It was however decided in September 45 by Col. Cripps that Major Forti would not be appointed to Venezia Giulia.

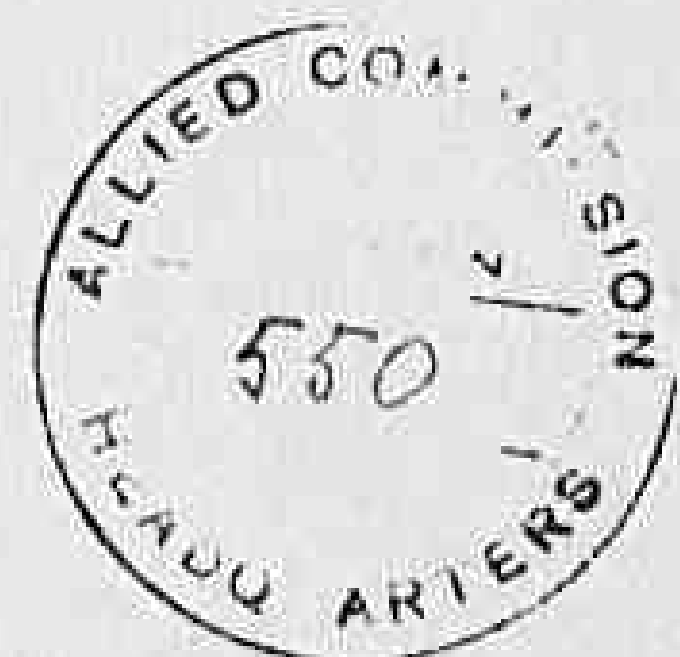

4. It is hoped that some form of appreciation of this officer's contribution to the Allied effort might be made.

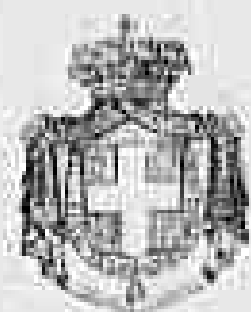
