LOMBARDIA.

Fascists and
Personnel to
Leave for GER-
MANY.

Our mission North of BERGAMO reports...

(2) "The same source reports that
Fascists and personnel of the
Republican Army will shortly have
to leave for Germany. Whether or not
they will be allowed to take their
families with them appears to pre-
sent a problem. Perhaps to calm the
disquiet the German Embassy has star-
ted a rumour of the impending arrival
in Italy of ten Divisions and of a
new Patrol-solidifying gas capable
of immobilising engines."

Representative
ready for ROME.

1. "A report from one of our Italian
missions North Of MILAN states
that they have a representative ready
to come to ROME where he will hold

himself at the disposal of the Government. He is awaiting instructions to proceed.

Comment. There is at present no known safe channel through which this representative could reach Southern Italy.

Party disputes.

(a) They admit frequent party disputes on details of management but close questioning confirms that they do carry out the essential job of unifying strength and maintaining resistance in spite of the disappointingly slow progress of the Allied Armies. Withdrawal of our support would result in many thousands having no option but to accept German employment and large numbers of resisters would have to give themselves up.

Action on enemy's withdrawal.

(b) Both are confident that in the event of an enemy withdrawal, his retreat would be harassed and order maintained provided that explosives could be supplied for sabotage work.

Essential action called for.

(c) The prompt arrival of Allied missions with a strong personality at the head of each is considered essential.

Additional support.

(d) In addition to squads already organized in the cities they have bands upon whom they can rely to support the activities of the local committees.

Request Allied Authority in event of delay.

(e) If the arrival of the Allies is delayed, the presence of a "token" force of Allied Authority might prove

himself at the disposal of the Government. He is awaiting instructions to proceed.

(f) Both representatives have been told by our R.L.O. that they have only to assume control until the arrival of A.M.G. They naturally press for acknowledgement if they succeed in their task but accept this ruling.

2. They have requested a written list of tasks to be performed so that they can lay this before the Committee who would be required to elect individuals responsible for each separate task.
