ITALIAN SHIP ALISEO BASED AT NAPLES SAILING TO GENOA HAS REQUESTED EMERGENCY RATIONS FOR 6 DAYS AT MADDALENA TWICE IN ONE WEEK STATING THEY COULD NOT REPEAT NOT DRAW RATIONS AT GENOA. I AUTHORIZED 3 DAYS EACH CASE. SIMILAR ITALIAN SHIP IBIS HAS REQUESTED MORE RATIONS THAN REQUIRED TO GET BACK TO BASE AT PALERMO STATING DIFFICULT TO DRAW RATIONS THERE. I ONLY AUTHORISE SUFFICIENT FOR EMERGENCY PLUS SAFETY FACTOR. THIS OFFICE MAINTAINS THAT DUE TO SHIPPING FACILITIES OF FOOD TO SARDINIA THAT THESE SHIPS SHOULD NORMALLY BE SUPPLIED FROM MAINLAND AND ONLY IN EMERGENCY SHOULD THEY RECEIVE RATIONS HERE. REQUEST CONFIRMATION

1. It has been decided that Refugees travelling under arrangements made by Allied Commission, Displaced Persons, and Repatriation Sub-Commission will be provided with a travel ration in addition to the Camp Feeding facilities and meals supplied at Railway Station Feeding points.

2. The ration will be:

200 grams of Bread
60 grams of Preserved Meat, or, when available from local sources,
75 grams Cheese

For each day of travel

The above ration may be supplemented by purchase of uncontrolled items such as fresh fruit, wine, etc. Wherever possible, cheese should be provided in lieu of meat.

Women, children, and sick persons will receive in addition:

50 grams Powd. Milk
15 grams Sugar

For each day of travel.

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2. The ration will be:

200 grams of Bread

The above ration may be supplemented by purchase of uncontrolled items such as fresh fruit, wine, etc. Wherever possible, cheese should be provided in lieu of meat.

Women, children, and sick persons will receive in addition:

50 grams Powd. Milk
15 grams Sugar

For each day of travel.

3. Travel rations will be issued at Staging Points or Camps from which a railway journey of eight hours or more commences and will be issued for the duration of the journey to destination or to the next Staging Point or Camp, i.e. one or two days.

4. The provision of Bread and Cheese will be arranged locally in conjunction with General or local Alimentation Office by the Camp Officials.

5. Preserved Meat, Milk and Sugar, will be indented for by the Camps to Septral, or A.C. Food/Supply Officers where established, in accordance with normal practice.

6. Records will be kept showing the number of Rations issued and the quantities involved. These will be shown in the Monthly Rationing Statistics Summary, Section "D".

7. Any travel ration at present being issued without authority from this H.Q. is hereby cancelled and will be replaced by the scale laid down above.
