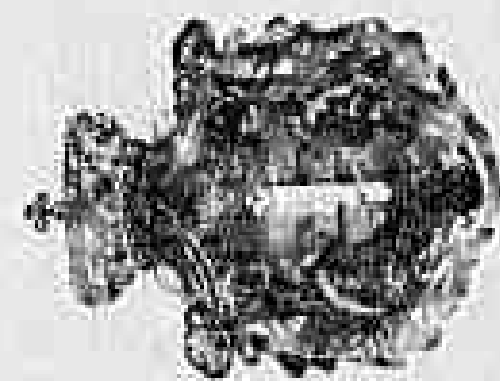

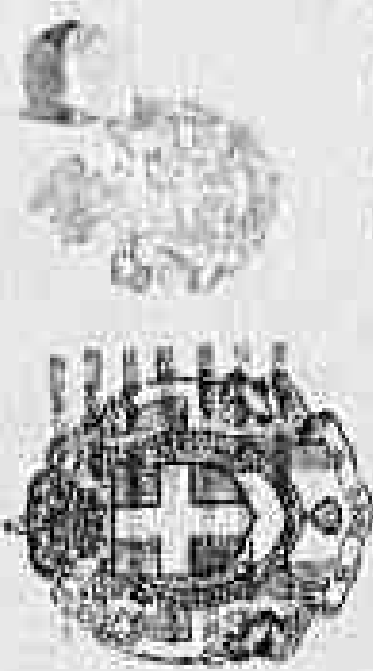

1. The Commander-in-Chief, U. S. Fleet and Chief of Naval Operations was advised by reference (a) as to rates of pay advances established for personnel attached to Italian submarines operating under U. S. control at Bermuda. The rates established were confirmed by reference (b).

2. The Italian Minister of Marine on 29 May 1944, requested that in addition to pay advances previously authorized that the personnel of Italian submarines operating at Bermuda may receive the following sums per month, in dollars. These payments are understood to be used solely to cover mess expenses and laundry.

For each Officer: 35 dollars per month.
(Per ciascun Ufficiale: dollari Mensili 35)

For each Petty Officer: 5 dollars per month.
(Per ciascun Sottufficiale: dollari mensili 5).

For each Ldg. Hand and others: 2 dollars per month.
(Per ciascun Sergente, Sottocap e comune: dollari mensili 2).

3. It is recommended that U. S. Naval Disbursing Officers be authorized and directed to advance funds for the payment of the additional allowances which have been approved by the Italian Minister of Marine.

MEMORANDUM for Senior U.S. Naval Officer, Italy.

Subject: Spare Parts for Italian Submarines at Bermuda.

Reference: (a) CINCPAC's 042002 June.

1. Comdr. CHIALABERTI and Major FESTUCCIA confirmed that JALEA and ONICE are carrying as many of their own spares as possible. Their capacity will be small owing to additional personnel and clothing stores, and there is no room for spares for other types of S/Ms. SO (LI) believes no reply necessary to reference (a).

2. (a) Spares from NAPLES and Taranto are nearly all crated, and assembled in warehouse (S/M) 43.

(b) Loose spares ex CHERSO are heaped, in a battered junk pile, near NW corner of Graving dock PRINCIPE DI NAPOLI.

(c) Boxed spares ex CHERSO are partially unloaded, including most of spares needed for Bermuda. But there are still 40 or 50 cases of S/M spares, a few of which are needed, lying untouched in her hold.

3. CHERSO's berth was moved yesterday from TB mole to "CARRIERA" at extreme East end of Arsenal, where U/T cannot come alongside. The one lighter unloaded the Air Force material, and then disappeared. The dockyard is full of parades celebrating the fall of Rome, and the unloading has stopped.

4. I thereupon called on Adm. CORREALI, who promised to send a lighter or tug alongside CHERSO immediately.

5. There are literally several thousand S/M spare parts of all descriptions, scattered about the Arsenal, coming from three sources: NAPLES, MADALENA, and TARANTO. The more important work of sorting, listing and crating the Naples and Taranto spares is practically completed. There is no question that these can be shipped on SS PIERRE SOULE or earlier if another vessel should become available.

The CHERSO spares, more numerous but less needed in Bermuda, may not even catch the SS PIERRE SOULE. It will take several days even to set a date for a reliable list. As MARELA and VORTICE are a new type of S/M, there are few if any spares available for them, involving a long process of finding spares (for older types) that can be adapted.
