1. MMIA appear to be under some misapprehension as to the status and functions of I.M.P.R. and their letter at folio 1 has caused the Ministry of War to "freeze" the appointments of almost all the army representatives that have been nominated.
2. The I.M.P.R. are on the Staff of the Ministry of War (Reparto Autonomo Ministeriale), and on request from the Ministry of Occupied Italy they are detached to that Ministry for employment as Patriot Reps. They are NOT posted to Patriots Branch.
3. These officers are not on full pay on the active list, but they cannot fulfil their functions as I.M.P.R. if they must first be discharged from the army, because:
 - a) They could not operate with armies etc. unless they were military and
 - b) the reduced army pay they are receiving is frequently their only permanent source of income; the indemnity of 200 lire per day they receive as Patriot Reps, is intended merely to cover additional expenses connected with their present employment.
4. As the I.M.P.R. are required now in forward areas it is a matter of great urgency that this question should be cleared with MMIA and that they should rescind their letter at folio 7.

Answer to letters 111714/1/4 and 111968/1/4 dated 18 and 21 May 45.

Having carefully examined the letter of A.C. MIA ref A/306 dated 26/5/45 of which we enclose a copy of the literal translation, and following correspondence and contacts with A.C. Patriots Branch, we point out the following:

From the attached letter, para 1 we assume that by the word "civilian" the A.C. (MIA) did not mean to say that personnel requested by Patriots Branch should not be military, but that they should not be on "active service with the Italian armed Forces, included in the battle plan duly authorized".

That is, in other words, already previously employed by the same Allied authorities. For the same purpose it is believed that the personnel that this Ministry should send to A.C. Patriots Branch, should be:-

military, but not included in the so called "forza vettogliata" (drawing rations), or on "minimum pay". This wording means the military personnel drawing peace-time and not war-time wages:

However it is also believed that personnel included in the battle plan can be attached to this Ministry, having previously been transferred out of the battle plan itself, by a simple one-sided provision of the Italian Military Authorities, and not having previously been discharged, as maintained in the letters to which we are answering.

Such is the meaning that we believe should be given to para 2 of the attached translation.

Besides that mentioned above, we wish that the Cabinet of the Ministry of War would consider the real nature of the "military representatives" requested by Patriots Branch, according to which they must be military because:

1. They are employed in Allied Army Territories.
2. Under the direct jurisdiction of AMG HQ 5th and 8th Armies who call for them and qualify them as Italian Military Patriot Representatives "(IMPR)".
3. Their duties and tasks are essentially of a military nature, e.g. contacts with Allied Military Authorities and C.V.L. formations, institution and administration of patriot centres etc.)

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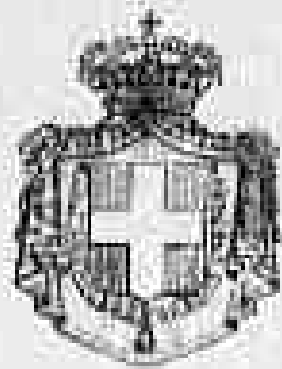

Dopo accurato esame del foglio A/306 del 26/5/1945 dell'A.C. (MMIA), di cui si trasmette copia della traduzione letterale, ed a seguito del carteggio e delle conversazioni intercorse con l'A.C. Patriots Branch, si espone quanto appreso.

Dal foglio allegato, paragrafo 1°, si desume che con il termine di "civile", l'A.C. (MMIA) non ha inteso dire che il personale richiesto dalla Patriots Branch non debba essere militare, ma bensì che non sia "in servizio attivo presso le Forze Armate Italiane comprese nel piano di impiego debitamente autorizzato".

Cioè, con altre espressioni, già usate in precedenza dalle stesse Autorità Alleate, per la stessa questione, il personale che dovrebbe essere designato da questo Ministero all'A.C. Patriots Branch, si ritiene debba essere:

- militare, ma non facente parte della così detta "forza vetovagliata";
- oppure "a paga minima", intendendo con questa espressione il personale militare fruente del trattamento economico di pace e non quello di guerra.

Tuttavia anche il personale compreso nel piano di impiego si ritiene possa essere assegnato a questo Ministero, previo trasferimento fuori del piano stesso, con semplice provvedimento unilaterale delle Autorità Militari Italiane e non già previo collocamento in congedo, come sostenuto nei fogli cui si risponde.

Tale è infatti il significato che si ritiene debbasi attribuire al paragrafo n° 2 della traduzione allegata.

Oltre a quanto sopra detto, si prega codesto Gabinetto a considerare l'effettiva natura dei "rappresentanti militari," richiesti dalla Patriots Branch, secondo la quale non possono non essere militari perchè:

- 1°) - impiegati in territorio delle Armate Alleate;
- 2°) - alle dirette dipendenze degli H.Q. A.M.G. 5^a e 8^a Armata che precisamente li chiamano e definiscono quali "Italians Military Patriots Representative," (I.M.P.R.);
- 3°) - vengono loro attribuiti compiti essenzialmente militari (contatti fra autorità militari alleate e formazioni di C.V.L., smobilitazione e disarmo delle formazioni, istituzione e direzione dei centri raccolta, ecc.).

Pertanto questo Ministero ritiene di concludere, in merito all'argomento di cui all'oggetto, esprimendo l'opinione che nulla vi è d'innovato nella prassi fin qui seguita.

- 2°= Nessun membro dell'Esercito Italiano attivo, ora compreso nel piano di impiego entro i limiti approvati, può essere impiegato in altro servizio che non sia quello previsto dal predetto piano. Qualora si desideri impiegare un ufficiale (di carriera o della riserva) attualmente in servizio attivo, sarà necessario dispensarlo dalla posizione che ha nell'Esercito Italiano, e tale norma italiana avrà pieno effetto, in quanto produce il mantenimento dell'ufficiale nella riserva dell'Esercito Italiano, ovvero in servizio attivo.

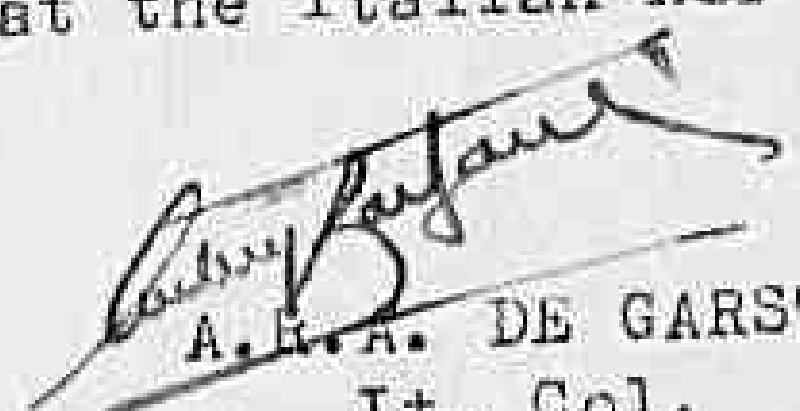

Since returning to ROME the undersigned has discovered that Lt. Colonel FRIGERI, according to our records, has always had a very anti-fascist outlook and has suffered in his Army career accordingly.

As you have not stated the reasons which the GIN and the CVL have against him personally, would you please inform this office of any further difficulties you may find in employing him as it is considered that to remove him immediately may cause him to feel that he has a grievance and also it is necessary to consider whether or not he can be employed elsewhere by this Branch.

If Lt. Colonel FRIGERI has not already returned to ROME, an endeavour should be made to employ him until such time as a decision has been made as to his future.

1. Under present directives the term "civilian" includes all Italian nationals not now on the active list of the Italian Armed Forces regardless of any prior service in the Italian Armed Forces. Reserve officers, not on active duty as a member of the Italian Armed Forces within the authorized order of battle, are therefore termed civilians.
2. No member of the active Italian Army, now carried on the order of battle within the authorized ceiling, may be employed on any duty other than that shown on the order of battle. Where it is desired to employ an officer (regular or reserve) now on active duty, it will be necessary to remove such officer from the strength returns of the Italian Army; and such Italian law as operates to retain the officer on the reserve of the Italian Army, on inactive status, will take effect.

1. The names which appear on the attached list (Appx "A") have been selected by Soccinarro and were submitted by him on 5 April 1945.  
  
Those officers who are now recommended have not been independently screened, but appear to have been considered by the Expiration Committee. In view of your direction they will now be screened by S.I.M.
2. Appendix "B" shows changes that have been made and indicates the reason for such changes so far as is known to this Section.
3. There has been no legislation abolishing the original Patriot Committee set up by D.L. 519. However, on 8 Feb 45, it was stated by the Prime Minister to me that the Committee had been abolished. Furthermore, Article 4. of D.L. 73 of 28 Feb 45 gives to the Ministry of Occupied Italy (Welfare Office) the functions formerly carried on by the Committee.
4. Attached is a report from Avv. FORTI who was also present at Soccinarro's meeting on 14 April 45. He, like a number of others, is a reserve officer and if selected will go forward as an officer. This report gives further indication of Soccinarro's ideas.
5. DAF are intended solely to assist Allied Patriot officers and perform a useful service in running camps, making payments, etc. This is their sole function and the Minister should only give instructions on such technical matters as running camps. The officers are on the staff of the Regional Commissioner and take their policy from him only.
6. It is recommended that the Chief Commissioner see the Prime Minister and request him to instruct Soccinarro that he is to give no policy instructions to his Patriot Officers.

REPORT OF AVV. FORTI ON A MEETING HELD AT THE  
MINISTRY OF OCCUPIED ITALY ON 14 APR 45 AT  
1000 HOURS.

Avv. FORTI, who is one of the Legal Advisors on Italian law attached to this Sub-Commission is also a member of the Committee of the Liberal Party. He is a TRIESTE lawyer who has lost all his worldly belongings and his son in the War. He has been appointed by the Ministry of Occupied Italy as a Liaison Officer between AMG and the Ministry in the Sub-Region of VENETO (TRIESTE Town).

He was officially requested to attend a meeting of IOs for Northern Italy by Scoccimarro. The Meeting took place at the Ministry at 100 hrs on 14 April.

IOs had a short talk before the meeting with an Italian Colonel who is in charge of the Military Department of the Ministry and who discussed the general situation with them.

Scoccimarro then spoke. He said that IOs would have to deal with the problem of the Partisans and to this effect ensure liaison between Regional, Sub-Regional and Provincial Commissioners of AMG, the Ministry and especially contact the Partisans. He outlined their responsibilities and explained how best they could fulfill their Mission.

An IO from VENEZIA GIULIA asked Scoccimarro whether there were special instructions for IOs in his own province.

Scoccimarro replied: "You have time enough to consider your duties. In all probability VENEZIA GIULIA will be occupied by a mixed formation of Italians and Yugoslavs under TITO. Consequently there will be no reason for your intervention as no Partisan camps will be organized as in other parts of Northern Italy. Your appointment was made in case you would be required some time or other and it became necessary to send you there. There is plenty of time in any case."

From conversation with other IOs, FORTI gathered that TITO's Partisans in VENEZIA GIULIA are composed of CROATS, SLOVENES and separatist Italians, all communists. A non-communist Partisan formation recruited in VENEZIA GIULIA is operating in UDINE province.

Report of Avv. FORTI on a meeting held at the Ministry of Occupied Italy on 14 April 1945 at 1000 hours.

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Avv. FORTI, who is one of the Legal Advisers on Italian Law attached to this Sub-Commission is also a member of the Committee of the Liberal Party. He is a TRIESTE lawyer who has lost all his worldly belongings and his son in the War. He has been appointed by the Ministry of Occupied Italy as a Liaison Officer between AMG and the Ministry in the Sub-Region of VENETO - (TRIESTE Town).

He was officially requested to attend a meeting of LOs for Northern Italy by SCOCCIMARRO. The Meeting took place at the Ministry at 1000 hrs on 14 April.

LOs had a short talk before the meeting with an Italian Colonel who is in charge of the Military Department of the Ministry and who discussed the general situation with them.

SCOCCIMARRO then spoke. He said that LOs would have to deal with the problem of the Partisans and to this effect ensure liaison between Regional, Sub-Regional and Provincial Commissioners of AMG, the Ministry and especially contact the Partisans. He outlined their responsibilities and explained how best they could fulfil their Mission.

An LO from VENEZIA GIULIA asked SCOCCIMARRO whether there were special instructions for LOs in his own province.

SCOCCIMARRO replied: "You have time enough to consider your duties. In all probability VENEZIA GIULIA will be occupied by a mixed formation of ITALIANS and YUGOSLAVS under TITO. Consequently there will be no reason for your intervention as no Partisan camps will be organized as in other parts of Northern ITALY. Your appointment was made in case you would be required some time or other and it became necessary to send you there. There is plenty of time in any case."
