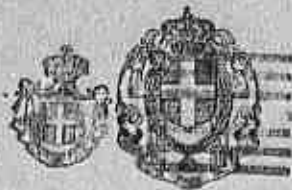
3. The opportunity is taken to observe, that the I.R.N. would appreciate advice of any further sales of woollen waste-goods in order that it may take advantage of them.

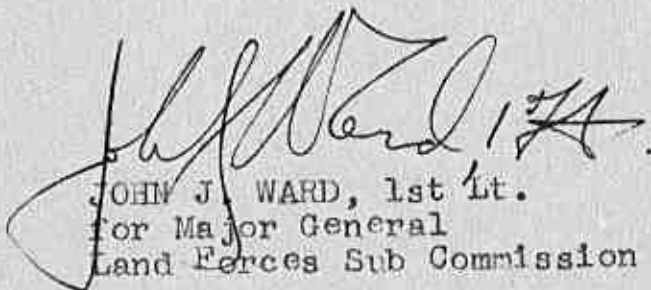
