The undersigned feels compelled to make the following report on the trip to Rome he undertook on 4 December 1944 on orders of Major Dr. H. A. Det., Allied Commission, to transport to H. A. Det. the w/w Italian civilians:

- a) Sig. BRUNO;
- b) Ing. TRISTANI;
- c) Sig. RONCHI.

REPORT.

1. While arranging the loading of the luggage of the civilians, I was asked by Sig. TRISTANI if there was room for four to sit down in the vehicle. I answered: "Yes, but aren't there only three?" He said: "Yes, I mean three."
2. After all the luggage was loaded on the truck in front of Hotel Porta Rossa in Florence I took my seat and the civilians started to say good-bye to some people with whom they had been standing in front of the hotel, while climbing on the truck. A few seconds later they shouted: "C.R." or something to that effect, and after I had asked if they were all seated well and had obtained an affirmative answer, I took off.
3. I stopped in Siena in front of the Hotel Excelsior to see if everything was all right because I had heard some moaning during the last few minutes. I looked inside the back of the truck and saw four persons instead of the three I had been ordered to carry. I asked Sig. BRUNO: "Whom do we have here?" and he answered: "A friend of mine. He came along at the last minute because he wants to visit his family." I asked: "Does he have a permit?" BRUNO answered: "Yes. He's sick, he doesn't travel well." By that time he had climbed off the truck and his friend, still moaning, followed him. Moaning all the time and not saying a word to me, he handed to me a piece of paper. It was not issued by him but by an Italian Army Agency, OK. 11 by F. L. G. It was dated 13 October. 1. While arranging the loading of the luggage of the civilians, I was asked by Sig. PIRELLI if there was room for four to sit down in the vehicle. I answered: "Yes, but aren't there only three?" He said: "Yes, I mean three."

After all the luggage was loaded on the truck in front of Hotel Porta Rossa in Florence I took my seat and the civilians started to say goodbye to some people with whom they had been standing in front of the hotel, while climbing on the truck. A few seconds later they shouted: "O.K." or something to that effect, and after I had asked if they were all seated well and had obtained an affirmative answer, I took off.

By that time he had climbed off the truck and his friend, still moaning, followed him. Loading all the time and not saying a word to me, he decided to use a piece of paper. It was not issued by M.C. but by an Italian Army Agency, ok. I by M.A.C. It was dated 13 October. I didn't say anything but went immediately inside the Hotel Excelsior to call up the office in Florence. I tried twice but the line was busy. I then decided to take the man along for two reasons:
  - a) Italian civilians are often treated with an extra-ordinary amount of courtesy and I wasn't sure how official his ally was and didn't want to do the wrong thing in case he was all right.
  - b) I preferred to take him to M.A.C., Security Branch, rather than turn him loose in Rome in case he was not all right, this in view of the fact that he had been smuggled on the truck in such a peculiar, underhanded manner by one of our own civilian employees.

3. Sig. SERE admitted to be the one responsible for planning this, although aware of the fact, as admitted by him, that I might get into trouble if the vehicle should be stopped by U.S. who would have never believed me that I didn't know that I carried a gun without proper permit. Secondly, even in normal times, and in wartime even in the case of an Allied soldier, one never rides in a vehicle without taking permission and without proper authority. Thirdly, he has taken advantage of his status as civilian employee to do a "favour" to someone in a most underhanded and suspicious way.

4. I turned both SERE and his friend over to Sgt. Dino Belli, Security Branch, I.A.C. May I add that since the man's Italian Army rank might be alright, I am afraid that security had to let him go. Nevertheless, I want to point out to my superior officer that the fact that they succeeded after all in obtaining what they wanted, namely to get the man a ride to home, might encourage them to try other "favours" and that they have reason to laugh at me. May I also call attention to the fact that SERE carried a letter of introduction to AUG Haylen, issued by Patriot Branch I.A.C. Det. A. C.

SUBJECT: Payrolls.

TO : All Sub-Commissions, Branches, this HQ.  
(ATTN: Authorizing Officer for Civilian Payrolls)

1. The manner in which payrolls are at present prepared is highly unsatisfactory, and a great amount of unnecessary work and loss of time is entailed in consequence.

2. In order that the present standard may be improved the following instructions are issued for strict compliance by the officers responsible for the preparation of payrolls:

(a) Employees on a daily rate will not be paid for Sundays, unless they work on those days.

(b) Employees on a monthly rate will be paid half of that rate (if a full month is worked) on each payroll. Payrolls will be submitted for 13-day periods, the working month being 26 days. In cases where overtime pay is due, the monthly rate should be divided by twenty-six (26) to determine the daily rate.

(c) It is of the greatest importance that the exact nature of the work of each employee be entered on payrolls, and the function as shown must coincide with one of the official grades.

(d) In a great many cases employees are shown as "Secretary", or "Executive Secretary". It is emphasized that no such grade exists in AMG/ACC (officers do not have "Secretaries") and it is requested that the function of employees who have been so described hitherto be accurately stated, e.g. typist, clerk.

(e) The basic currency for AMG/ACC accounting purposes is the Lira, and foreign currencies must not under any circumstances appear on payrolls. **29**

(f) Official maximum rates of pay must be strictly adhered to in every grade.

(g) Separate payrolls must be prepared for each class of worker. In some cases clerks, labourers, drivers, etc. are included on one payroll.

(h) Rates of pay must be clearly shown, also the period worked so that computation may be easily checked.

(i) It is emphasized that the arithmetical accuracy of payrolls is the responsibility of the authorizing officer, and any overpayments are the personal financial liability of that officer.
