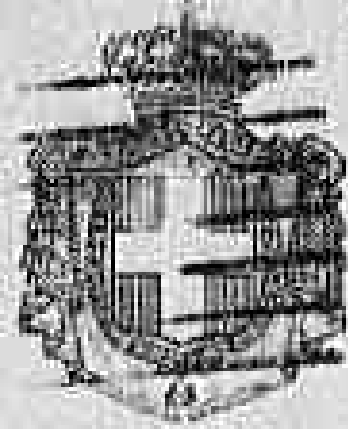

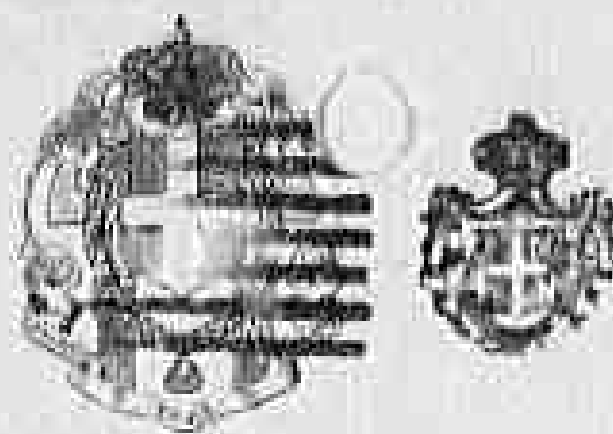

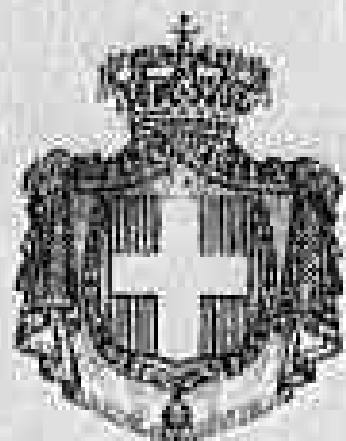

Reference is made to our SM/16188 and SM/16611 of 7th and 12th August 1945 respectively.

1. At the present time there are I.R.N. personnel appointed to the Assistance Office in Trieste who were already there at the time of the liberation of the town. Certain of these Officers and Petty Officers belonged to the ex-Republican Navy and have not been screened as yet.

2. In view of the lack of precise information due to the impossibility of sending a representative of the Ministry and in view of the urgency and importance of the problems to be solved, a situation has been created in that base which, beyond the damage it does to I.R.N. prestige, also renders impossible complete collaboration with the Allied Authorities even within the confines of that particular sector.

3. In order to remedy the above state of affairs your attention is called to the urgent need to send at least one other Officer to Trieste, in the manner and form considered most suitable by the N.S.C. which is better informed of the local situation. In carrying out his task this officer would maintain contact and close collaboration with the Allied Authorities there.

Reference is made to signal No. 12385 of 28th January 1946.

In general it is agreed, as suggested, that it is necessary to nominate a "Superintendent" at Naples to take charge of material coming from Great Britain and allocated to the I.R.N.

Should there be no objection, this responsibility will be entrusted to Captain SANDRELLI Pietro, who, in the quality of Commanding Officer of the Naples Naval Base, will be able to make use of the equipment and technical departments under his command in order to discharge the abovementioned duties.

It is considered necessary, however, to observe that the I.R.N. equipment and personnel presently at Naples is being considerably reduced and, in consequence, that base will not be in a position in the near future to receive and take charge of all materials in question.

It is suggested, therefore, that it would be desirable for the arrival of ships, the quantity and nature of the material to be discharged, to be communicated sufficiently in advance in order that it can be decided, in cases of very large cargoes for which the means available at Naples are inadequate, that the ships - if deemed possible - should continue to Taranto or La Spezia, which bases are more suitably equipped.

Should this proposal be approved a "Superintendent" will also be appointed for La Spezia.

With reference to your NSC/4444 dated 16th January, 1946, the question of the appointment of a Captain of the Port at Trieste was recently discussed at a meeting of the Port Control Committee, on which 13 Corps is represented.

2. The opinion of this Committee is that, as the Acting Captain of the Port (Dr. P. Klotic) is carrying out his duties satisfactorily, coupled with the help that is given by this Office, it is not necessary or desirable to appoint anyone over his head at this juncture.

3. Trieste is not like any other Port in Italy, where Allied Military Government rule through the local Italian Authorities nor is the future status of the Port yet known and, until it is known, it is not possible to start handing it back to civil control.

4. It is the opinion of the Committee that, had they considered it necessary to elect a Captain of the Port now, they would have recommended an Allied Officer, i.e. either American or British - but definitely not an Italian.

5. It is also observed that, as the majority of the shipping using the Port at the moment is Allied, most of the points mentioned in the Ministry's letter do not arise and those that do arise can be adequately dealt with by existing facilities.

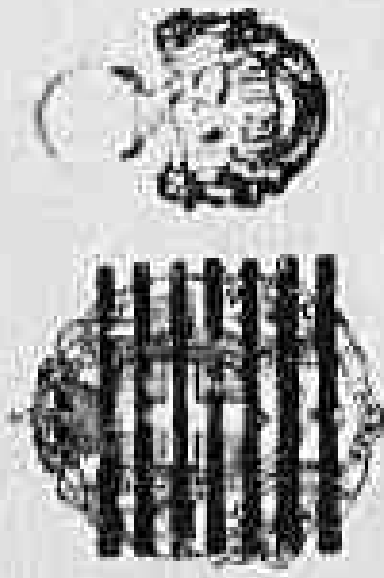
Subject: State of the Captain of the Port's Office at Trieste.

1. The services of the Captain of the Port's Office, Trieste, which had already been confused considerably during the German occupation, were completely disorganised during the Yugoslav occupation of the city from 1st May to 21st August 1945.
2. The lack of technical personnel suited for directive positions renders purely formal the functioning of such an important administrative body, causing very serious harm to people connected with the sea - both afloat and on shore - who find it impossible at present to obtain mariner's documents in order to gain in consequence Master's certificates, pensions, compensation for accidents, etc.
3. Leaving aside the matter of technical services in the harbour, for which this Ministry is aware that a British Harbour Master is present in Trieste, it is observed that it is urgently necessary to arrange for an official of the Captain of the Port's Dept., dressed as a civilian, to resume in Trieste the functions which he exercised there prior to May last, in a like manner to the practice which has held good for some time in other administrative offices.
4. It is proposed that the post of Director of Maritime services and Officer in Charge of the Captain of the Port's Dept., at Trieste, should be assigned to Dr. BLOLE' Alfredo, presently Director of the Harbour Works Dept., and held in good esteem by the Allied Authorities for the active collaboration which he has given hitherto.
5. It is understood that the responsibilities of the Maritime Directorate and Captain of the Port's Dept., shall be restricted to Administration only (seafaring persons - Crown Offices - fishing - assistance to seamen's families - pensions, etc.), being excluded the technical services of the port in which - as is quite evident - the British Harbour Master shall be given such collaboration as he may request.
6. As is known, the collaboration of personnel of the Captain of Port's Departments elsewhere has been well appreciated by the Allied Authorities.

La mancanza di personale idoneo a funzioni direttive rende puramente formale il funzionamento di un così importante organo amministrativo, con gravissimo danno particolarmente della gente di mare, navigante e litoranea, che non trova attualmente la possibilità di ottenere i documenti di navigazione, gli accertamenti di imbarco e di servizio marittimo, ai fini del conseguimento di patenti di grado, di pensioni, di indennizzo per infortuni etc.
3. Prescindendo dai servizi tecnici del porto, per i quali è già nota a questo Ministero la presenza a Trieste di un Harbour Master inglese, si prospetta l'urgenza di disporre che un funzionario della Capitaneria riprenda a Trieste, in veste civile, le funzioni che vi esercitava già prima del Maggio u.s., a somiglianza di quanto è stato da tempo praticato per gli altri uffici amministrativi.

1. A survey of the northern sea coast in the interest of rehabilitating commercial fishing shows the immediate need for the appointments of Italian Captains of the port.
2. As it is known Captains of the port and Delegati di Spiaggia (Dependent officers) are charged with the responsibility of issuing fishing permits, enrollment of boats and crews. In addition their offices are needed by AMG and AC authorities for the distribution of supplies and equipment in order to reach the fishermen direct and eliminate speculation on the part of middlemen.
3. It is urgently requested that Compartments' Maritime Directors and their subordinate Captains of the port be appointed as soon as possible in the northern regions of the Adriatic and Tyrrhenian seas for the reasons outlined above.
