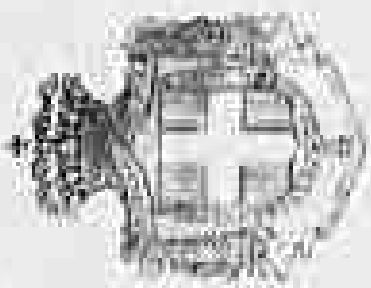

7. Full particulars must be submitted. Failure to include necessary and pertinent information will be cause for return to originating office.
8. In order to insure efficient handling of order requests, it is requested that special care be given to the correct spelling of names, ranks, serial numbers and branches of service.

We cannot, however, hide the disappointment felt by this Ministry, which is indeed sorry to have to note that a request which is often granted to civilians for private motives cannot be granted to a Minister of the Democratic National Government, who should go to the territories for reasons connected with his work (which had previously been notified in detail) and to other matters of special interest not only to the Italian Government but to the Allies as well, such as resistance to those gallant patriots who are now fighting side by side with the soldiers of United Nations.

Avv. Passerini had actually ^{for} promised to care for the organisation of our sections, and in doing so had obtained our recommendation and intervention on his behalf to obtain the circulation permit for his motor car.

The Association ignores entirely the reason for which avv. Passerini was carrying about the million lire.

We have, however, seen to it that the circulation permit should be withdrawn from avv. Passerini.

Avv. Passerini, now, has no more authority to travel on behalf or for the Association.

I will appreciate if you will notify the American Authorities of my disappointment.

I take the occasion to pay you my compliments.

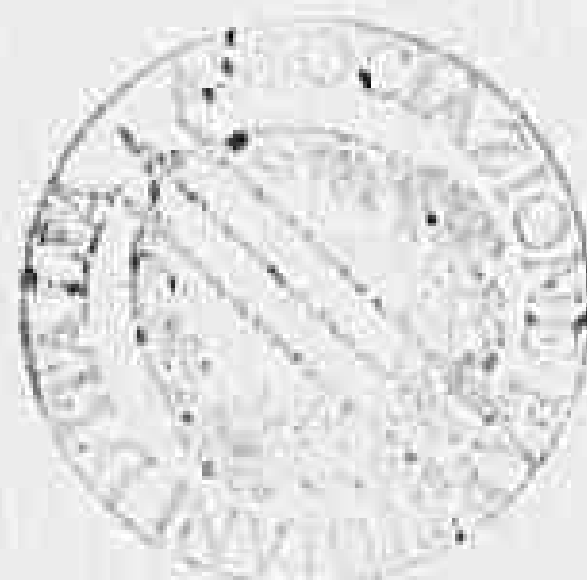
