1. Major M. B. Conrath was assigned to India Region on 3 March 1945 and was nominated Regional Patriot Officer for that Region.
2. On the 7th March he was attached to AMG, 3rd Army in order to take over the District Centre at RAVENHILL, where he relieved Lt. HARRIS (A) who was recalled to home on temporary duty.
3. RAVENHILL is in India Region.
4. Major M. B. Conrath has had no experience in the handling of Patriots. However, when, was an opportunity for direct contact with them to gain first hand knowledge of some of the problems which would face him in his Region on the occupation of North Italy. It was considered fit and proper that he should take over this camp temporarily.
5. It is regretted that Major Conrath was not permitted to travel in a lorry. This was due to the fact that there is an acute shortage of passenger vehicles. I would point out however that other distinguished officers have to submit to this form of conveyance.
6. In view of Major Conrath's attitude and the necessity for officers of the Allied Commission adapting their outlook to changing circumstances I consider it advisable that his application for re-posting to the Army be recommended.
