My dear Mr. Minister:

I refer to my letter of 5 February 1947 file TMAS/0/8/2/LF to the Undersecretary of State to the Presidency of the Council of Ministers on the subject of the demilitarization of Pantelleria and Lampedusa, copy of which I am enclosing. Recent inspections of the progress of demilitarization of these islands in accordance with the program of demilitarization prepared by the Demilitarization Committee following its visit of 22-27 July 1946 indicate that as yet no action has been taken with respect to projects P-4, P-8, P-11 and P-12 of the program, copy also enclosed.

The Supreme Allied Commander is desirous that demilitarization be completed prior to the withdrawal of Allied Forces from Italy. It is, therefore, desired that you give priority to the above listed projects. It is my understanding the L-4 and L-6 have been completed but I should appreciate assurance on this prior to writing off Lampedusa as being completely demilitarized.

I trust, therefore, my dear Mr. Minister, that you will expedite in every way possible the overall demilitarization program, and that I may be informed at an early date of the action taken.

1. The progress reports received from the Demilitarization Committee indicate that the demilitarization of the island of Pantelleria is not proceeding as rapidly as is desired.

2. The demilitarization is the responsibility of the Supreme Allied Commander and he is most desirous that the major portion of this work be completed prior to the withdrawal of the Allied Forces from ITALY.

3. Your progress report of 7 February 1947 states that Lampedusa has been completely demilitarized but no reference is made in Appendix 'B' of said report, to the installations L-4 and L-6 which were reported as "No Action As Yet" in your preceding report of 20 December 1946.

4. You are requested:

- a. To expedite the demilitarization as much as possible.

The following progress report on the demilitarization of the Tortugas Islands of PANTELLERIA and LAMPEDUSA covering the period 13 December 1946 to 4 February 1947 is submitted in continuation of progress reports dated 2 October 1946, and 20 December 1946 and in accordance with paragraph 4 *in* *the* *progress* *letter* G-3, ATHQ/131/2 dated *29 June 1946.*

Reference is made to your letter dated 24 October 46, file 83565/16644/16/19.11 to the Chief Commissioner, Allied Commission, transmitting a program for the conversion of existing military installations on the islands of Pantelleria and Lampedusa to civilian purposes.

The proposals were forwarded to Allied Force Headquarters where they have been carefully reviewed. I am instructed to inform you that on the basis of these studies the decision has been reached that there can be no relaxation of the existing directives as regards the demilitarization of these islands.

It is, therefore, desired that existing instructions be carried out as expeditiously as possible.


