Subject: Personnel from the ships stationed in the Bitter Lakes

With regard to the request of the Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean, I propose the repatriation of 96 men (18 per vessel) from the ships stationed in the Bitter Lakes.

For the moment I would consider it desirable to restrict the reductions to that figure owing to the repercussions which they could have on the morale of the crews, as I have explained already to Admiral Willis. Indeed, it is to be observed that the present complement table did not provide for the A.A. armament to be manned by personnel borne for that purpose alone, although it was intended that the personnel borne for the maintenance of the weapons should man them in case of need.


The reduction made mainly affects the personnel in charge of the weapons and machines.

M E M O R A N D U M

Reference is made to the Navy Sub Commission's letter No.4339 of 31st December 1945.

The Ministry of Marine proposed to appoint Capt. BASLINI to the Inspectorate of Minesweeping considering the importance of this service and the fact that Capt. FLORENTINO will have to leave the service in the course of 1946 owing to his exceeding the age limit established by definite provisions of the law.

The presence of Captains FLORENTINO and BASLINI simultaneously at the Inspectorate of Minesweeping for the long period of turning over duties would assure continuity of direction in such an important service; the present time seems most suitable for this turn over both because there is in progress the organisation of the new craft lent by the British Navy, and because - after the winter season during which activities are reduced of necessity - Captain BASLINI will find himself well versed in all details of organisation at the beginning of a period of intense activity.

It is suggested that it would be desirable to bring these considerations - and in particular the expected retirement of Captain FLORENTINO in 1946 - to the notice of the Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean, since it is in consideration of the importance given to the M/S services at the present moment that this Ministry of Marine has essayed to ensure in good time that these shall proceed normally in future by appointing to control them a Captain who will be able to continue for a long time in those duties.

Since similar results could be obtained by appointing Captain BASLINI as Vice-Inspector of Minesweeping and prolonging so far as possible the period when Captains FLORENTINO and BASLINI would be present there together, it is suggested that it would be desirable to ask for the Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean's agreement to the appointment of Captain BASLINI as Vice-Inspector of Minesweeping.

1. I should like to bring to your notice the very excellent work performed by Capitano di Frigata SANTINI, Guido, a Reserve Officer of the Italian Navy, in the important and onerous post of Questore of the Province of Padova.

2. Captain Santini was selected for the post in the early days of the liberation. He has carried out his work with courage, ability and devotion to duty worthy of the highest praise. He has maintained valuable cooperation at all times with the Public Safety Officers of Allied Commission and with those of the 6th Armoured Division.




