With reference to the Ministry of Marine's letter SM 24879 dated 13th November, 1945, the spares in question were indented on 557 B.O.D. through the usual channels. Humber spares have always been scarce and the Royal Navy Liaison Representative with Army supplies now states that, despite repeated attempts, it has been impossible to obtain any of the parts.

2. It is regretted that further assistance cannot be rendered, and it is recommended that application be made to the Italian Ministry of Industry and Commerce in accordance with the recent instructions on the supply of motor transport and spares to the Italian Navy.
