs who since a long time go around from a Region to another without any possibility of stop and find accommodation.

It is clear that owing to this situation, I, the Commander, must request that at least the property of the Italian Military Administration is given back to the Military Authorities as soon as possible.

On my side I have helped requests of Civilian Authorities and Assistance Associations in various ways when it was possible, so I now apply to Your Excellency so that my exigencies are satisfied, as I now request the restitution of what belongs to the Military Administration.

According to the above:-

a) I have requested the dependent Comando Venio to start action in order to obtain from the Comune of Cervignano, evacuation of civilians from the III Armata Barracks (ref your 37736/IV dated 16 Aug 47).

b) I ask Your Excellency to give all the possible assistance so that the various authorities provide to evacuate as soon as possible the military premises necessary to this Command for accommodation of at least the first group of families of Offrs and WOs who particularly need accommodation.

Herewith appended a list of premises belonging to the Military Authorities occupied by civilians. Underlined are the premises in respect of which need is particularly felt.

1. On 6 August I received a visit from Capt. RAYSON, RE of 256 Wks Scot RE who said he was acting for 44 Town Major - now on leave in UK.

2. He raised the question of the VILLA BRAZZA at BRAZZA which he said, was still under ALLIED REQUISITION.

3. He had visited the villa in company with his CEE from VENICE and the property was required at once for an incoming higher formation.

4. It was stated that he had found Italian soldiers working in the villa and in consequence his CEE was angry and demanded that they be removed forthwith.

5. A communication was at once sent to 5 Territorial Command (Copy to 44 Town Major) informing them of the situation.

6. 5 Territorial Command then informed this HQ that the Commander MANTOVA DIV (Gen MONTESELO) was intending to occupy the house and it had been reserved for him.

7. S/Capt "Q" HQ 3 A.C.R.A. was also informed and he confirmed that the villa would be required and that the General should if possible be persuaded not to take possession for a few days until the various difficulties had been sorted out.

8. Later Gen Monteseulo was seen by me in company with the Chief of Staff, 5 Territorial Command.

9. The General stated his family had arrived and that he had occupied the house and he intended to stay there.

2. He raised the question of the VILLA BRAMBA at BRANLACCO which he said, was still under ALLIED REQUISITION.

4. It was stated that he had found Italian soldiers working in the villa and in consequence his CEE was angry and demanded that they be removed forthwith.
5. A communication was at once sent to 5 Territorial Command (Copy to 44 Town Major) informing them of the situation.
6. 5 Territorial Command then informed this HQ that the Commander MASHOVA DIV (Gen MONTESEMLO) was intending to occupy the house and it had been reserved for him.
7. S/Capt "Q" HQ 3 A.C.R.A. was also informed and he confirmed that the villa would be required and that the General should if possible be persuaded not to take possession for a few days until the various difficulties had been sorted out.
8. Later Gen Montesezolo was seen by me in company with the Chief of Staff, 5 Territorial Command.
9. The General stated his family had arrived and that he had occupied the house and he intended to stay there.
10. I respectfully acquainted him with the administrative situation and he replied that his authority for entering the property was as follows:-
  - (a) He had been invited to do so by an Air Force Officer of superior rank - who had previously occupied the property.
  - (b) This arrangement had been made in collaboration with the Town Major and Col Houser (Italian Liaison Officer working with 44 Town Major).

10. It would also appear that Major Johnson late of this HQ and now in UK, had had some dealings in the matter which arose at the time when it seemed certain powers of requisitioning would be given to the Italian Army.

(c) The General also stated that the Villa was the property of a member of his family.

11. I assured him everything would be done to clarify the matter and arrive at a satisfactory solution.

12. General Montemarlo's attitude was curt and blunt and he made it clear that he was in and intended to stay in, if necessary he would see you personally.

13. The General then drew my attention to an article in an ~~Italian~~ Italian Newspaper, the headlines of which indicated that the Allied Quarters in Italy were costing several hundred million lire annually.

14. I assured him that the matter of his house would if necessary be brought to your own personal notice.
