1. Reference your communication 36/9/PAT, dated 21st July 1945, relative to above subject, I have to inform you that Lt.Col. Sebastiano Canbosu and Ten. Gabriele De Rosa left 5th Army for Rome, with orders to report to your office, early last week. Capt. Raffaello Pianigiani will be leaving to report to your office on Wednesday, 1st August 1945.

2. Lt.Col. Canbosu and Ten. De Rosa have, during the time they have been under my command, conducted themselves correctly and performed a reasonably good job of work for officers who had little knowledge of the type of work they had to perform.

Capt. Pianigiani has been, in every respect, an excellent officer. His work with the Patriots has been outstanding and I have no hesitation in saying that, of all the Patriot Officers I have met, Capt. Pianigiani is head and shoulders above them. He has a complete grasp of his subject both as a field officer and as an officer in charge of a centre, and his knowledge in regard to the political situation in relation to how it affects Patriots is immense. I feel that Capt. Pianigiani's name ought to be brought to the attention of the Italian War Ministry and, in the event of him continuing to work with the Patriots, I am of the very strong opinion that he should be promoted to at least Major and an executive job.

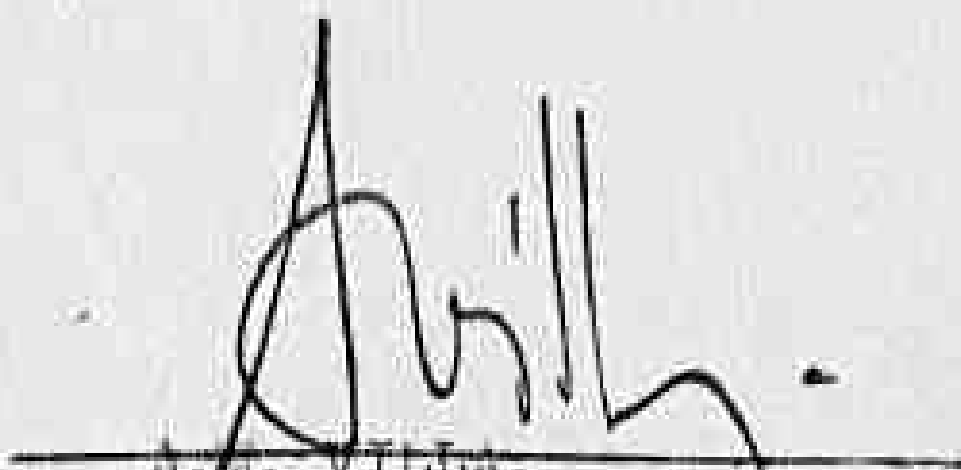

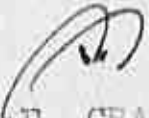
