1. The question of the off-loading of coal at La Spezia has been considered by this Office.
2. The situation at present is that C in C MED having agreed to the use of the port of La Spezia, subject to no Naval responsibility being accepted, has now decided that the entry of Liberty Ships would involve too great a risk until the entrance has been widened, by the removal of wreckage.
3. Smaller ships carrying Sardinian coal will be routed to La Spezia as soon as possible. Other coasters carrying Italian domestic cargoes will also possibly be routed there.
4. Until such time as it is decided that Liberty Ships may enter the port of La Spezia, imported coal for that area will necessarily have to be off-loaded at Leghorn.

Subject: Additional Collier for Italian Navy.

Co. GS. NA. were approached by the Ministry of Marine for the allocation of suitable vessels, and as a result, several schooners were made available. While the supply of Sardinian coal to Italian Navy bases is at present being maintained, it is irregular, inefficient, and suffers from considerable difficulties which would be eliminated by the allocation of an additional collier to the Italian Navy.

2. In view of paragraph 2 of minute 1 however, action has been taken accordingly and the Ministry of Marine have now made arrangements with Co. GS. NA. who, without specifically allocating additional vessels to the Italian Royal Navy, have now undertaken the regular supply of Sardinian coal to Italian Navy bases.

With reference to the Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean's letter No. Med. 45/505/6/3 dated 12th December, 1945 and your signal timed 261217 of February, 1946 (not to the Ministry of War Transport Representative), information is requested whether Cogena has been approached with a view to the release of suitable vessels, as was suggested verbally to your Staff Officer (Supply) by the Assistant Fleet Engineer Officer on the Staff of the Commander-in-Chief, Mediterranean, during his recent visit to Rome.

2. While the need for an additional collier is fully appreciated, it is considered preferable, however, for this matter to be settled locally in Rome, if possible, since it is unlikely now that a satisfactory proposal will be received from the Ministry of War Transport Representative, Mediterranean in view of reductions and withdrawals of Ministry Staff.

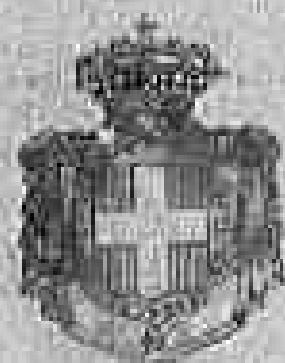

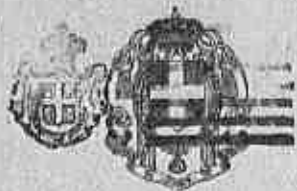
