I have agreed today with Capt. ANCHER of "A" Branch M.H.I.A. that those patriot representatives who are regular army officers on full pay must be returned to the Ministry of War within one month. Those regular army officers who are on minimum pay need not be returned until they are called for by the Ministry of War.

I shall be glad if you will make this clear to Major General ODONE and ask him to see that we get plenty notice for Italian officers on minimum rates who are called back by the Ministry of War.
