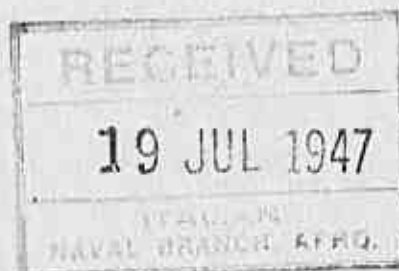



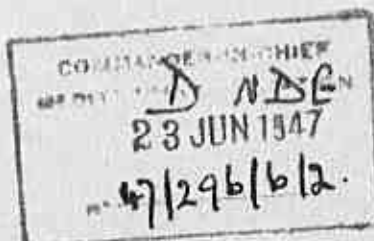

1. Our Naples office informs us that they are holding in the installation of Pozzuoli 135 barrels of products of which they do not know the purpose of use, and which have never been taken into stock. The result of the analysis of the contents made at Naples has been sufficient to determinate for what purpose they are to be used and we are now awaiting a sample which we shall submit to further analysis.
2. The whole quantity was delivered to the above installation in January 1946 by a British sailor to whom a temporary receipt was issued a copy of which we are attaching hereto.
3. Our Naples office contacted, as regards the delivery in question, Capt. Sereni of the Italian Naval Fuelling Office (at the time Liaison Officer with the Royal Naval Fuelling Office) who stated that the product in question was delivered as a donation to CIP.
4. As regards the above statement of Capt. Sereni, we wrote to GHQ - S.T. Directorate who replied that as the stocks in question are not the property of the British Army they are not interested as to their disposal and suggested that we inform the Navy Sub-Commission - Rome.
5. Would you kindly confirm the above statement, as per paragraph 3 above and also inform us as to the use of the product in question?
