1. It appears that there is available for sale at the Q.M.P.B.S. 5155, Leghorn, a considerable quantity of woollen rags -between 1000 and 2000 Quintals. It is considered that this material could be subjected to industrial processes and made into military cloth.

2. In view of the serious difficulties which are met in the supply of military cloth, and of the present needs of the I.R.N., it is desired that an urgent request may be made of the appropriate Allied Authorities for at least a large part of the above material to be put aside for the I.R.N.


3. The opportunity is taken to observe, that the I.R.N. would appreciate advice of any further sales of woollen waste-goods in order that it may take advantage of them.
