To : Establishment Section.

Reference your 37/Est of 13th August 1945.

1. Signorina Lea Basso, Italian Civilian is employed by Patriots Branch.
2. She asked for leave for a few days to go to UDINE to visit relatives. This leave was granted. A Patriot Officer was going back to UDINE by car and as he had accommodation in his car he offered to take her.
3. There was a vacant seat in the car going North and it is not intended that she should occupy any seat which may be required for personnel on duty. Special application was not made for transport and will not be made for transport on her return journey. She is to return only on vehicles or by Air if there are vacant seats.
4. This Italian Civilian was warned that transport would not be asked for her and that she would require to find her own way back. The Patriot Officer has offered to help her get on to any vehicle coming down to NOSE but it was understood by all that there would be no special demand for such.
5. The civilian has not received any instructions to carry out official business for Patriots Branch and is simply going on leave.
6. It is regretted that any confusion has arisen in this matter but it was understood that civilians employed by AC might use WD transport and that travel orders were necessary for civilians as well as military.

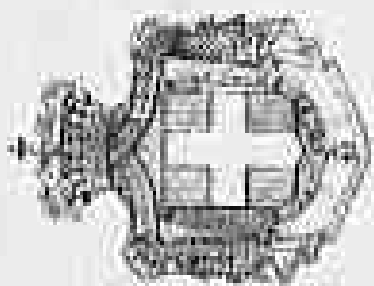

The Public Safety Sub Commission has passed to this Branch the attached documents concerning the patriots PARARILLI, ZAMBUTO, DI CARO, who, with cards issued by the Avanguardia Partigiana and travel permits issued by the Alto Commissariato per i Profughi di Guerra, went to Florence to be enlisted in the Partisan Brigades at present fighting at the front.

Such a procedure being contrary to regulations, you are requested to inform the a/m bodies that it must cease and to instruct them that no one should be sent into Army areas without prior consent of the Army concerned, and that each person should be in possession of the requisite civilian movement pass.

4. They reported themselves to Capt. R.G. Hammond, Partisan Officer, at the Partisan Centre, Via Marte Bello, Florence, and have volunteered to join an official work party.
5. The local Partisan leader, Lt.Col. Fedeli, said the attached Partisan cards are not official and he does not recognize them as such.
6. Could enquiry be made please at the Partisan Centre in Rome and the responsible person there instructed that, in future, no one should be sent into Army Area without prior consent of the Army concerned and that each person should be in possession of the requisite civilian movement pass.
