SUBJECT: Relationship with Italian Military Affairs Section, AFHQ

TO : Capitaine de Vaisseau de Villefrance

Reference: Letter, G-3, AFHQ/132 "Organization for Italian Military Affairs", 28 January 1947, addressed to Chief, French Military Mission to AFHQ.

1. In view of your recent interview with the Supreme Allied Commander, Mediterranean, it is confirmed that para 2 of the above mentioned letter no longer applies.

2. As stated in para 3 of the reference letter the Chief of the Italian Military Affairs Section (IMAS) has been instructed verbally to insure close liaison between yourself and the sub-sections of IMAS.

3. Any matters, unconnected with the Italian Armed Forces, which you may wish to represent may be raised directly with his headquarters either by you personally or through the present Chief, French Military Mission to AFHQ. It is considered that this method of approach will be more expeditious than the use of LACAB as a channel of communication, in that the latter organization is merely a detached branch of AFHQ without executive authority. The Chief of LACAB has nevertheless been instructed to give you any assistance within his power.
