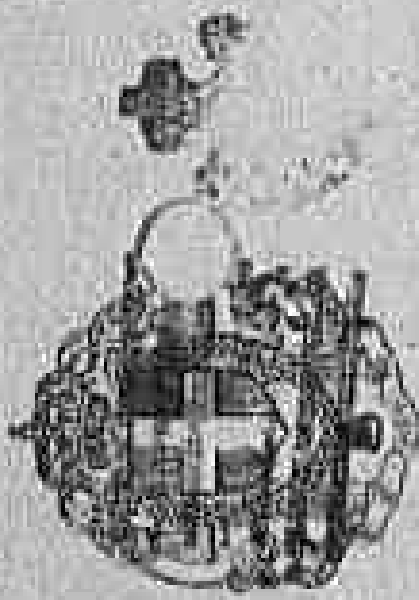

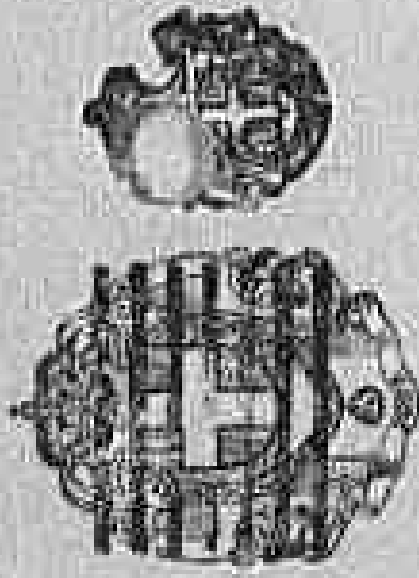

1. Further reference is made to my 11287/2 dated 8 June '45.
2. Following the release of the 1920 class, and in order to discharge ratings of the 1921 class it is necessary for this Ministry to order the Port Captaincies in the provinces of Northern Italy under A.M.G. control to enlist the 1923 and 1924 classes.
3. The call-up of the 1923 and 1924 classes which has already taken place in the provinces of Central and Southern Italy would be extended thus to the provinces of the North, completing and standardising the call-up of Naval ratings for the whole of Italy.
4. The inflow of recruits at the Port Captaincies in the North would be gradual, and would be carried out in two distinct phases : the first from 1st October with an estimated contingent of 3000 men, the second from 15th November with another contingent also estimated at 3000 men.
5. The area of the call-up would not extend to the east beyond the boundary of the Captaincy of the Port of Venice.
6. The ratings from the Adriatic Ports (Venice, Ravenna, Chioggia, Ancona) would receive their uniforms and enrol at Venice. Those from the Tyrrhenian ports (Imperia, Savona, Genoa, La Spezia, Leghorn, etc.) would be taken to receive their uniforms and enrol at Messina and Taranto.
7. The Ministry awaits the approval of the N.S.C. prior to issuing orders for this to be done.

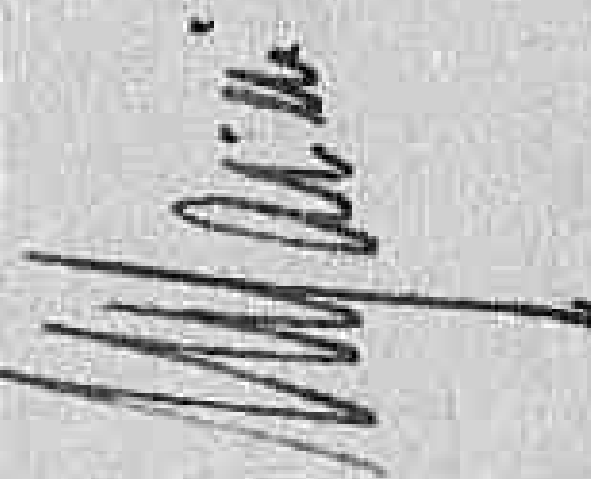

On 10th ulto. the recruiting of remaining 1923 Cl. men commenced at the Sardinian and Sicilian Captaincies of the Port as well as on the Mainland between Straits of Messina and Naples and Bari Captaincies, inclusive.

It was estimated that 1568 bodies would be called-up; 948 in N° presented themselves as follows :-

Recruits incorporated therefore reach 65% approx.

It is considered that the call-up has been satisfactory as this Ministry gave approval for many recruits to join other Forces (Army, Air Force and "Coastguards"), and because many are working for Allied Commands, and lastly on account of a number having been given time to finish their studies.

Due to lack of time, particulars have still to come in from Captaincies of the Port.

In Sicily, 42% of the recruits presented themselves. The remaining 58% (519 in N° bodies), according to Marinarmi, did not do so for following reasons :-

- 22% already under arms, confirmed by Captaincies;
- 22% accounted for on scores proved legally;
- 14% unjustifiably absent.

SUBJECT: Italian Army-Call-up.

TO : Allied Force Headquarters.

1. AFHQ Administrative Memorandum No. 10 dated 20 February 45 entitled "Conditions under which Italians will be exempted from Military Service" was written at a time when Italy, as far as liberated, was under control of the Allied Authorities and when the Italian Army, for which recruits were being called up, was largely operating under control of AFHQ. Since then practically the whole of Italy has been handed back to the Italian Government and the interim Italian Army has been returned to the control of the Italian Ministry of War vide AFHQ AGO91.711 GSD/O of 2 December 1945.

2. The Italian War Ministry is now calling up new age groups for limited service in the Italian Army in order to maintain it at the strength authorized by the Combined Chiefs of Staff as laid down in the above-quoted letter. Now that active operations have ceased and in view of the fact that the labour market is far more open to the Allied authorities due to unemployment and also that few men liable to military call-up can be regarded as key men, the retention by Allied military authorities of these young men would not appear to be advisable.

3. In these circumstances it is recommended that exemption from Military Service should now be left entirely in the hands of the Italian Government and that the above quoted Administrative Memorandum either be cancelled or suitably amended.

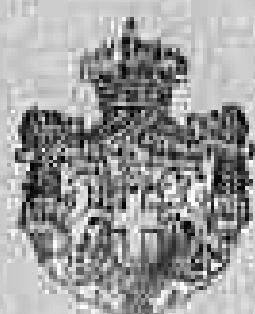

My dear Mr. Prime Minister,

You are no doubt aware of the amendment to Article 52 of the Draft Italian Peace Treaty which was discussed by the Military Commission in Paris about 3 September. I have been informed that it was agreed to insert a new Article No. 40 (A) to the effect that in no case shall any officer or non-commissioned officer of the former Fascist Militia or the former Fascist Republican Army be admitted with officer's or non-commissioned officer's rank to the Italian Army, Navy, Air Forces or Carabinieri with the exception of such persons as have been exonerated by the appropriate body in accordance with Italian law.

I am not aware, my dear Mr. Prime Minister, to what extent this new clause may affect the Italian Armed Forces, but I feel sure that you will want to take such action as may be advisable at this stage.
