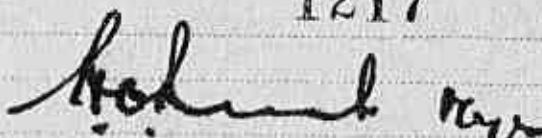

AMG ACCOUNTING MANUALIMPRESTS

1. When an officer stationed in a town where there is no Sub-Accountant (S-A) requires funds for the payment of AMG expenses or if it is more convenient for an officer to make payments from his own office rather than have the disbursements made by a S-A against vouchers approved by him, he will be given a fixed sum of money, or Imprest, out of which such payments may be made.
2. It is not intended that Imprests should be used for making advances to meet communal, etc. deficits or for making large payments of any other nature, but that they should be used exclusively for the payment of salaries of AMG employees and other small items.
3. Officers requiring Imprests should submit an estimate of their needs for a period of 15 days and the amount of the Imprest should be based on this estimate allowing a margin for unforeseen incidental expenses. When the amount of the Imprest is paid over to the Imprest Holder, the S-A will enter the payment in his cash book under the Head: Imprests, and Sub-Head: Name, rank and title of the Imprest Holder.
4. When an Imprest is granted by the C.A. or a S-A, a prenumbered Imprest Warrant (Form F/5) will be made out, in triplicate, to show:
 - (a) The name, rank and title of the Imprest Holder,
 - (b) The date of expiry of the Imprest Warrant,
 - (c) The name and address of the S-A who will replenish the Imprest,
 - (d) The purpose for which the Imprest is granted,
 - (e) The amount of the Imprest, and
 - (f) The date and signature of the authorizing officer.
5. The originals of all Imprest Warrants issued by S-A's will be given to the Imprest Holders and must be produced by the latter whenever their funds require replenishing and must be surrendered when the Imprests are retired. The duplicates will be forwarded by the S-A's to the C.A. with the monthly Report of Receipts and Disbursements and the triplicates retained by the S-A's.
6. Whenever a payment has to be made by an Imprest Holder, he will prepare, in duplicate, either a Payroll (Form F/4) or a Payment Voucher (Form F/3) in support of the disbursement, noting thereon the number of his Imprest Warrant; these vouchers must, of course, be authorized and receipted in the usual way and the certificate of payment completed. An Imprest Holder may find it convenient to prepare his Payrolls in triplicate so that he can retain a copy for future reference.

7. A few days before the fifteenth and last days of each month, the Imprest Holder will turn over to the S-A named in the Imprest Warrant the originals and duplicates of the vouchers, properly authorized and receipted, for all disbursements he has made to date and will be reimbursed the exact amount he has spent, thereby reconstituting in cash the full amount of the Imprest. Thus, an Imprest Holder must always have in his possession cash or properly authorized and receipted vouchers or both for the full amount of his Imprest. In these circumstances, it will not be essential for Imprest Holders to maintain cash books, but they may do so for their own convenience.

8. When Imprests are replenished, as explained above, the S-A will enter as a separate item on the payment side of his cash book each voucher presented for reimbursement and will classify these items according to the nature of the payments made by the Imprest Holder. It will not be necessary for the S-A to make out further Payment Vouchers (Form F/3) to support his disbursements, as the vouchers turned in by the Imprest Holders are all that are necessary. It will, however, be the duty of the S-A to see that all vouchers are properly authorized, receipted and arithmetically correct before the refund is made to the Imprest Holder.

9. When an Imprest is retired, the S-A will proceed as follows:

(a) Take over the remaining cash and any outstanding vouchers in the possession of the Imprest Holder, thus accounting for the full amount of the Imprest.

(b) Enter in his cash book the outstanding vouchers, if any, proceeding as explained in para. 8 above.

(c) Issue a Receipt Voucher (Form F/1) to the Imprest Holder for the full amount of the Imprest and record this sum as a receipt in his cash book under the Head: Imprests Retired, and Sub-Head: Name, rank and title of the Imprest Holder.

(d) Withdraw and cancel the original of the Imprest Warrant and annex it to the duplicate of the Receipt Voucher mentioned in (c).

10. Imprests are not transferable from one officer to another and the amount of an Imprest may only be altered by retirement and the issue of a new one.

11. Imprest Holders are reminded that it is their personal responsibility to see that proper steps are taken to safeguard the public funds entrusted to them and that any loss due to neglect or loose interpretation of any instructions issued for the safe custody of public funds may involve the officer concerned financially.
